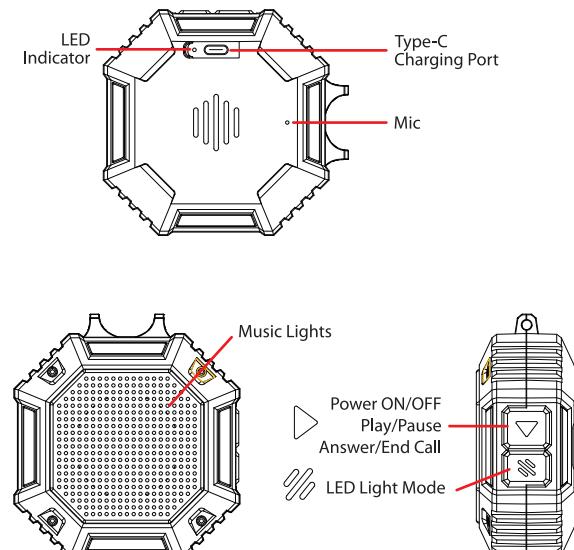

Getting Started

Charging the Speaker
Charge speaker fully before first use.
Plug the small connector of the supplied USB charging cable into the charging port on the speaker. Plug the large connector into a USB power source, such as the USB port on a computer or a 5V USB adapter (*not included*) and plug into a wall outlet.

The LED Indicator will turn **RED** while charging and turn **OFF** when fully charged. When the speaker is low on power, a tone will be heard, indicating that it needs to be recharged.

Powering ON/OFF
• **Press+Hold** the ▶ button to power the speaker ON/OFF
• When powered on, a tone will be heard, and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. It may automatically re-pair to a previously-paired device in range.

Note: The speaker will automatically power OFF after 5 minutes without a Bluetooth connection.

Bluetooth Pairing

- Power the speaker ON. A tone will be heard and the speaker will enter Bluetooth pairing mode. The Music Lights will **FLASH** RGB colors.
- Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **ISBW104** from the list of found devices.
- After a successful pairing, a tone will be heard and the Music Lights will turn **SOLID PURPLE**.

Media Playback

- Press** the ▶ button to PAUSE/RESUME playback

Phone Calls

- Press** the ▶ button to ANSWER/END a phone call
- Press+Hold** the ▶ button to REJECT an incoming phone call
- 2xPress** the ▶ button to REDIAL the last outgoing phone number

Music Lights

- Press** the ⚡ button to toggle between 4 RGB light modes
- Press+Hold** the ⚡ button to turn the Music Lights OFF
