

Key Definition for the remote controller:



Remote controller Operation:

Coding:

- A. Power connect after light cut off the power.
- B. In 3 seconds after power connection, keep pressing the coding keys. (See the keys picture)
- C. Loose the key after see the white light flash for twice, coding successfully.

Clear Coding

- A. Power connect after light cut off the power.
- B. In 3 seconds after power connection, keep pressing the clear coding keys.(See the keys picture)
- C. Loose the key after see the white light flash for twice, clear coding successfully.

A ON/OFF keys

Press to power on/off the light.

B Brightness +/-

Press to adjust the brightness.

C Color+/-

Press color +, to fine tuning the color.

Press color -, to fine tuning the color.

D Color switch

Press the color switch, to switch color in order, total 7 colors.

E Countdown light off

Press countdown light off keys, light will off in the corresponding time.

P.S.: If repeat press 3 keys many times, only operate as the last time's press.

F Night light

Press the night light key.
