





- Don't need to tilt or follow a subject, your camera sees everything!
- For ceiling view we recommend to position the camera at breast level
- For floor view we recommend to use a stick (sold separately) for a wider effect

Capture a 360° Photo

- Tap on the Photo Capture icon
- Yellow icon
- Default mode is set to Automatic, simply press the trigger button! Shutter sound indicates the photo has been taken
- To switch between Automatic or Timer mode, tap the Photo Capture icon
- and switch with right and left arrows
- Save by tapping the Tamaggo icon
- In timer mode, the light ring indicator will flash for 10 seconds until the photo is taken



Capture a 360° Video

- Tap on the Video Capture icon
- Yellow icon
- means video mode is activated
- Press the trigger button to start recording your 360° video. Press again to stop
- A light indicator will keep pulsing while the 360° video is recording

- to navigate through photos and videos with the right and left arrows
- Play video by tapping on play icon
- To delete, tap on the bin icon
- Tamaggo icon
- brings you back to main menu
