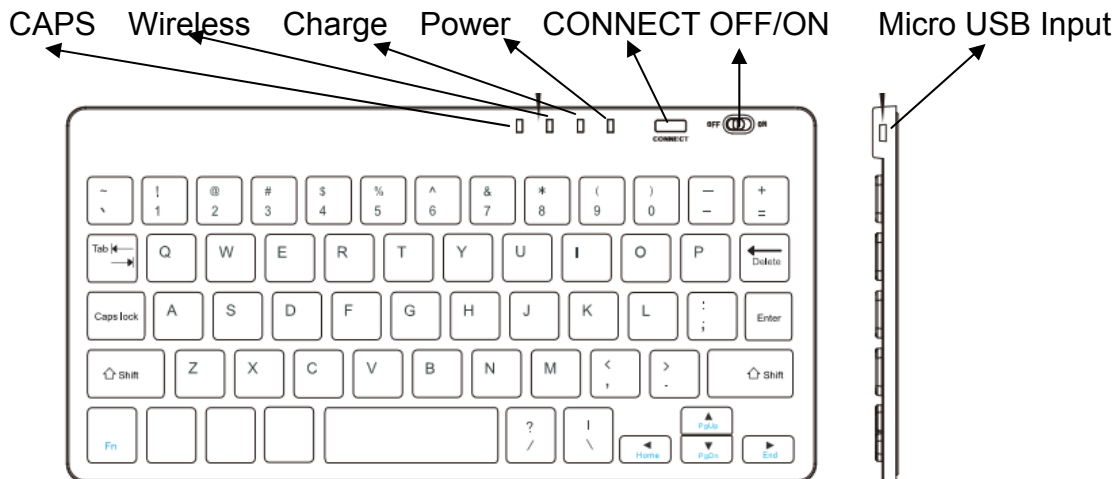




## Wireless Keyboard

HG190-1

**Set Includes: Keyboard, Tablet Stand, Stylus Pen and Micro USB Charging Cable**



### BATTERY WARNING

### Specifications:

1. Standard MICRO interface
2. Operating distance up to 10 meters (~33 feet)
3. Operation Voltage / Operation Current: 3.0~4.2V / <2.5mA
4. Standby Current / Sleep Current / Charging Current: <0.3mA / <40μA / ≥200mA
5. Standby time: >15 days
6. Charge time: <2 hours
7. Lithium battery capacity / Lithium battery life: 110mA / > 3 years
8. Operating temperature: 14 ~ 131°F (-10 ~ +55°C)

### Functions



Use OFF/ON switch to turn unit ON or OFF



When the unit is ON, press the CONNECT button to pair up the keyboard with your device (e.g. computer, Smartphone, tablet, etc.). Follow pairing instruction below.



**Power** Power light will turn on for four seconds and then turn off to save power. The keyboard remains on until it is turned OFF using the ON/OFF switch.



**Charge** Charging light turns on when charging the keyboard; turns off when fully charged.



**Wireless** **Wireless light:** When pressing the CONNECT button, the [wireless] light will blink; the light will remain blinking until the keyboard has been connected to your device.



**CAPS** CAPS light turns on when Caps Lock button on the keyboard is pressed. Press Caps Lock again to unlock caps.

### **Pairing with an iPad/ iPhone**

- Step 1: On the keyboard, slide the power button to the ON position. The POWER light will turn on for 4 seconds and then turn off to save power. Note: keyboard is still on.
- Step 2: Press the CONNECT button on the keyboard, the [wireless] indicator light will blink.
- Step 3: On the iPad/iPhone, turn Bluetooth - ON.
- Step 4: The iPad/iPhone will display “Bluetooth keyboard” as an available device.
- Step 5: Select “Bluetooth keyboard”; the iPad/iPhone will display a code.
- Step 6: Type the code on the keyboard and press enter; keyboard will now be paired to the iPad / iPhone.

### **Pairing with Tablets, Smartphones, Laptop and Desktop computers, etc.**

- Step 1: On the keyboard, slide the power button to the ON position. The POWER light will turn on for 4 seconds and then turn off to save power. Note: keyboard is still on.
- Step 2: Press the CONNECT button on the keyboard, the [wireless] indicator light blink.
- Step 3: Go to your “settings” screen on your tablet, laptop, Smartphone or other wireless –enabled devices and go to the wireless setting menu and activate its wireless function and search for the keyboard.
- Step 4: Once the “Bluetooth keyboard” has been found, select its name to connect.
- Step 5: Once the wireless keyboard has successfully been connected to your device, the wireless indicator will turn off.

### **Note:**

- Only one device can be actively paired at one time.
- After pairing for the first time, your device will connect to the keyboard automatically when the keyboard is turned ON.
- In case of connection failure, delete the pairing record from your device, and try pairing again.

### **Sleep Mode:**

The keyboard will go into sleep mode once it detects it is not being used; press any key and wait a

second or two to bring it out of sleep mode. This mode extends the life of the battery.

### **To Clean:**

Use damp cloth or alcohol wipes. Dry thoroughly.

### **Troubleshooting:**

1. Make sure the keyboard is on (the power indicator is ON).
2. Make sure the keyboard is in operating distance (within 10 meters/~33 feet).
3. Ensure the battery is has been charged.
4. Make sure the wireless function on the device is "ON."
5. Press the CONNECT key to check the wireless status.
6. Ensure keyboard has been paired with your device.
