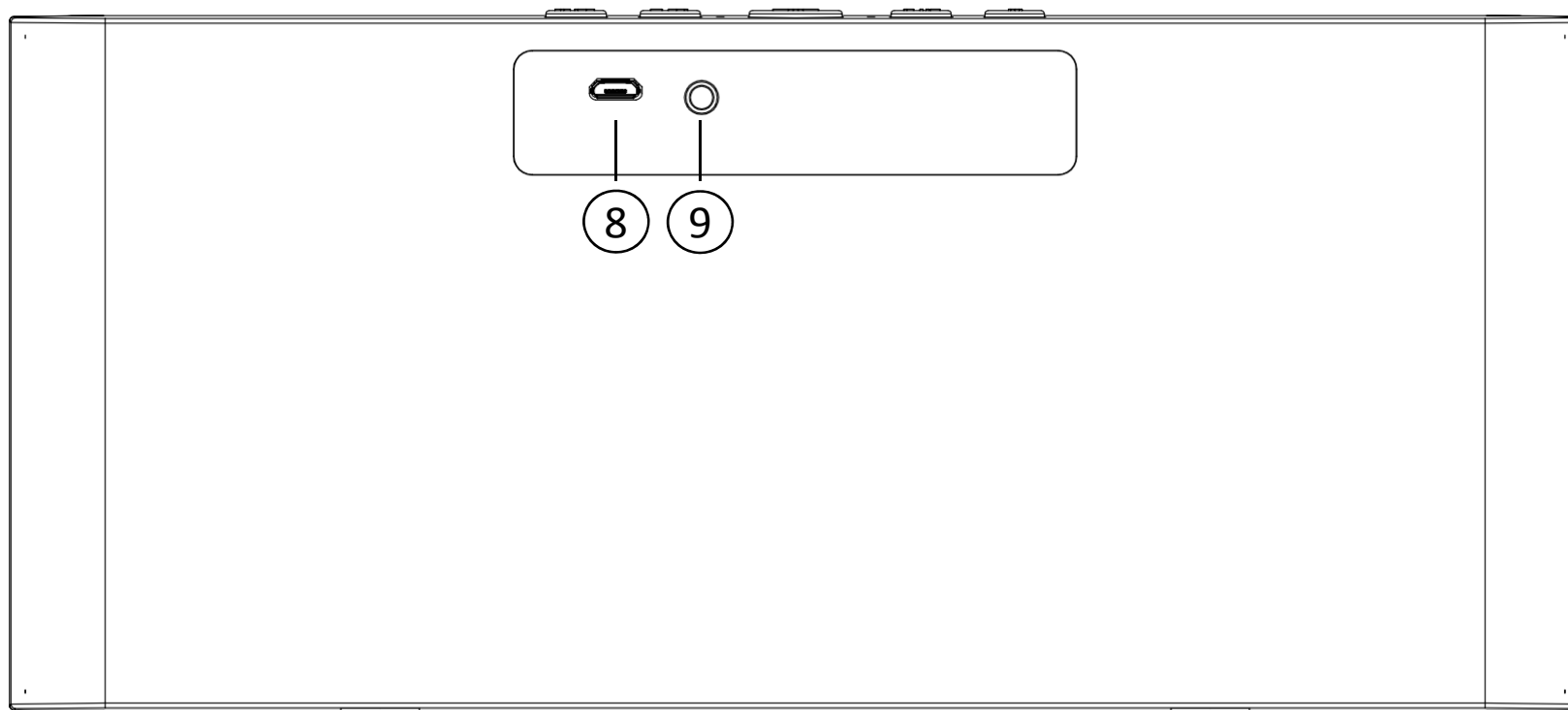
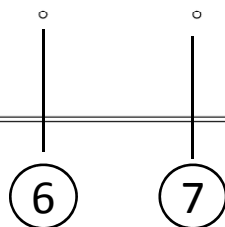
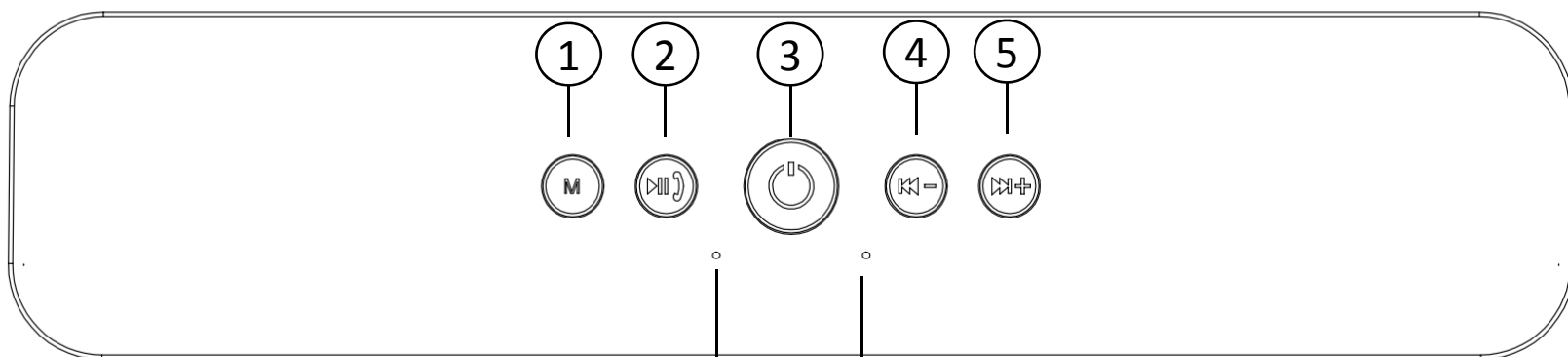
Thank you for purchasing the Wireless speaker . These speaker are designed to be convenient.

This prouduct is designed to provide high quality audio playback from most iPad,iPhone ,iPod , computer , PDA or other Bluetooth audio device .

This instruction booklet explains the basic operation of the unit . Please read them carefully and keep for future reference .

1. Mode- Short press **shift** to AUX/ Short press **shift** to Bluetooth
2. play/ pause /call –Short press to play/ pause current track
Answer/End Voice calls – Short press once to ANSWER.
Short press again to END
3. Power on/off – powers the speaker on and off
4. Volume – - Long press to decreases the volume level
Short press once to skip to the next track
5. Volume + - Long press to increases the volume level
Short press once to skip to the last track
6. High sensitivity microphone for voice calls
7. LED indicator light
8. Micro USB connection – for use with included micro USB cable
9. 3.5mm AUX input – for use with a direct cable connection to music device

Connections

Bluetooth Connection

Powered on, press the power button once and the LED indicator light will begin to glitter, Speaker is now ready to be paired. Next, enable the Bluetooth function on your Smartphone or other Bluetooth enabled device and hit scan for “B75”. When found choose it from the list.

If prompted to input a password insert 0000, once successfully paired select the “B75” from the list of paired device in order to connect. When the connection is successful, the LED light is bright

LINE IN

The Auxiliary line input port on the back of the speaker is used as a direct connection from Smartphones, MP3 players and other audio sources.

Guidelines for Built-In Battery

1. Connect the small end of the Micro USB charging cable to the charging port on the Speaker.
2. Connect the large end of the Micro USB charging cable to your computer's USB port or an AC adapter (not included).
3. When the speaker is charging , the LED indicator light is red
4. When fully charged, the LED indicator light is goes out.
