USB-C Charging Cable

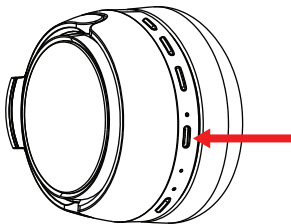
A Closer Look



Charging



Connect the headphones to the USB-C Charging Cable (Included) and plug the other end into a USB power port.



The Power Indicator light will illuminate red while charging.

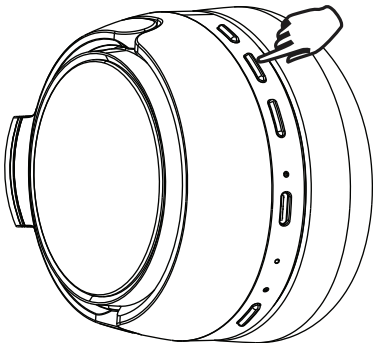

Powering On

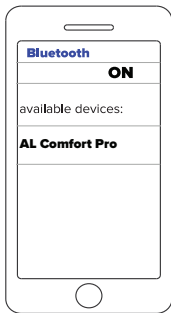

After Powering ON, your headphones will automatically go into Bluetooth pairing mode.

To connect your headphones to your smartphone, go to settings then select the Bluetooth page. Look under 'available devices' and connect to "AL Comfort Pro".



Button Functions



Volume+/Next Song Button:

- Press to increase volume.
- Press and hold to go to the next track.

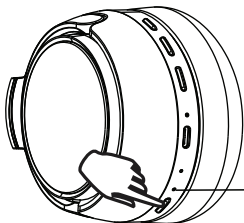
Power Button:

- Press and hold for approximately 3 seconds to power on/off.
- Press to answer/end calls.
- Press and hold to reject incoming calls.
- Short press to play/pause.
- Press twice to activate voice assistant.
- Press three times for Low Latency Mode On/Off.
- Press five times to clear pairing.

Volume-/Previous Song:

- Press to decrease volume.
- Press and hold to go to the previous track.

ANC / Transparency Mode



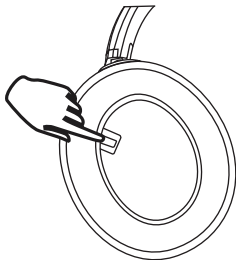
- ANC On
- Transparency On
- ANC Off

Press the ANC button to cycle through the three available modes: ANC ON, Transparency, and ANC OFF.

Active Noise Cancelling mode cancels noise around you.

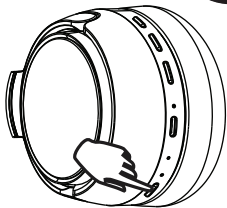
Transparency Mode turns off ANC and instead uses the microphones to amplify sound around you.

Low Latency Mode



Low Latency Mode: Press the Power Button three times to turn on/off. Low Latency Mode reduces the delay inherent in Bluetooth transmission for improved lip sync.

Spatial Audio



Press the ANC button twice to cycle through the three available Spatial Audio Modes: Spatial Audio, Head Tracking, and Sound Modes (off).

Spatial Audio uses a Head Related Transfer Function to create a 3D soundfield that surrounds you rather than coming from a straight line between Left and Right like Stereo. Most used with Music.

Headtracking adjusts the Spatial Audio based on your head movements so that the origins of sounds seem to stay fixed in the landscape when you move your head. Most used with Games.
