


<p>Introductions: Thanks for purchasing and using earphones. Please read this user manual carefully before using.</p> <p>Knowing earphones:</p>  <p>Wearing earphones: The standard d-sized eartips fit for most people and have been installed on the earphone housing before shipping. Please try different sizes to get best fit to enjoy the great sound.</p> <p>Wear</p>  <p>Put the earhook over the back of your ear and insert the earphone into the ear canal. Adjust by twisting into position if that isn't right.</p> <p>Move the microphone closer to your mouth for better sound during phone conversations.</p> <p>Begin to use</p>  <p>led light (the light will be red when it is eating, and will be green when it is enough)</p> <p>For first use, press and hold the multifunction key for 6 seconds until you see alternating red/blue flashing and hearing the voice prompt "pairing". For subsequent use, press and hold the multifunction key for about 4 seconds until you see blue light flashing and hear the voice prompt "power on". <p>Operation and instructions</p> <p>1. ON/OFF Press and hold the multifunction key for 3 seconds. The LED will flash blue when turning on and flash red when turn off.</p> <p>2. Pairing Press and hold multifunction key for 6 seconds until you see alternating blue/red flashing of LED.</p> <p>3. Adjust volume or Skip forward/backward press +/- for 1 second to adjust volume and 2 seconds to skip forward/backward.</p> <p>4. Pick up/hang up a call Press multifunction key shortly.</p> <p>5. Reject an incoming call. Press and hold multifunction key for 2 seconds.</p>	<p>6. Switch caller during a call. Press multifunction key twice.</p> <p>7. mute/unmute the microphone in a call Press volume up and down button once at the same time.</p> <p>8. Connect two cellphones ① With headphones turned off, & within 1 meter(3 feet) of music device, press & hold center key for more than 6 seconds until you see alternating red/blue flashing of the status indicator and a voice prompt saying "Pairing". ② On your phone/music device, turn on & have it search for devices (see instructions in the phone/music device manual for details). ③ Check for "SY11-1" and select, voice prompt will say "Connected".</p> <p>9. Accept calls from 2 phones and switch between them When you receive a call on the second phone while in conversation on the first phone, double press the multifunction button to put the first call on hold and switch to the second one. Double press the multifunction button every time you want to switch between calls.</p> <p>10. Switch between earphones and receiver Press and hold the multifunction button for 1 second during a call to switch between the earphones and your phone's receiver.</p>	<p>④ Turn off the earphones. ⑤ Pair the second phone as outlined above.</p> <p>11.
