Product Description:

How to install the earbuds:

To Enjoy better sound quality, or to fit your ears, change the size of earbuds or adjust the earbud position to fit comfortably and snugly in your left and right ears separately. When you change the earbuds, turn them to install firmly on your headset and prevent the earbud from detaching and remaining in your ear.



How to place the headset on your ears:
