

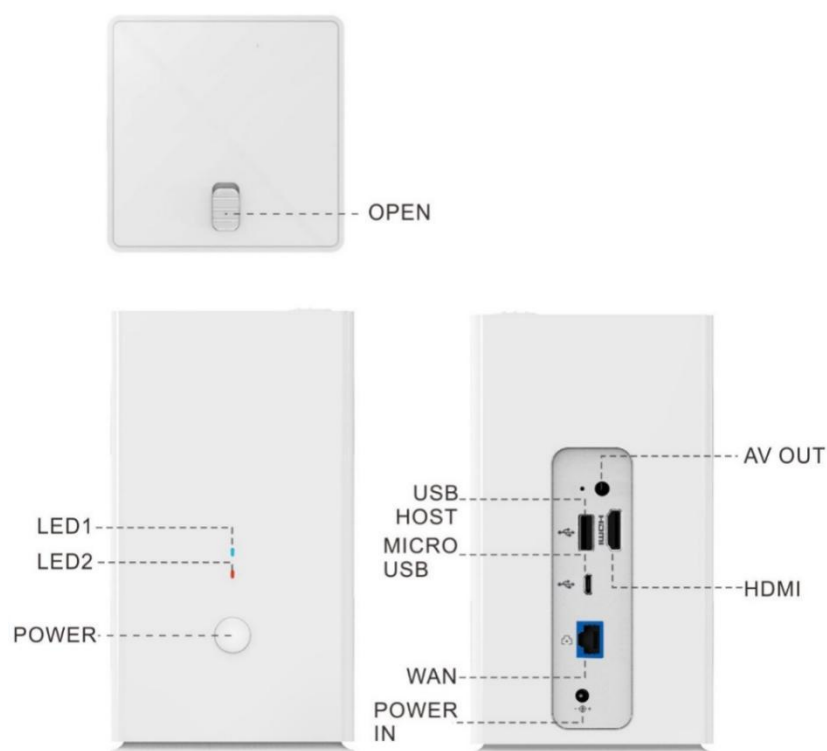
# CH-100

### 1.Preparation

- ⊙Please check the power indicator of the device and the red light indicates that the power is on. Press the power button, the power indicator turns blue to indicate that the device is powered on.

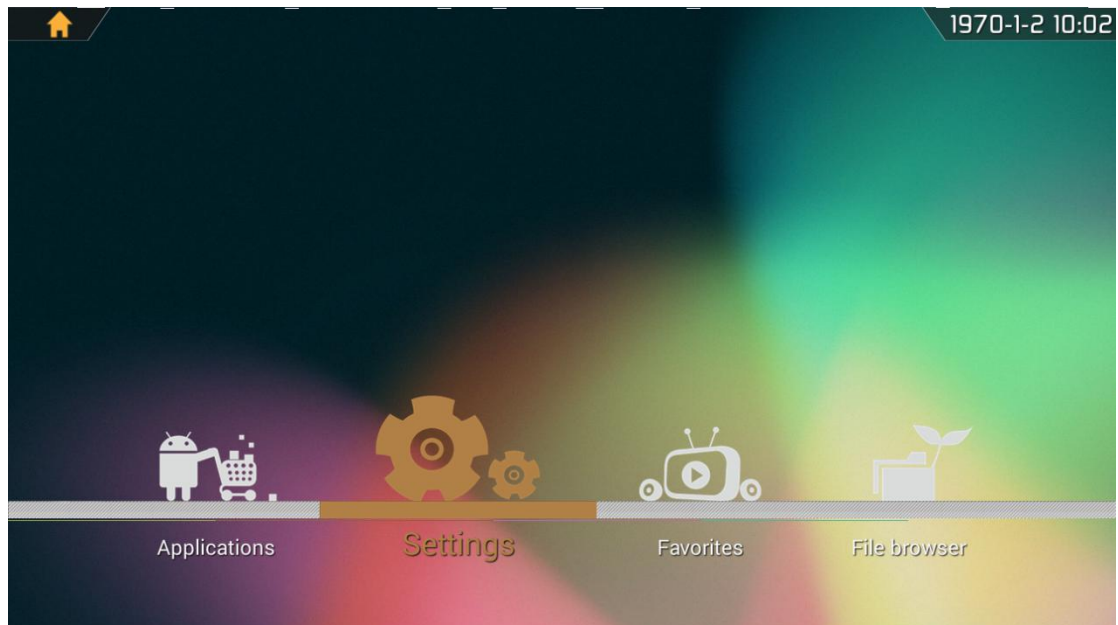

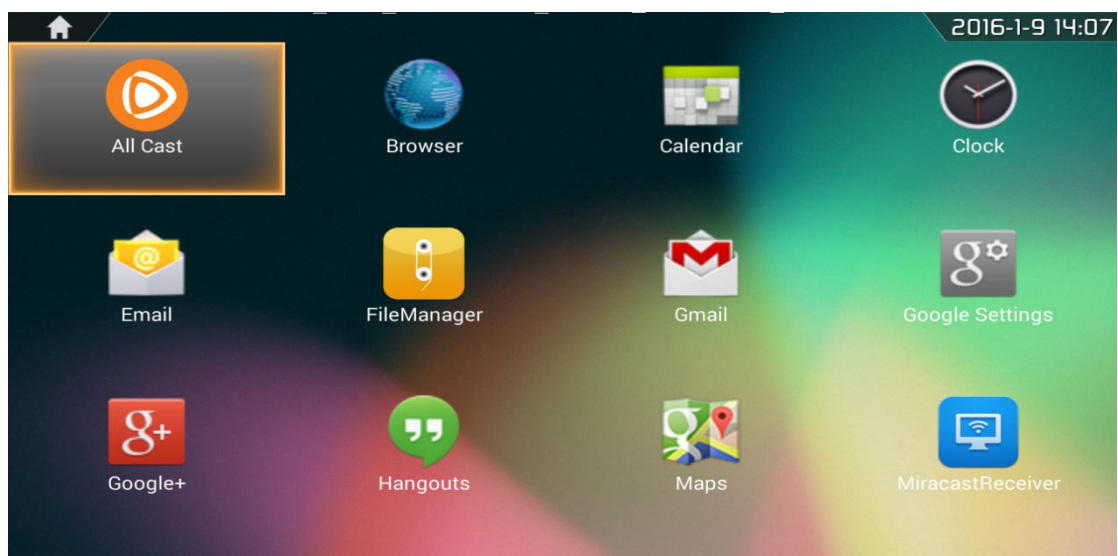
#### 3.1 Home Interface

Home interfaces as shown below, you can use Applications, Settings, Favorites and File Browser.

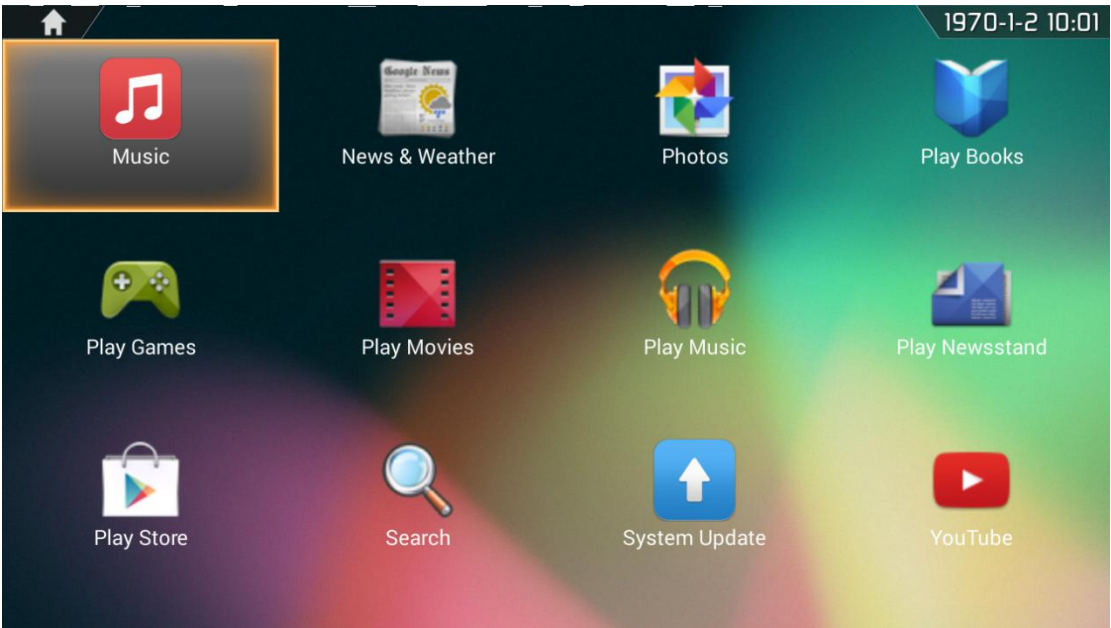


#### 3.2 Access the Applications

Select the application to access the application menu interface.

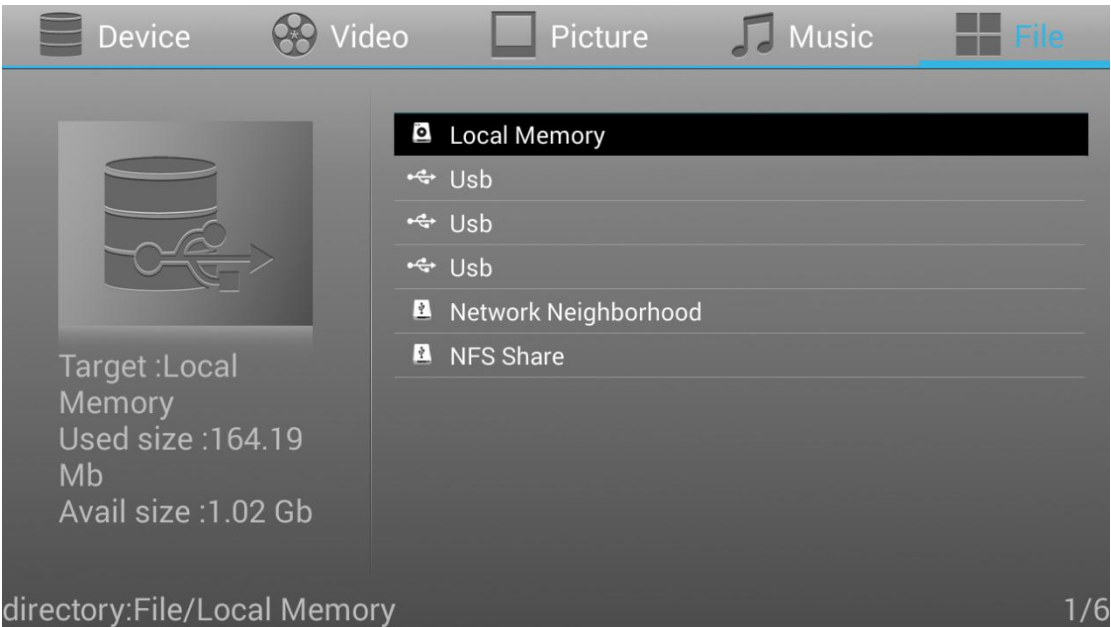


In this menu, you can select the application you need to use.

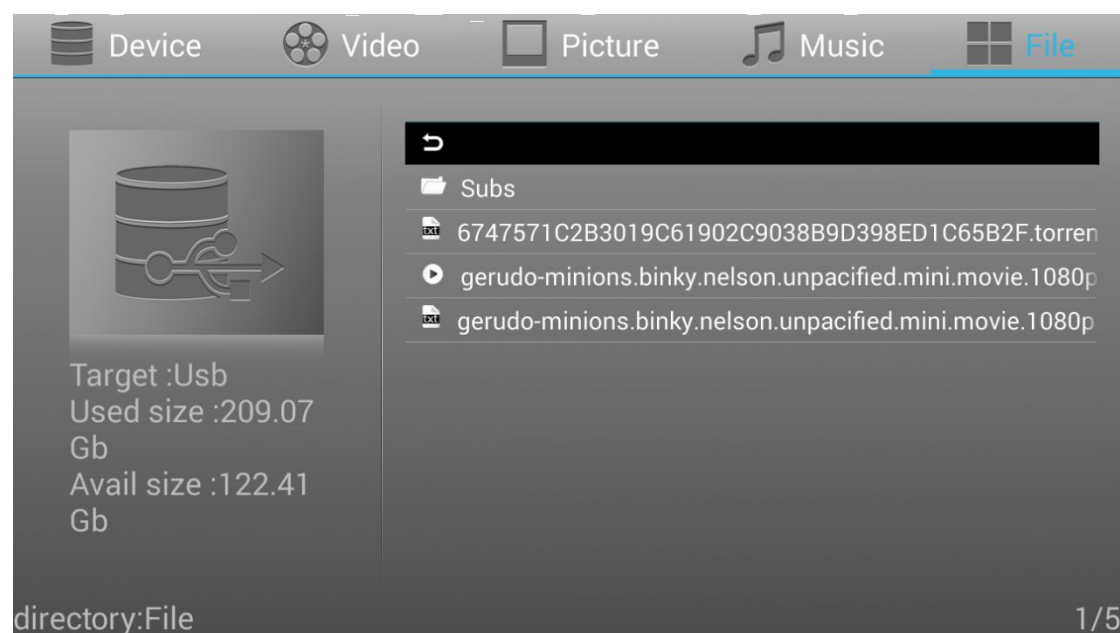


3.3 File Management

You could check and use files on your device, such as pictures, videos, and etc.



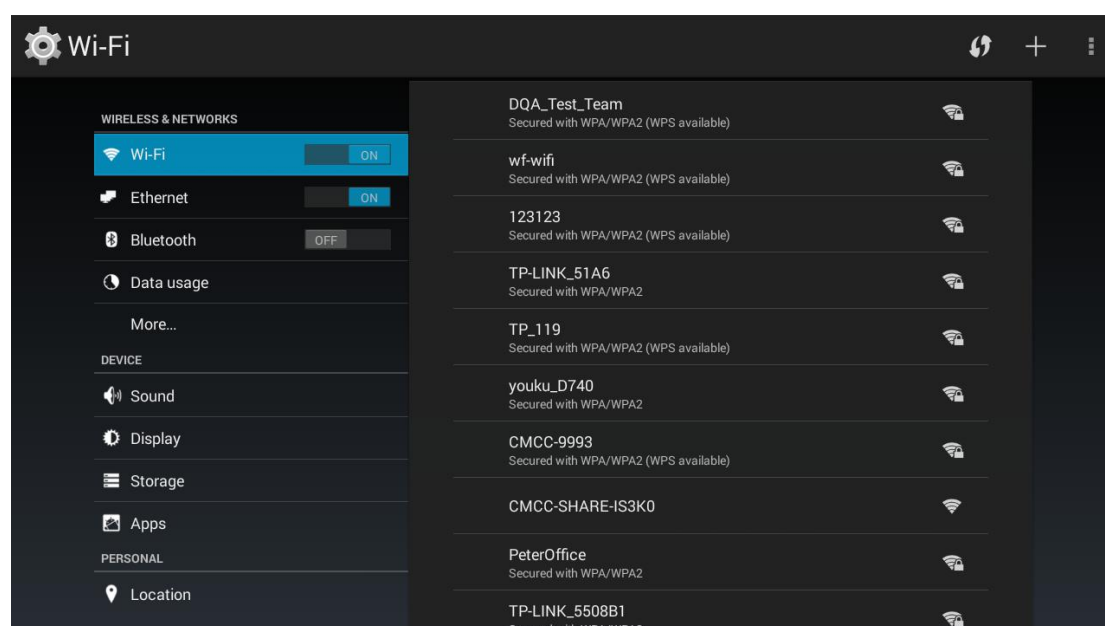
### 3.4Settings

Select the settings, enter the setup menu, then select the features and settings you need, such as wireless network, wired network, Bluetooth, time and date settings, language and so on.

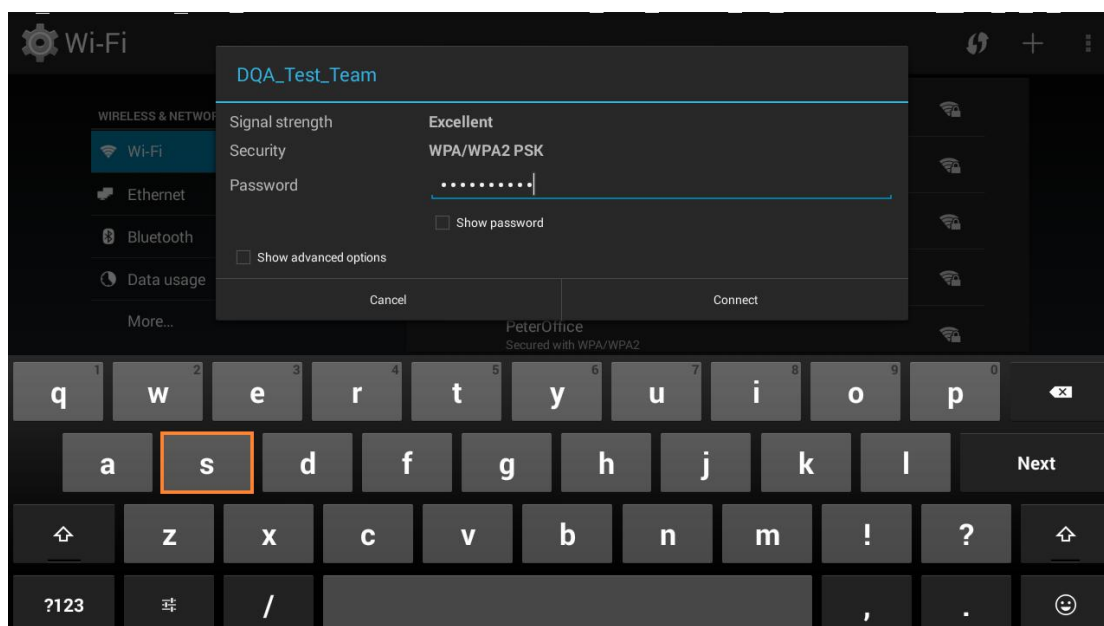
#### 3.4.1 Wireless and Network

Turn on the Wi-Fi and search the surrounding wireless network.

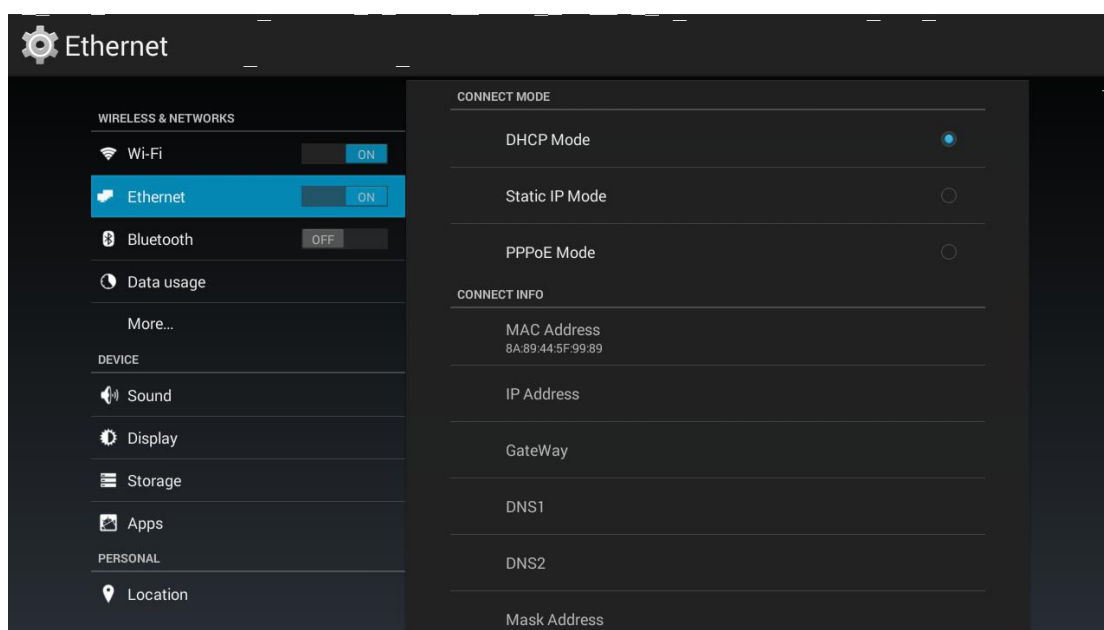


Select the network you need to connect. If the connected network is encrypted, enter the appropriate network password, then you can connect the network.



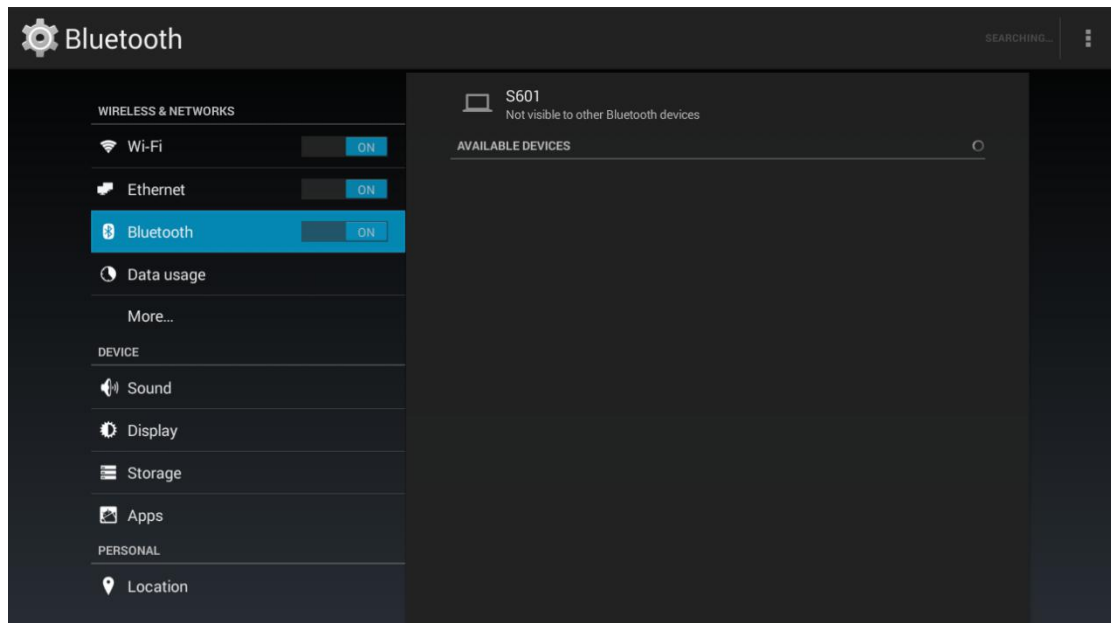
## Wired network connection

Through the blue WLAN interface on the device, you could connect the dedicated cable in the use place to the device. You could access to the network by configuration or through the PPOE dial-up access to the network.

Turn on the Bluetooth, and search your surrounding Bluetooth devices, such as Bluetooth headset, Bluetooth audio and etc. Then click on the name of the searched Bluetooth device to pair the Hub. You can use the device after the completion of pairing.

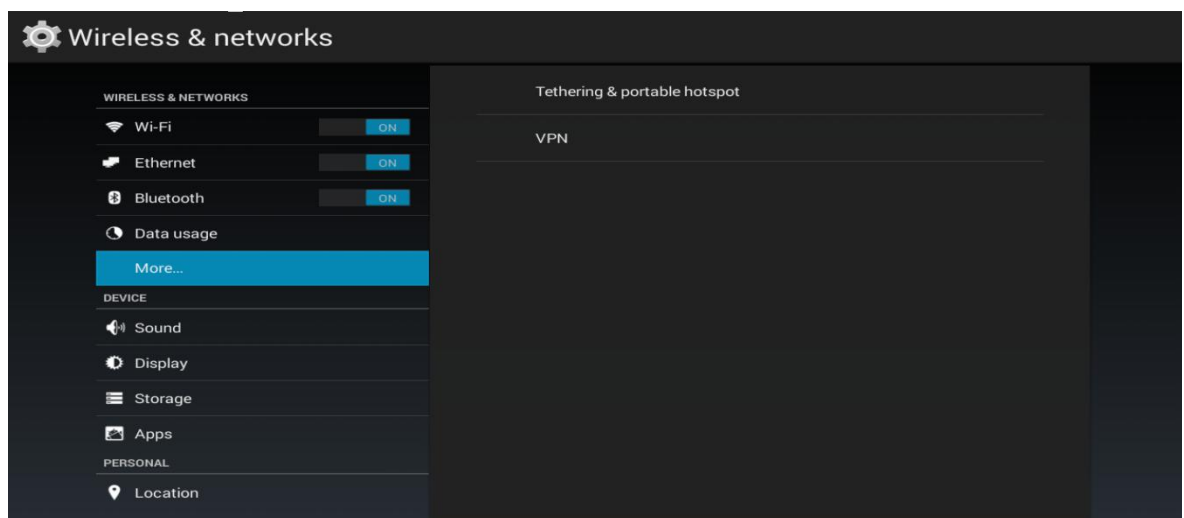


## Data usage

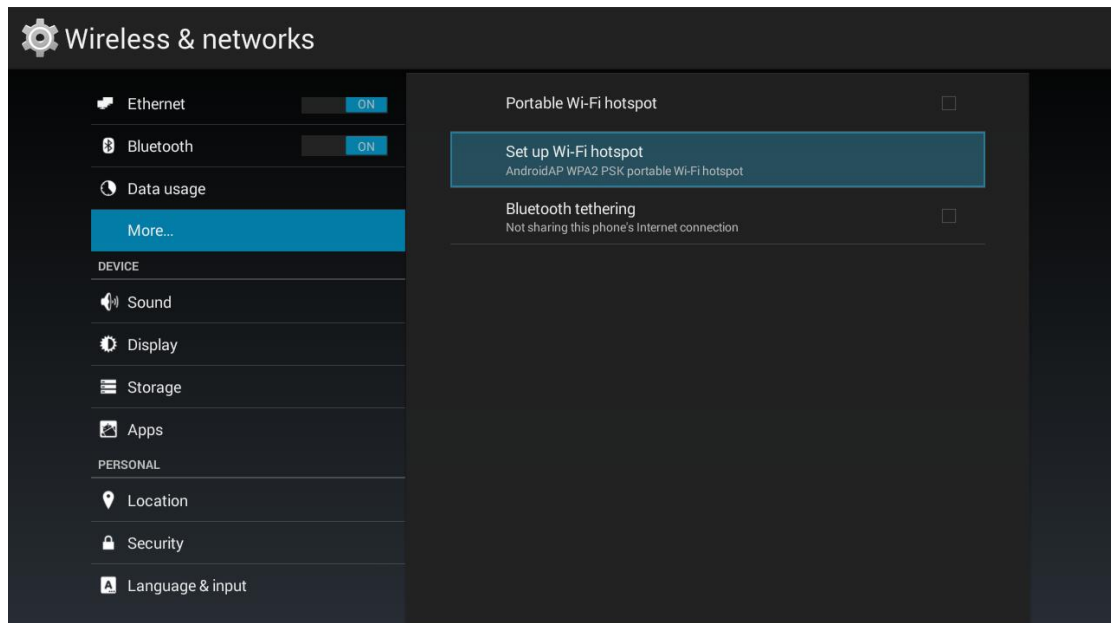
The network traffic data you used could be checked.

You can share your network through this device.

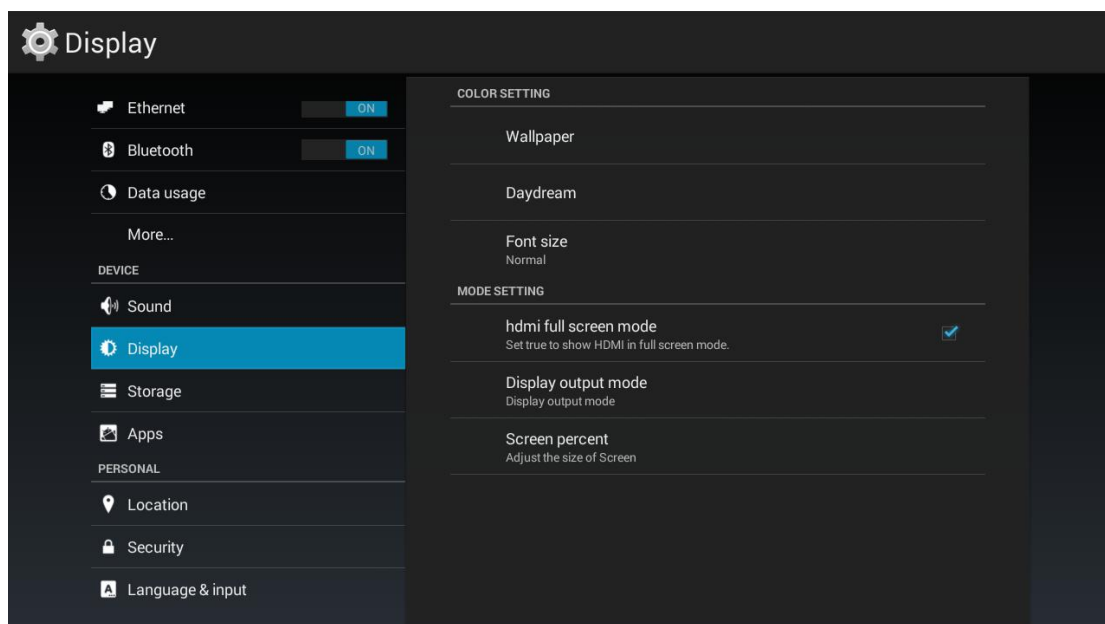


You can configure your Wi-Fi hotspot, or configure Bluetooth to share your network.

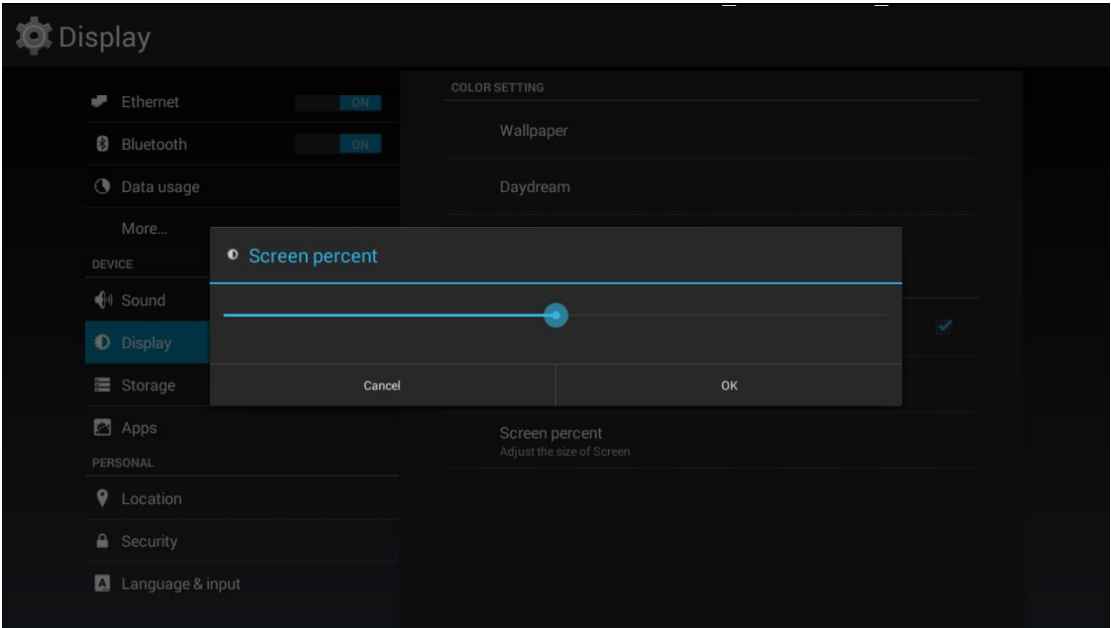


### 3.4.2 Display

You can configure your favorite wallpaper, font size, and so on.

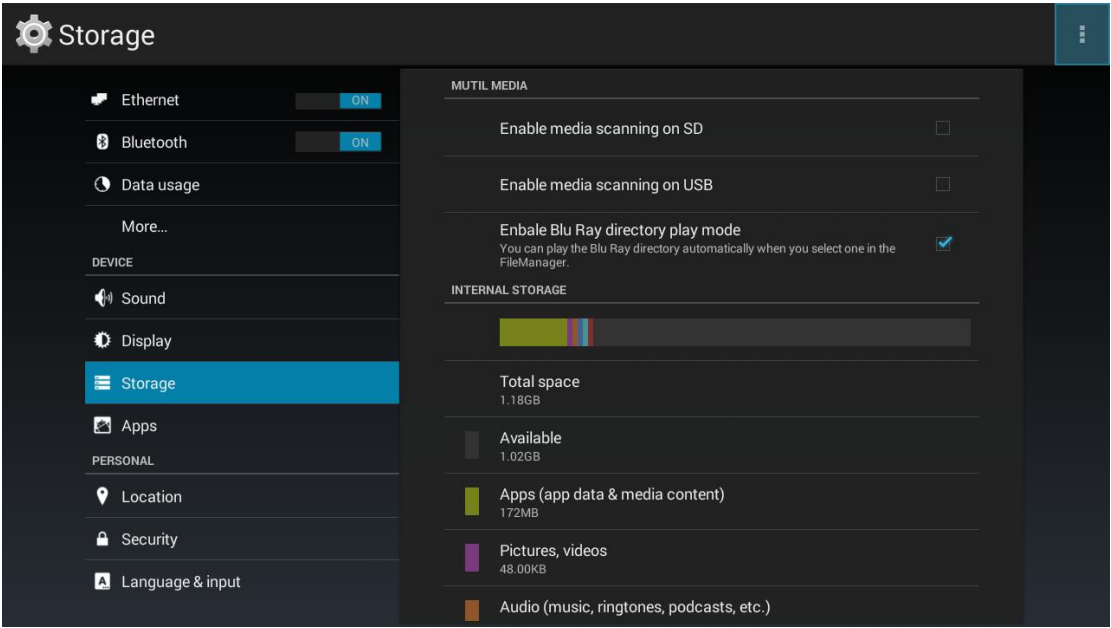


You can adjust the display ratio of the screen to achieve the best display.



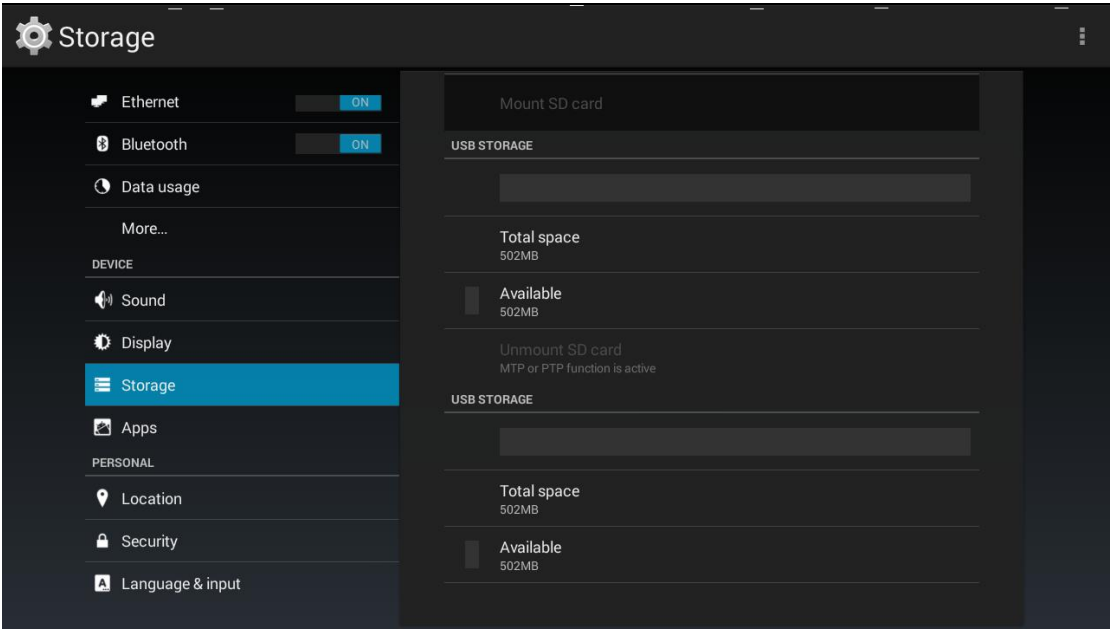
3.4.3Storage

You can view the device's memory information and usage, as shown below,



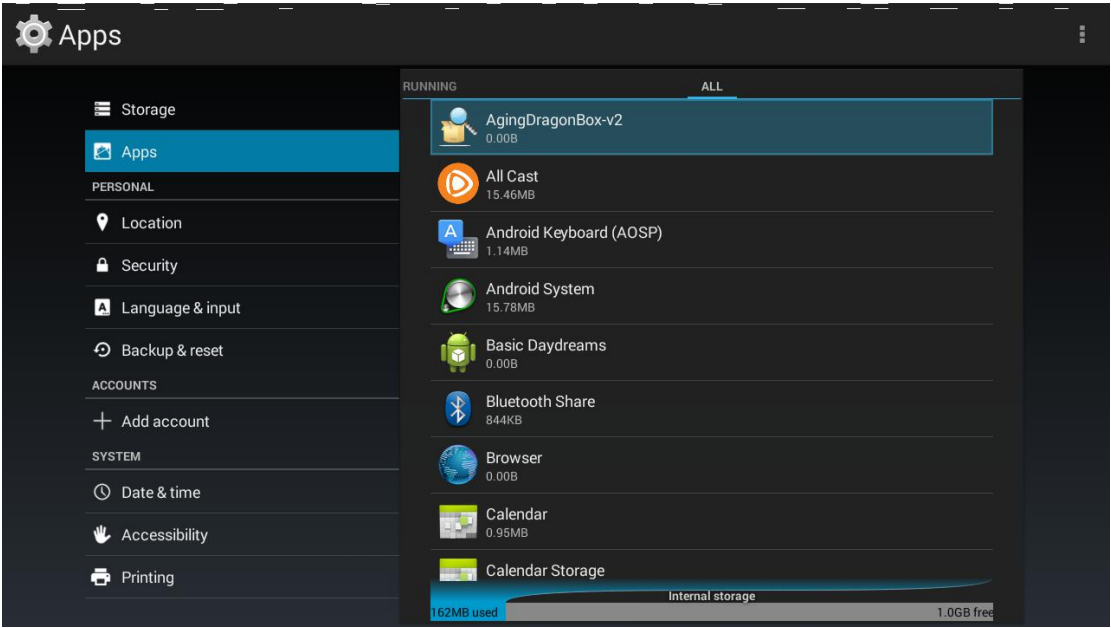
You can check the built-in storage capacity information, as well as the use of external storage device information.



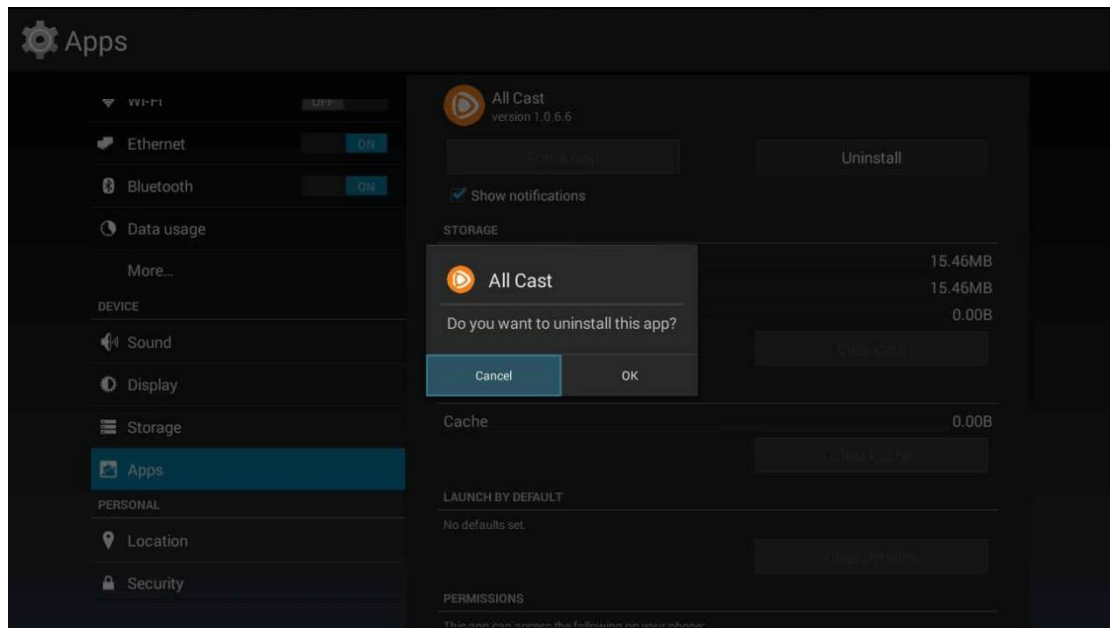


3.4.4 Application management

Your application information could be checked.

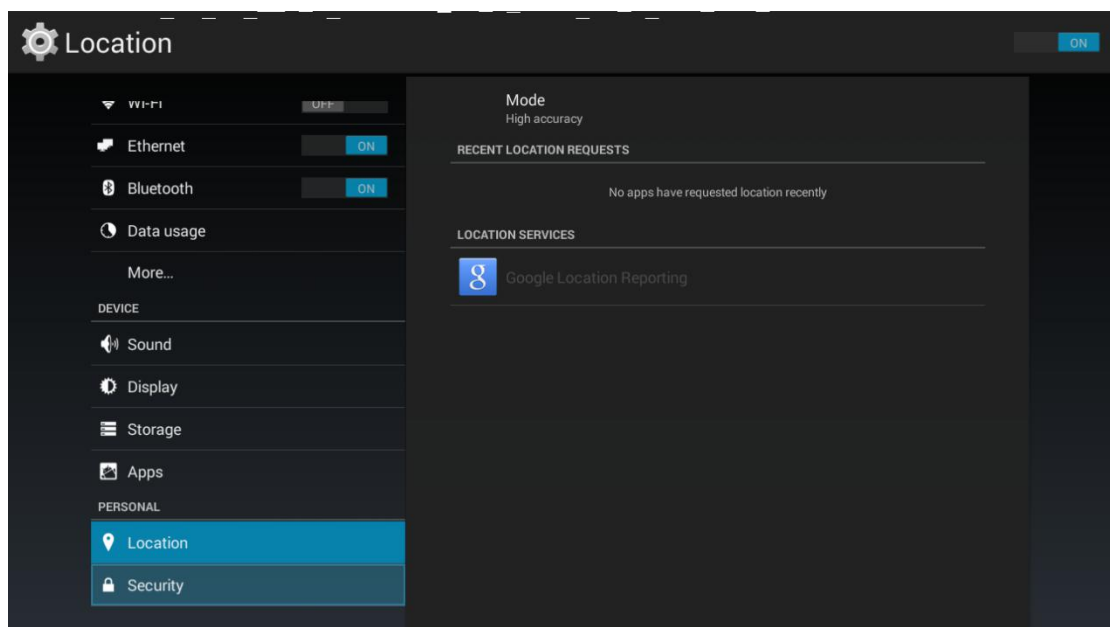


You can manage your application by installing or uninstalling.



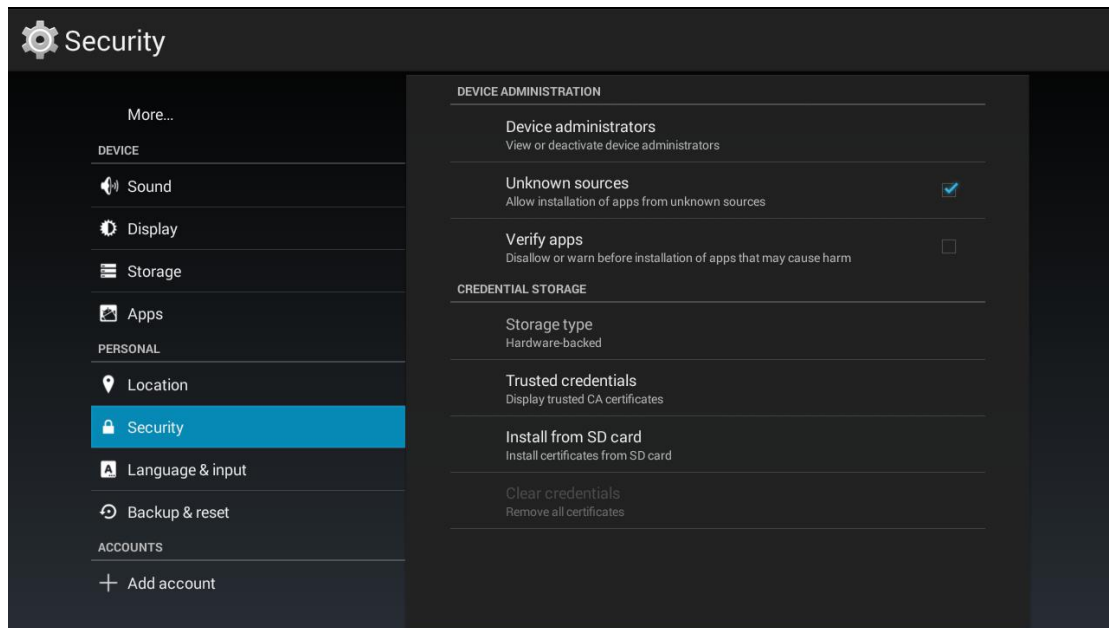
### 3.4.5 Location service

Open this service to share your location information, you can use Google Map, Baidu map, Auto Navi map and the other maps to check your current location through the network positioning.



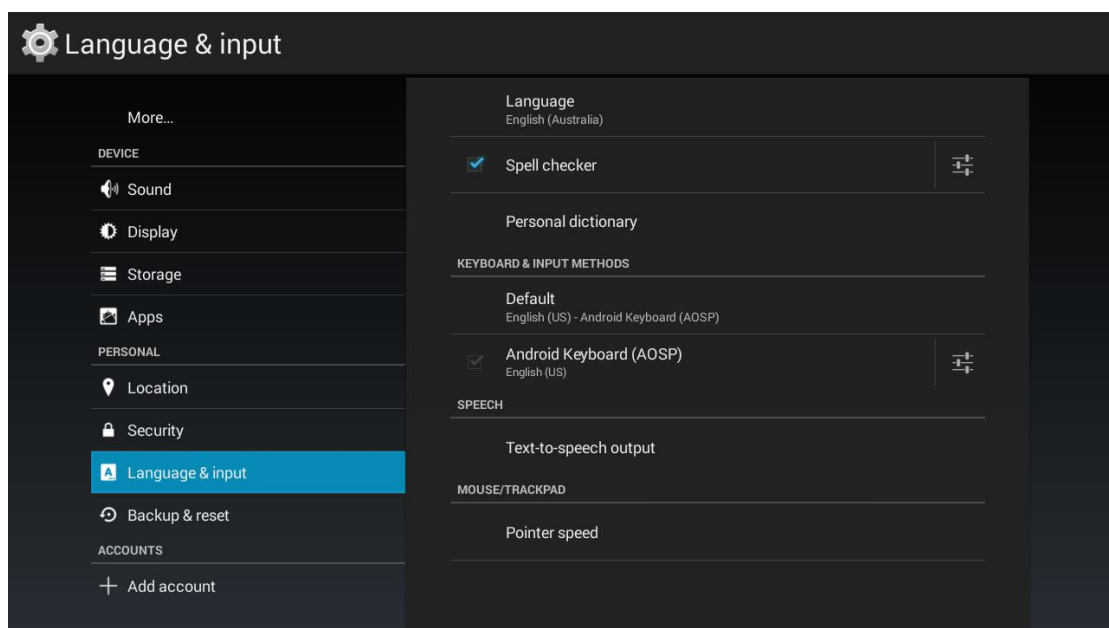
### 3.4.6 Security

Through the security services to ensure the system security and the application source.

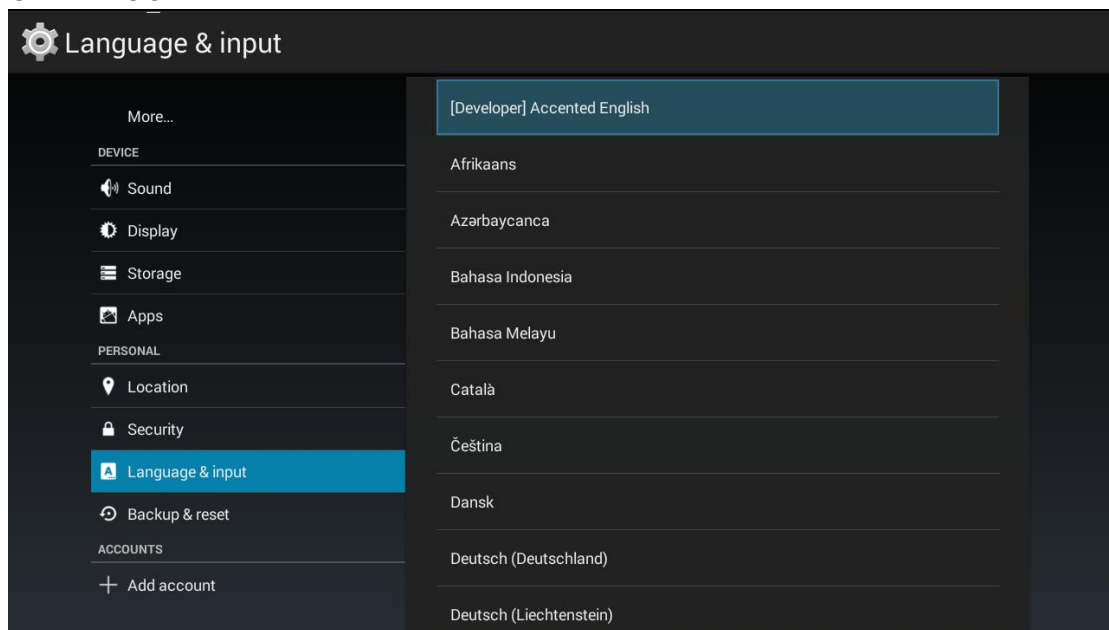


### 3.4.7 Language & Input

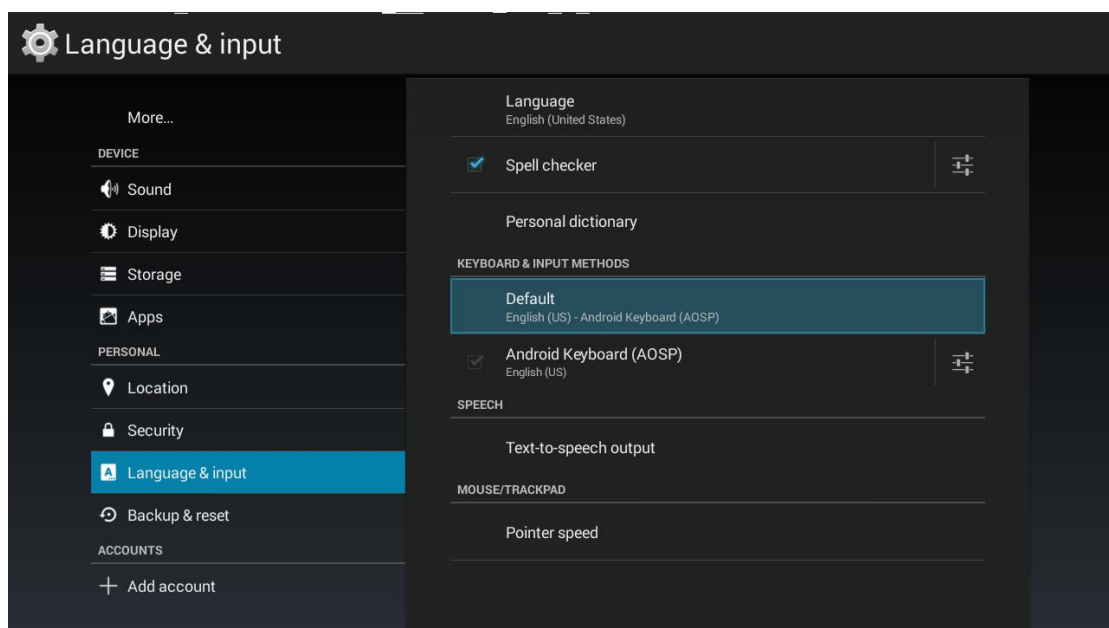
The system provides language configuration function and make it easy for users to use it quickly.



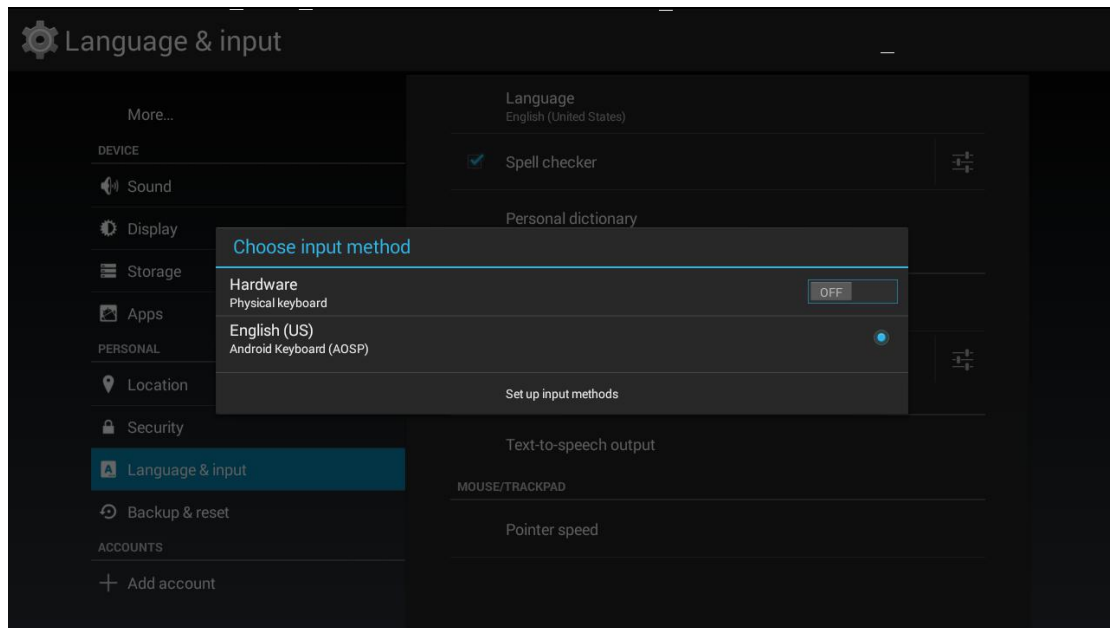
You can choose the language for your own system.



You can install the input method keyboard, the system defaults is the Android input method keyboard.

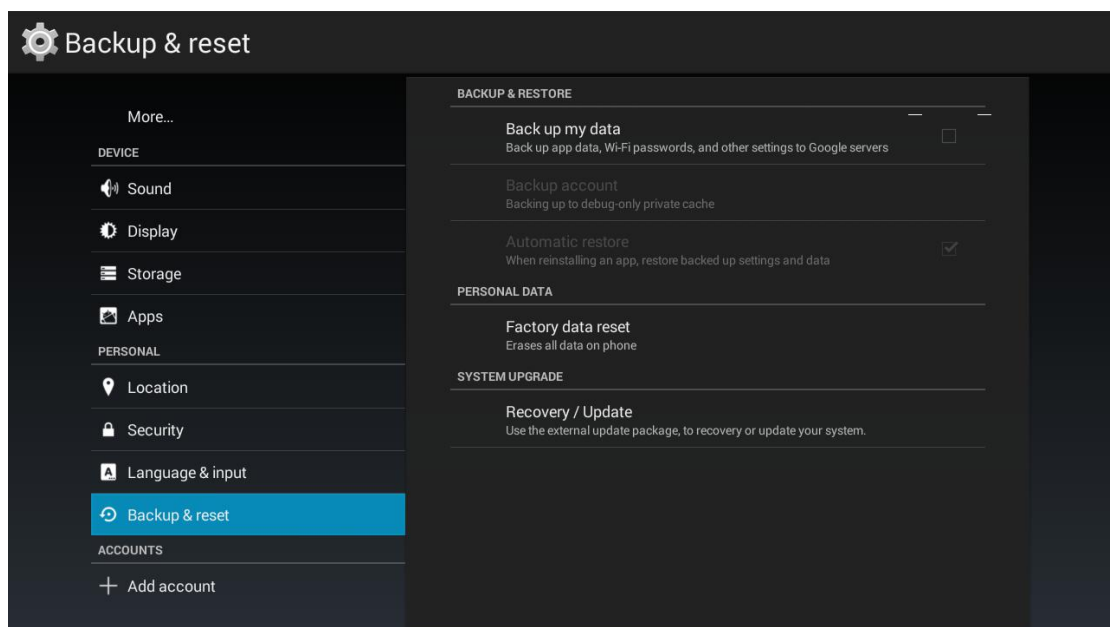


You can configure the installed input keyboard.



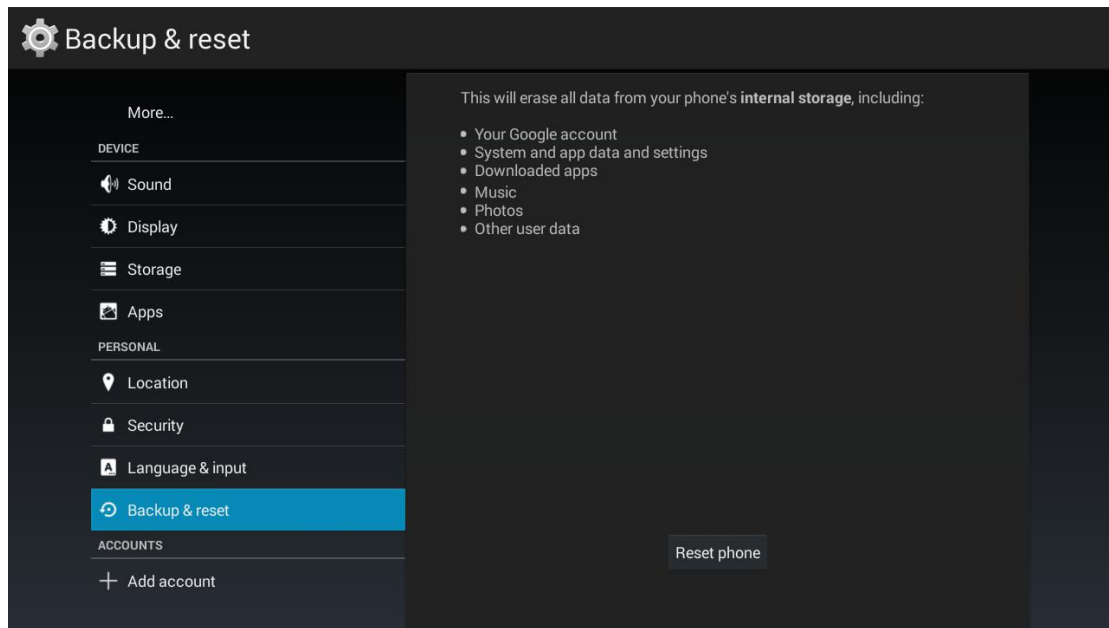
### 3.4.8 Backup & Reset

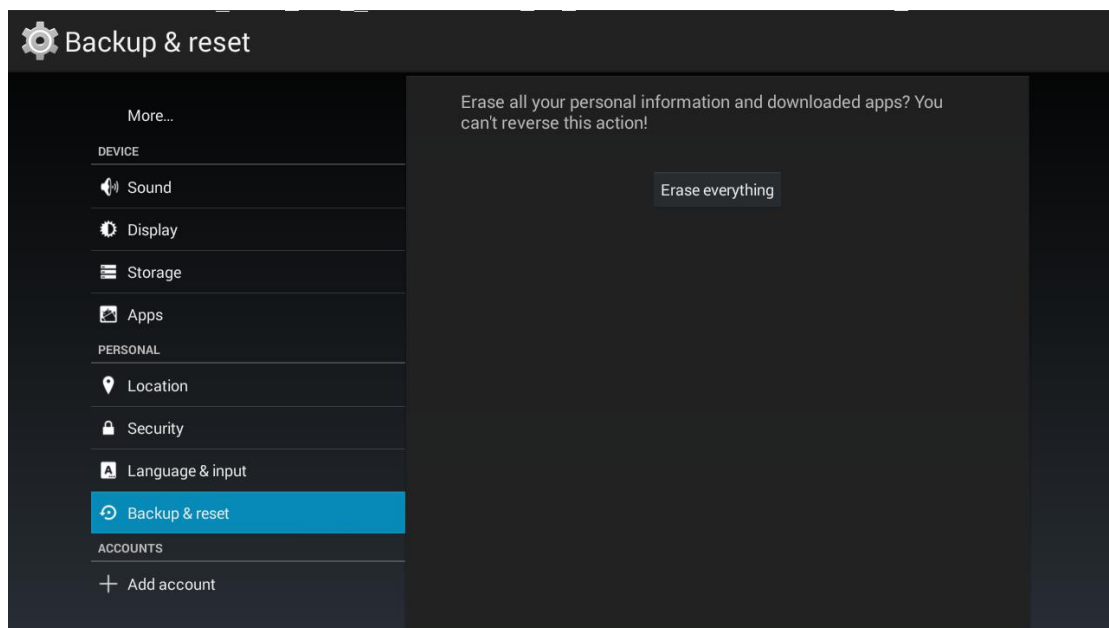


You can empty your Google account, restore your system and app settings by

restoring factory data.

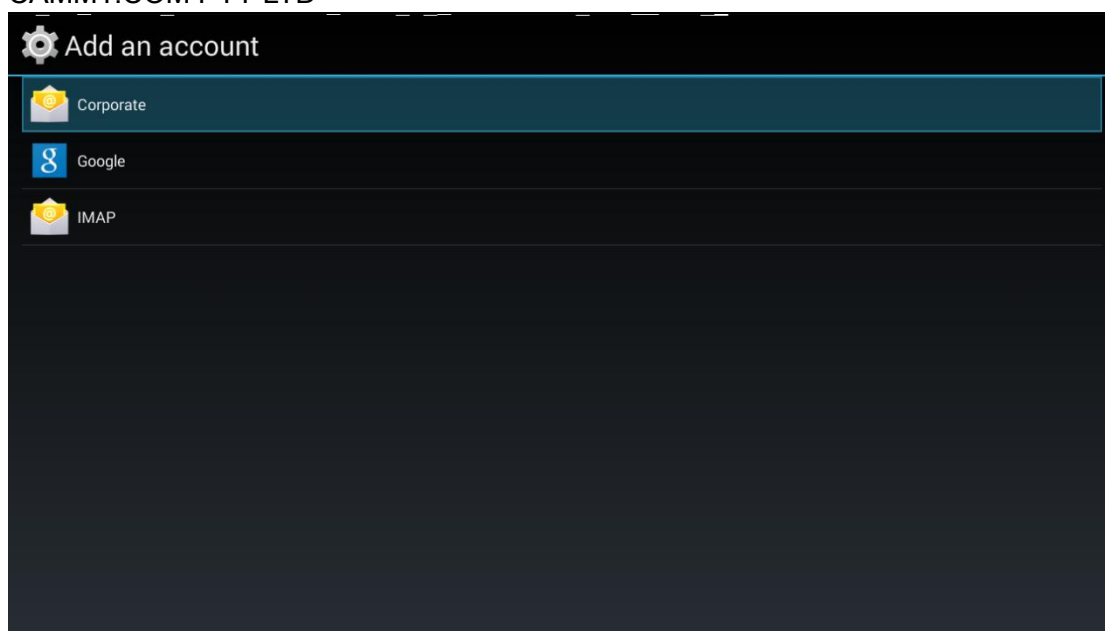


Choose to erase everything, the system will shut down and restart then enter the recovery mode.



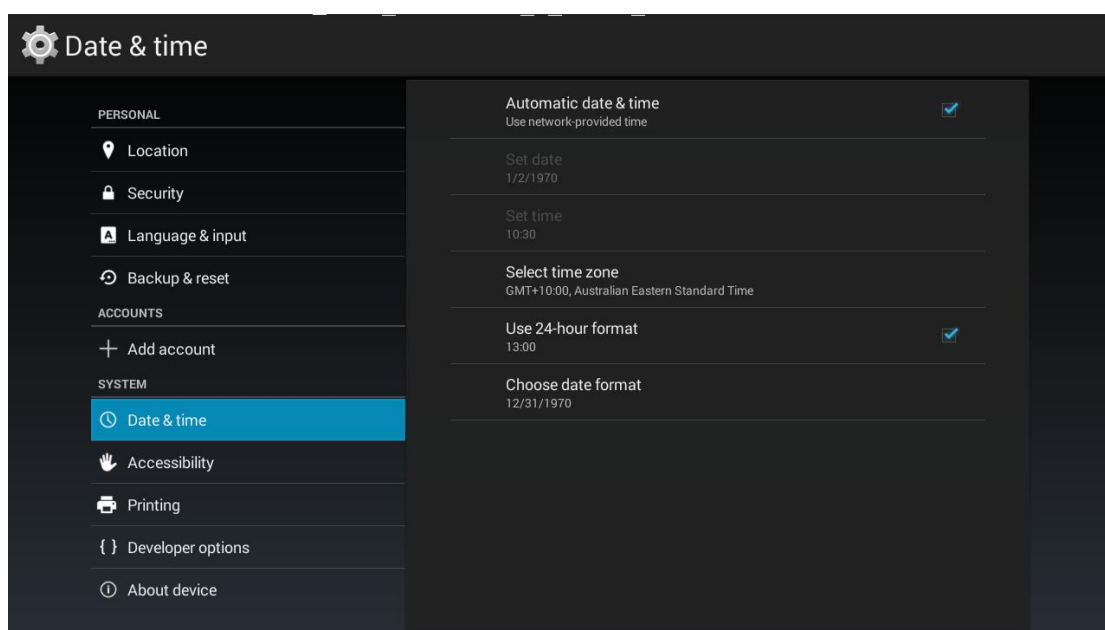
### 3.4.9 Add an account

You can add a Google account, email account and etc.



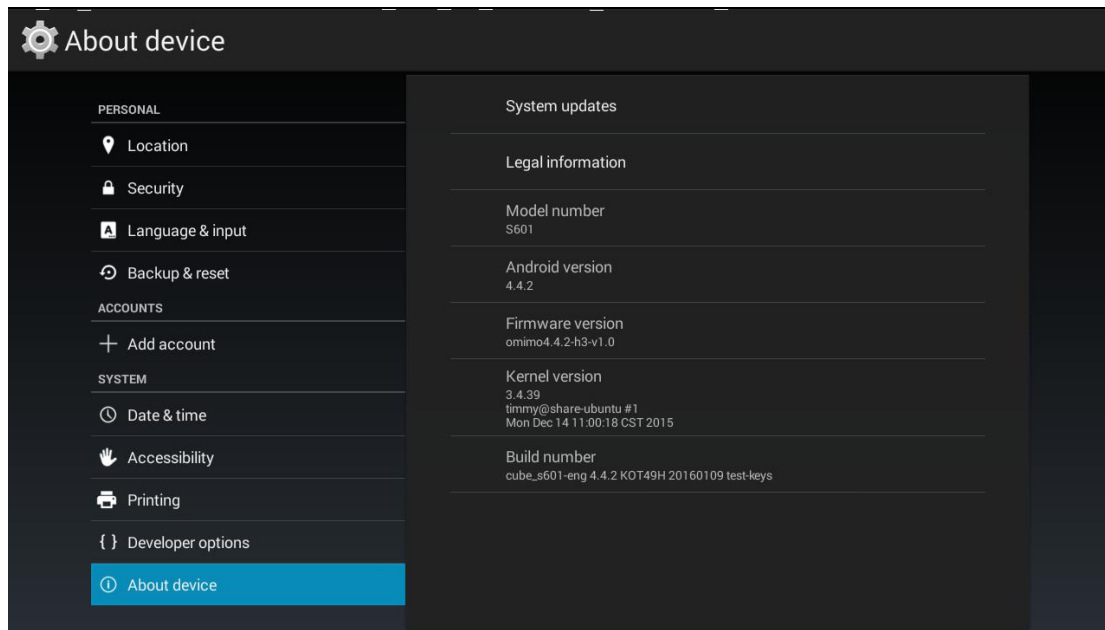
### 3.4.10 Date & Time
