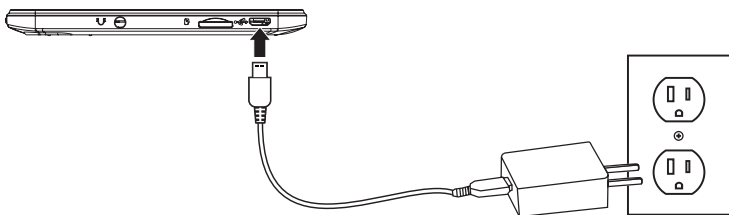
Using the Tablet

CHARGING THE BATTERY

It is necessary to charge your tablet before it can be powered on. The initial charge time is approximately 5 hrs. It is normal for the body of the tablet to become warm during charging and after extended periods of use.

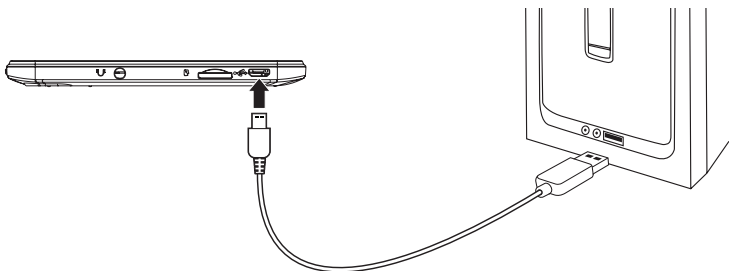
Charge the Battery with the AC/DC Power Adapter:

- » Connect the AC/DC power adapter to a standard power outlet and the Micro-USB port on the tablet.



Charge the Battery with the Micro USB charging cable and a PC:

- » Connect the charging cable to the USB port of a powered on PC and the Micro-USB port on the tablet. A window will appear asking how you want to use the USB connection, select "Charge this device" (for additional information on USB connections see pg. 18).



POWER BUTTON

The Power Button will power the tablet on, off, or put the tablet into Sleep Mode. Sleep Mode is a power saving mode that disables certain functions, namely, the screen. Your tablet will still do things like play music, and remain ready to use at a moments' notice.

Power Your Tablet ON

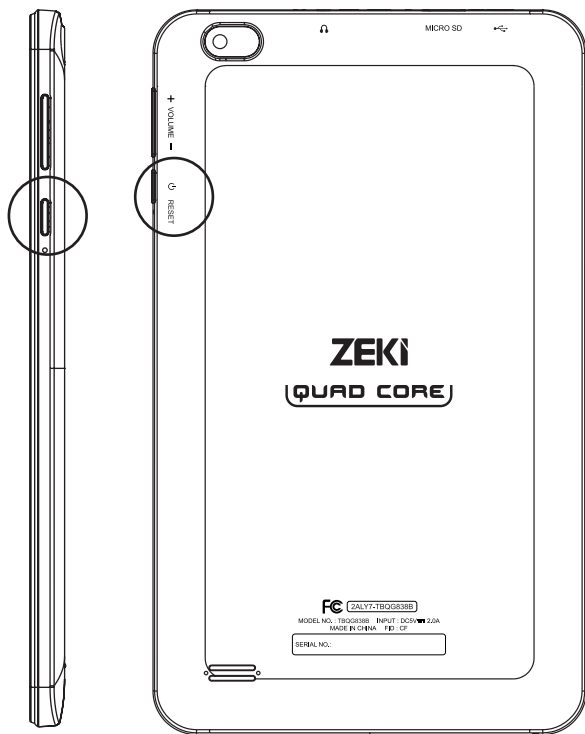
- » Press and hold the power button and wait for the screen to activate.

Put Your Tablet in Sleep Mode

- » Press the power button once to put the tablet to Sleep.

Power Your Tablet OFF

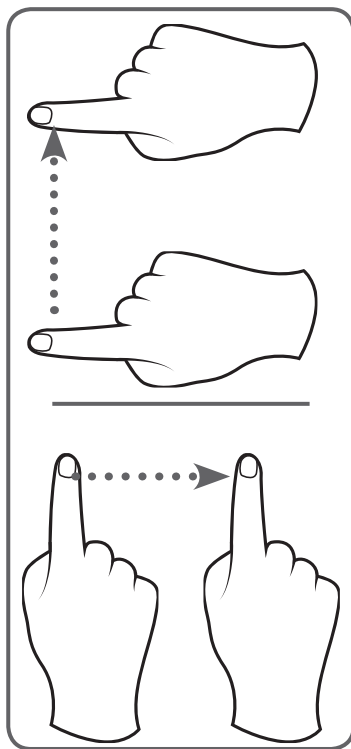
- » Press and hold the power button to turn the tablet OFF completely.

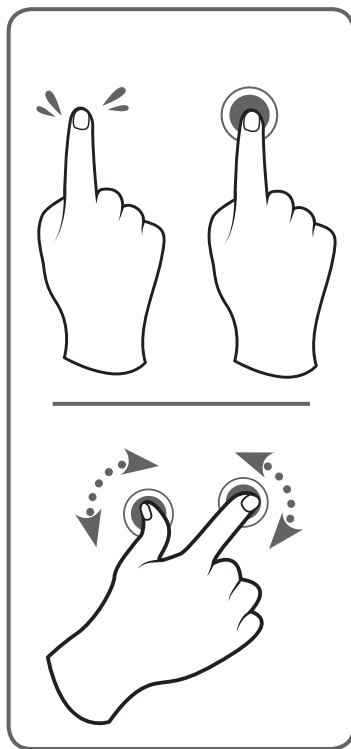
GESTURES

The screen on your ZEKI tablet is capable of accepting up to five points of contact at once, and by using these simple hand gestures you can interact with the tablet and its various functions.



Swipe

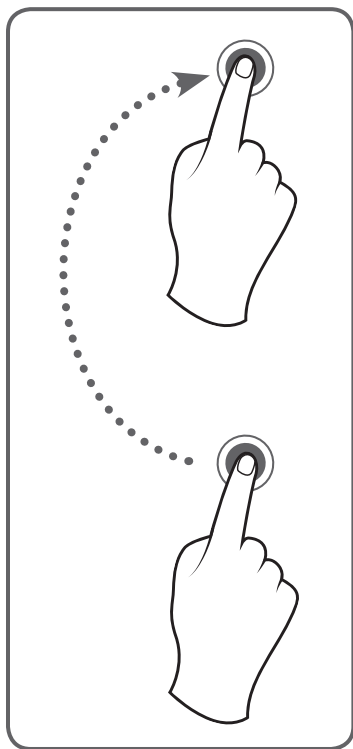
Touch and drag your finger in any direction on the screen.



Tap / Hold / Rotate

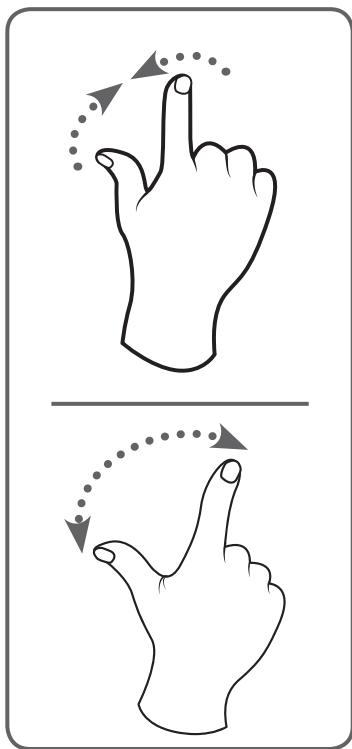
Briefly tap the screen to select an icon, item, or app. Press and hold to bring up menus or other options.

Hold and turn two fingers to rotate things like pictures and games.



Hold & Drag

Touch and hold any item on the screen, such as an app, to move it.



Zoom In / Zoom Out

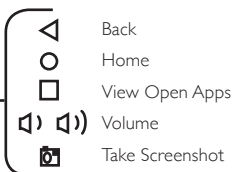
Touch the screen with two fingers and pinch in or out. In some cases, you can also zoom in and out by quickly tapping the screen twice.

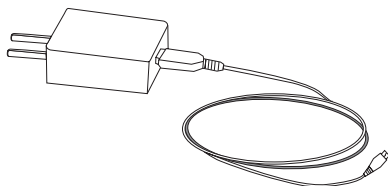

Using the Tablet

INCLUDED ACCESSORIES

AC/DC Power Adapter

Use the Power Adapter to charge from a standard power outlet.



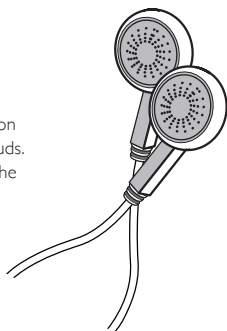
Micro-USB to USB Cable

Use the Micro-USB to USB cable to connect to a computer and transfer files or charge the tablet.



Stereo Earbuds

To avoid hearing damage, make sure that the volume on the tablet is turned down before connecting the earbuds. After placing earbuds in your ears, gradually increase the volume until a comfortable listening level is reached.



SCREEN ORIENTATION

Your tablet will automatically adjust from portrait to landscape mode as you rotate it.

You can disable this feature by dragging the **Quick Settings** tab down from the top right of the screen and tapping **Auto-Rotate**.

LOCK SCREEN & SECURITY

Disable the Lock Screen by dragging upwards anywhere on the screen. If you want to make your tablet more secure you can choose from several different options by going to **Settings > Security > Screen Lock**.

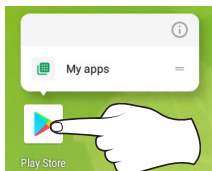
APPS

Downloading Apps

- » Press the Google Play Store app icon to search for and download new apps to your tablet.

App Information & Options

- » Press and hold an app icon, a fly out menu will appear to view app options, add widgets (if available), and information.



Press and hold to view app info

Adding Apps to Your Home Screen

- » Swipe upwards on any part of the screen, this will open the Apps Screen, which contains all of the apps installed on the tablet.
- » Press and hold an app, then drag it away from its current position. The screen will change back to the Home Screen and you can place it there.

Moving Apps on the Home Screen

- » Press and hold any app on the screen, then drag it to a new location.

Grouping Apps Together

- » Press and hold any app on the screen, then drag it on top of another app.

Removing an App or Widget from the Home Screen

- » Press and hold the app or widget and drag it to “X Remove” at the top of the screen.

Deleting Apps from Your Tablet

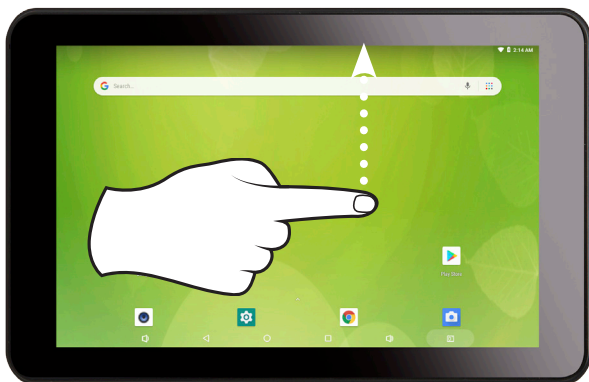
- » Press and hold the app icon of the app want to delete. When the fly-out menu appears, press Additional Info and press the button marked “Uninstall” to delete it from your tablet.

ANDROID OS UPDATES

The Android operating system may periodically be improved and updated. New versions of the OS may include bug fixes, security enhancements, and other new features. It is recommended to check for updates regularly and run the most current version of the software.

Check for Updates

- » Go to *Settings > System > System Update*

Wi-Fi & Internet

WIRELESS CONNECTIONS

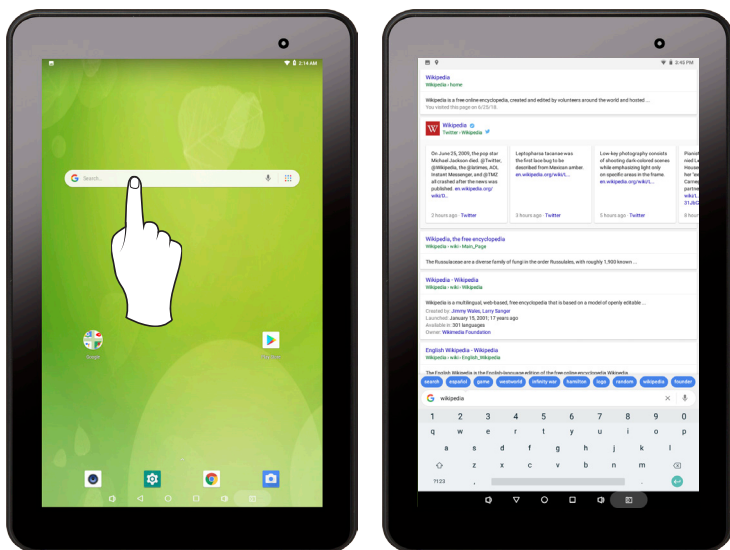
To access the internet or use other online services you must have the tablet's Wi-Fi enabled and connected to a wireless network or "hotspot". Your tablet will automatically guide you through the process of setting up your Wi-Fi connection when you activate it for the first time. Follow the guide and enter the correct information when prompted. It will be useful to have your router's ID and password on hand if you don't already know them.

Connect to a Wi-Fi Hotspot Manually

- » Swipe downwards from the top of the screen and press the  icon. Go to **Network & Internet > Wi-Fi**.
- » Be sure the Wi-Fi indicator is in the **ON** position, select the desired network from the list, and tap **Connect**. If the network is secured with a password you will be prompted to enter it using the keyboard.
- » Once completed, the display will show **"Connected"** under the name of the network, as well as the Wi-Fi signal strength.

GOOGLE SEARCH

- » Use the **Google Search Bar** for web searches. Use the keyboard to enter your search term and begin searching the web.





Camera

PICTURES, VIDEO & GALLERY


Your tablet is equipped with front and rear facing cameras for capturing images and video.

Taking Snapshots



- » Press the  icon from the apps menu or screen.
- » When you are ready, press  to capture the image.
- » After taking a photo, a small thumbnail of the image will appear in the corner of the camera view. Press the thumbnail to view the image and the gallery.

Taking Video

The camera takes still images by default, and must switch modes to take video.

- » While in camera mode, swipe right from the left part of the screen and select **Video**.
- » When you are ready, press  to begin recording video. Press again to stop recording.

Camera Functions & Options

- » Press  to switch between Auto and Night Mode light balance.
- » After swiping right to select Camera or Video, press  to adjust resolution camera resolution and other settings.

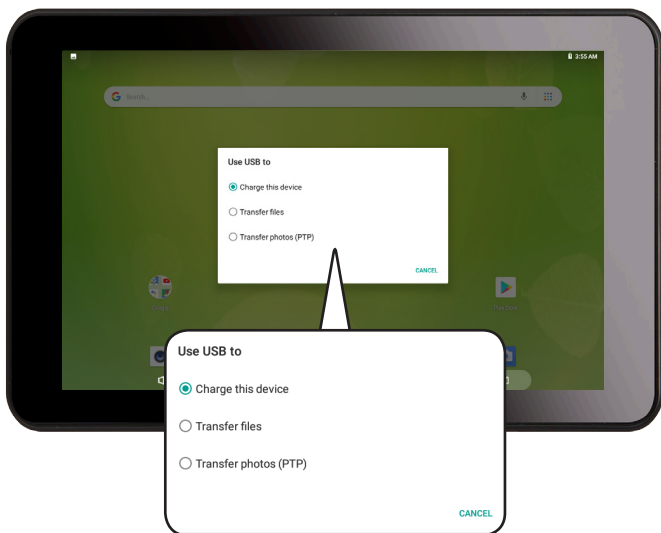
USB CONNECTIONS

Transferring files with a PC/Mac

- » Using a Micro-USB to USB cable (included), connect to the Micro-USB port on the tablet and a USB port on a computer.
- » A notification will appear on the screen asking how you want to use the connection (see image below).
- » Using the connected computer's file browser, you can now access and transfer files, photos and other media to or from the tablet.

Closing a connection to a PC/Mac

- » Select the tablet in the connected computer's file browser and **Eject** it to safely close the connection. This will reduce the risk of losing any data on both the computer and the tablet.
- » Unplug the Micro-USB to USB cable from the PC/Mac and the tablet.

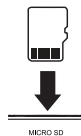


MICRO SD CARDS

The tablet will read Micro SD cards up to 256GB.

Connecting a Micro SD card

- » Insert a Micro SD Card into the Micro SD Card Slot on the top of the tablet.
- » The SD card will be detected automatically and a notification will appear at the top of the screen in the notification area indicating that it is ready to use.

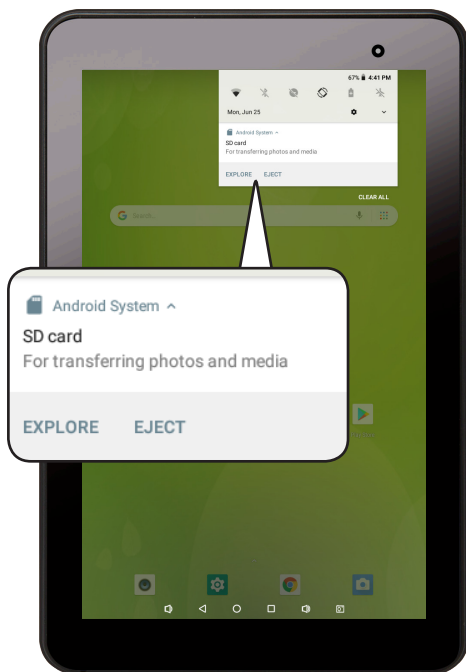


Accessing a Micro SD card

- » To view files on a Micro SD card, swipe downwards from the top of the screen and press *Explore*. This will open the file browser and the contents of the cards.

Unmount a Micro SD card

- » To safely unmount a Micro SD card, swipe downwards from the top of the screen and press *Eject*. It is now safe to manually remove the Micro SD card from its slot.
- » When the card has been unmounted it is safe to remove the card from the tablet.
