



1. Power on

A. Insert the SIM card

B. Pack the battery

C. Turn the volume control clockwise to power on.

2. Power off

Turn the volume control anticlockwise to power off.

Caution: No removing battery directly to power off, otherwise it will lead to the data loss and the walkie-talkie damages.

3. Transmitting

Press the PTT button to transmit, keep away from microphone 5cm at least.

Exception & Talking Priority:

If there is an advanced user starts to talk when you are transmitting, you will be forced to exit the transmitting mode.

4. Receiving

The LED indicator lights blue, LCD screen displays the transmitter's name when it is receiving.



Advanced Functions

1. Playback Voice Records

Enter Record Control to turn on the PTT records function, then on standby mode, short press "UP" or "DOWN" key to playback the records

2. Multi-members Selective Call

Enter friend or user list, short press "MENU" key to select one or more online friends, press PTT to create temporary group for selective call.

3. Monitor Group

Enter group list, short press "PF3" key to monitor other group(s). Short press again to cancel.

4. APRS Function (GPS must positioned)

- **a.** Shortly press the PF3 key, the last caller's GPS location will be shown.
- b. Enter friend or user list, short press "PF3 key" key to check the online user's GPS information.

5. Quick Operation

- a. Define Quick Group/user call: Enter "Choose group" Or "Friend list" Or "User list", long press the P1-P6 keys to store the current chosen group, friend or user to the corresponding key.
- **b**. Quick Operation: Long press P1-P6 keys to call the group, friend or user stored to the keys.

6. WiFi Function

1) Enter "WLAN Settings", then "Work Mode", choose WLAN-Manual/WLAN-Auto, press Menu key to save, the radio will connect to WLAN.





WLAN-Auto -- If the present WLAN is unavailable or experiencing signal weakness, it can automatically transition to a strong WLAN signal.

WLAN-Manual -- Can only manually switch to another WLAN.

- 2) Enter "WLAN Settings", then "Favorite List", select WLAN, press Menu key to connect.
- 3) Enter "WLAN Settings", then "Scanning", press Menu Key to search for WLAN; Press"▲"or"▼" key to check connectable WLAN, then press Menu key to connect. (*WLAN must be stored in Favorites List to support connection. When Work Mode is OFF, Scanning cannot be used.)

7. Quick search function

- 1) Under the menu "Group list" Or "User list" Or "Friend list", you can click P6 to enter quick search function.
- 2) Key functions:
- P1: Left P2: Right P3:OK P6: Page down
- 3) Operation:
- a. Press P1 or P2 or P6 to choose numbers or letters you want, and confirm the selected letters by P3. Group(s), User(s) or friend(s) searched will be shown.
- 3) "Up" key or "Down" key to choose the one you want to talk. Press Menu to confirm your operation.

8. GPS Patrol

- 1) Short press P2 Key in standby mode to realize GPS Patrol.

 Radio display "Waiting" when sending GPS information to platform.

 Please wait a moment to enter Patrol Menu.
- 2) Two different situations after enter Patrol Menu
 - a. Have patrol task

The task(s) will show below the message- "Date, Time and On/Out Planned patrol period". Short press Up/Down Keys to choose the options and press Menu Key to confirm.

After the task is completed, press any key to exit.

b. \ Have no patrol task

Show message- "Date, Time and On/Out Planned patrol period" on radio only.

NOTE: To realize GPS Patrol, radio must have GPS function and able to be located. The radio version must be V32 or above.

Warranty Period
