

The LED Indicator will turn solid RED while charging, and will turn OFF once fully charged. The speaker will sound a tone to indicate when it needs to be recharged.</p> <p>Bluetooth Pairing</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Press and hold the [] Button to turn ON/OFF the speaker. Double press the [] Button to switch between Bluetooth Speaker mode and FM Mode. In Bluetooth Speaker mode: press the [] Button once to PAUSE/RESUME media.
