When you are finished watching, press the HOME button on your iTV remote control and turn off your TV. After 15 minutes the iTV Viet will automatically go to sleep and its LED light will turn red. When you turn on your TV, there will be a clock displayed on screen. You can press any button on your iTV Viet remote control to wake up from sleep.

iTV VIET is the main program. (the blue V icon)

HOME MENU

Favourites

To add an app to your Favourites list, select an app and click **MENU** on the remote. A pop-up menu will appear and you can add or remove from favourites, edit settings, and update.

All apps

Select All Apps to see all your apps. Select an app from the list to edit their settings. For example, add or remove from favourites, edit settings, and update.


Settings

In settings, you can connect to your Internet, adjust the picture, change the languages, and more.

Network Connection

The best Internet connection for the iTV Viet is **Wired** from your modem with a CAT6 Ethernet cable, or using Powerline adapters. The minimum Internet speed requirement is 10Mbps/s. Use the Speed Test app to test your Internet.

WiFi: Select Internet > WiFi **"OK"**> Wait until available networks appear > Select your network > click **"OK"** for



the keyboard to appear > Enter your password. Click the continue arrow  button to save. If you are using WiFi as your Internet connection, it is best to try the 5G first and if it is not strong enough than connect to 2G.

Adult channels

In iTV Viet, Select the **Lock icon**  Enter zero **"0"** four times (0000) then select **OK**.

The adult channels are now unlocked and can be found in  **XXX**. To hide it again, select the **Lock icon**  again.

Changing the password

1. Select the **Lock icon**  Enter zero **"0"** four times (0000) then select **OK**.
2. Click the **Left arrow** to open the hidden menu,
3. Select **Expert mode** > **Profile settings** > **Profiles** > **Master User** > **Lock preferences** > **Master lock**
4. In **Master Lock** > **Numeric password** > Choose a new numeric password > Click **Done**
5. Re-enter new password. Click **Done**.
6. Make sure to select **"OK"** on the right of the screen to save the password.

Back up & Reset

PLEASE PHONE OR EMAIL US BEFORE RESETTNG THE BOX.

1. In **Settings** > **More Settings** > under Personal **Backup & Reset**
2. **Factory data reset** > **Reset MBX** at the bottom > **Erase everything**
3. **YOU MUST WAIT FOR 20 MINUTES. After apps have been automatically reinstalled, you may continue.**
4. Reconnect your Internet.
5. Open iTV Viet and check if it has updated to the new version. Follow the instructions on screen.

TIPS

- ☐ Pay attention to any notices running at the bottom of the screen.
- ☐ The latest version of iTV Viet will be listed at the bottom. Check the top left corner and make sure it matches to the latest version.
- ☐ In the **HELP (?)** icon at the top: you can fix, install, uninstall apps and more.
- ☐ **To change the menu settings for easy use:** Unlock the app > click left arrow to display hidden menu > select **Edit menu**. You can customize and turn ON/OFF any category you would like. To return to default, select **Reset**.

REMOTE

Please read the manual before use. **The USB chip must be in the iTV Viet box at all times.**



Basic Functions and Usage

- ☐ Choose the program then click **OK** to watch. To stop the program, click **RETURN**.
- ☐ The **MOUSE** function can be used in YouTube, Google and any apps that require the mouse.
- ☐ Use the arrow buttons **Left, Right, Up, Down, OK and RETURN** to navigate.
- ☐ If your iTV Viet app freezes, press **■** to stop. Or press **HOME**, then **Reboot** or quit the app in **Task Killer**.
- ☐ Use the **MENU** button on the iTV Viet remote to edit app settings.



Troubleshooting: Unresponsive remote control

1. Reboot the box: press **HOME**, select the **Reboot** and click **OK**
2. Unplug the power of the box and plug it back.
3. Change the USB port in the back to another port.
4. Check the batteries.
5. Reset the remote control as per instruction.

Pairing: If the remote does not respond, try replacing the batteries; otherwise follow these pairing instructions:

1. Take out the USB at the back of the iTV Viet box.
2. Press and hold the **HOME**  and **VOLUME DOWN**  buttons at the same time.
3. Release the buttons when the blue light turns on.
4. Plug the USB into your TV box.
5. When the blue light quickly blinks, pairing is complete.

Mouse Reset: If your mouse is not working properly, follow these instructions to reset it:

1. Press and hold the LEFT and RIGHT   directional arrows on the remote.
2. When the blue light turns on, lay the remote on a flat surface.
3. Release the remote control.
4. The blue light will turn off when the mouse has been recalibrated.
