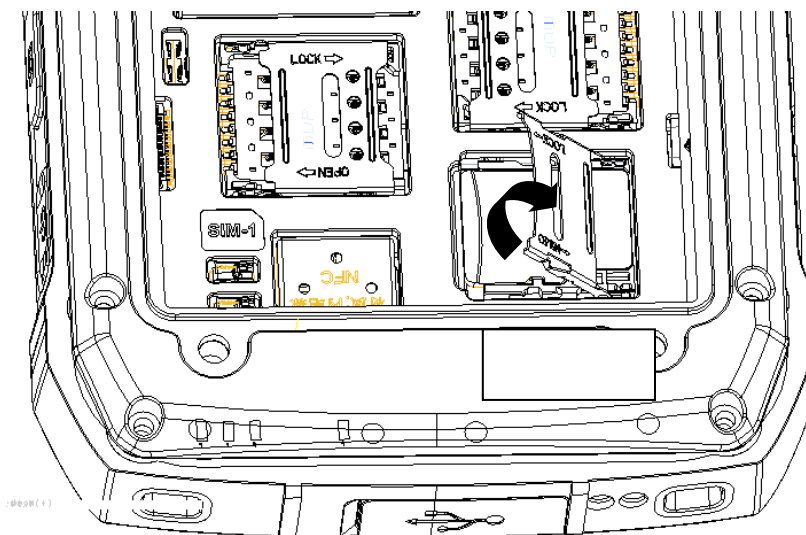

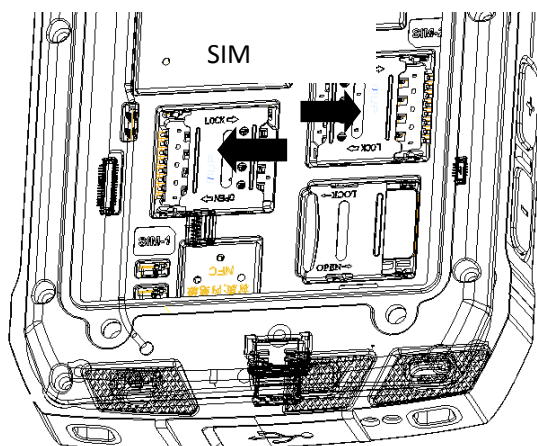

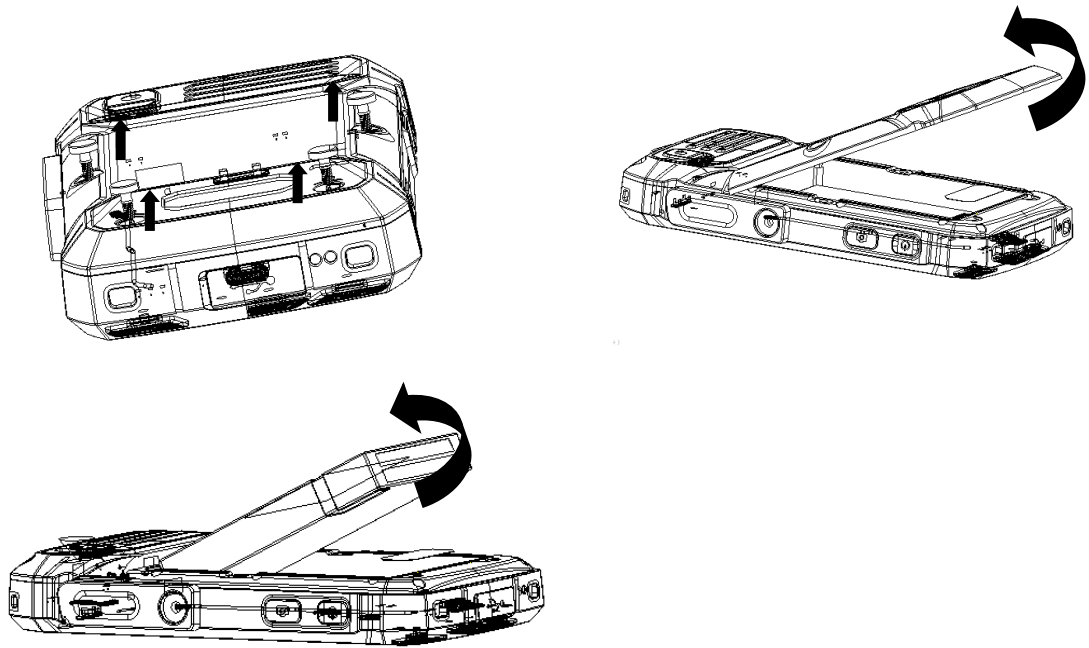

**Battery disassembly and assembly**



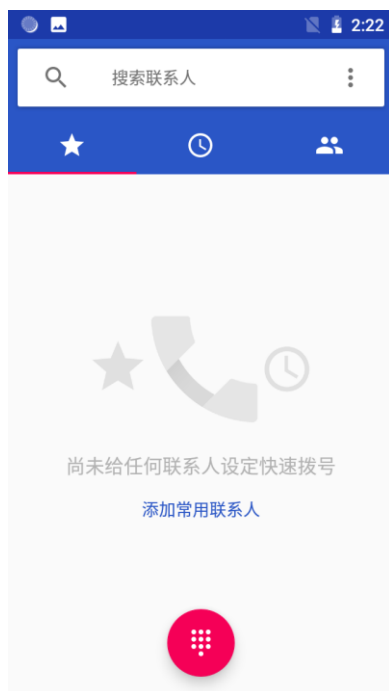

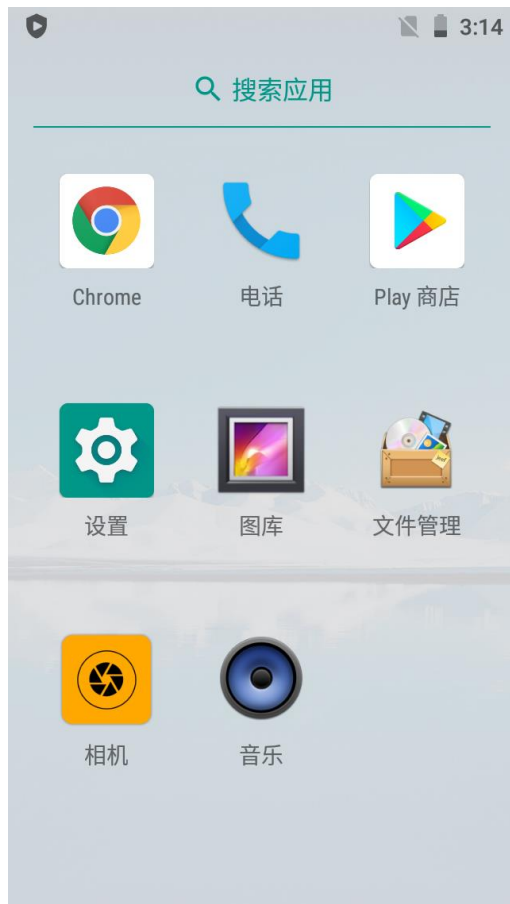

## Other functional parts

### Install memory card

When inserting the card, The side of the SD card with the chip facing down, pay attention to the direction of the gap, and push the card into the card slot.

#### **Note:**

1. Do not take it out when the device transmits or accesses informationSD card. Otherwise, it will cause data loss or damage, and even damage the memory card or device. The company is not responsible for losses caused by misuse of damaged SD cards, including data loss.
2. In replacement or disassemblyWhen using the SD card, please press the power button to turn it off before replacing or removing the SD card.
3. Maximum support for this machine64G SD card.

#### **Prompt :**

If used SD card-related functions are limited, please check or replace your SD card first.

### Install SIM card

When inserting the card, The side of the SD card with the chip facing down, pay attention to the direction of the gap, and push the card into the card slot.

### How to use the battery

#### Charging

1. Insert the charger plug into the device charger interface and pay attention to the direction.

2. Plug in the chargerStart charging on a 100~240V 50/60Hz power socket.
3. When charging,the battery level icon on the screen flashes; after charging is over, The battery level icon on the screen stops flashing.
4. After charging,unplug the plug from the device, and then unplug the charger from the power socket.

#### Charging time

1. If the AC power supply voltage is low, the battery will take a long time to charge ;
2. The charging time varies according to the specific situation of the battery ;
3. Charging with a non-standard charger such as a computer will extend the charging time ;
4. The operation will extend the charging time when charging.

#### **Note :**

1. The battery should be fully charged before the first use ; please disconnect the charger in time after the battery is charged. Long-term charging will cause damage to the battery performance. Make sure that the device is equipped with a battery when charging.
2. The ambient temperature range for normal charging of the device isFrom 0°C to 40°C, charging at ambient temperatures below 0°C or above 40°C will cause battery performance to decrease and life to be shortened. Charging at an ambient temperature that is too high or too low for a long time can cause damage such as insufficient battery charge or bulging battery.
3. When not charging, remove the charger from the AC power socket.
4. When the battery of the device drops to a very low level, charging the device may keep the screen black and will not turn on immediately. After charging for a period of time, it will turn on normally.
5. The charger is a safety device, please use a special charger for this model, and pay attention to safety when using it.

#### **Battery performance**

- The system environment, equipment settings, playing games, playing music, taking pictures, and using data services will all affect the standby time.
  - Making calls or playing games will consume more power than standby, and the standby time will be shortened.
  - The standby time in the unserviceable area is shorter than the normal standby time.
  - The performance of the battery varies with the state of charge, temperature, local network conditions, and the state of the background light.
- \* The specific time depends on the local network situation, user usage and mobile phone card situation.

### **Introduction to basic functions**

#### Power on and off

- Turn on the device: it is turned off and the battery has power. Press and hold the power button to turn it on correctly.
- Turn off the device: press and hold the power button on the standby interface to bring up the option interface, select "Shut down" .
- Restart : In the standby interface, press and hold the power button to bring up the option interface, select"Restart" .

### Power on and off

#### Lock

When the device is not in use, press the power button to lock the screen

When it is not operated for a long time, the device will automatically lock the screen.

**Unlock** : Swipe up when the screen is on to unlock it.

### Use the application

If you want to open an application, tap its icon on the screen.

- Return to the main screen: click the main screen button at the bottom of the display
- Switch to another screen: Swipe the screen left or right.
- Switch recently used applications: click the Recent tasks button.

### Make a call

Click the dial pad, enter the phone number, and press the call button. If you want to end the call, click hang up on the call interface..

## Main functions

### Dial

Click to enter the dial pad interface.

Click the number key to enter the phone number, and click the dial icon to call the number.

#### Smart dial

You can use the smart dialing function to quickly find contacts. To find a contact person, for example, Li Ming, you can directly enter the first pinyin letter of each character in the contact's name LM, that is, the number key 56 is obtained, and at the same time, all phone numbers containing the number 56 can also be searched.

After entering the number, click the dial icon to call the number.

### Contacts

The contacts is Address book of personal and business contacts with you , store the related information.

#### New contact

In the contact list interface, click "New", add contact, You can choose to add contacts to the phone or card. Enter the corresponding records in turn.

#### Note:

Excessive number of contacts may affect the speed of the system, The number of contacts is related to the local storage space.

### Browser

Click to enter the browser, enter the URL in the edit box, and you can quickly connect to the Web page. Click on the five-pointed star to select bookmarks and view historical records. Bookmarks have built-in multiple



commonly used web addresses, and you can click to directly enter the Web page.

#### Browse the web

Master real-time information, follow the focus information, open your browser, and the world is in front of you.

1. On the home screen, click Enter the browser.
2. Enter the URL in the address bar at the top of the browser. The device will automatically retrieve and list similar WEB addresses.
3. Click on the url you want to visit to open the corresponding webpage.

#### Custom homepage

You can set commonly used websites as homepage. In this way, every time you open the browser, the homepage will be displayed for easy browsing.

1. On the home screen, click Enter the browser
2. Click Menu icon,choose " Set up-General-Set up homepage" .
3. In the pop-up options menu, click the webpage you want to set as the homepage.

#### Clear browsing history

In order to better protect personal information and prevent information leakage, it is recommended that you clear your browsing history regularly.

1. On the home screen, click Enter the browser.
2. Click Menu icon,choose "Settings-Privacy and security. "
3. Click "clear history"
4. Click"Ok"

#### Note:

1. You can use your browser to access the Web and web-based applications. If necessary, please consult your Internet service provider on how to connect.
2. Using this feature may result in related data traffic charges, please contact your network service provider for details.

#### Video

Enter to view stored inVideo files in SD cards and phones.

Click the video to enter the video playback interface, and click the soft button of the player to pop up on the screen.

#### Note:

File format that can support playback : 3gp, mp4, etc.

#### Gallery

Enter to view stored inPictures and video files in SD cards and phones.

Swipe left and right to browse the pictures in the folder

Use your thumb and index finger to open or close to zoom in or out of a single picture.

#### Camera

With the camera that comes with the device, you can easily take photos and record video clips.

#### Take pictures:

In the camera preview interface, click the button to take a picture.

#### Video recording:

Turn on the camera and swipe the screen to the left to switch to video mode.

Click  start shooting , Click  Then stop shooting. during shooting click  Can take pictures , Click  stop taking pictures.

## Message

Click the information icon to enter the information list interface.

Write a message

In the information interface, click "Write a message" , enter the write a message interface.

- Click the number edit box to enter the number directly.
- Click Input Content" edit box,edit the information content
- Click@Pop-up menus: emoticons, photos, photos taken, quick replies, contacts, topics, schedules, and timed text messages.
- Click the icon of the card and select the card you want to use.
- Click "Send" sends a message.

## Music

Click to enter the music library interface, the options are as follows :

1. All songs: View a list of all songs.
2. Folder : View the folder directory where the music files are located.
3. Artist:Divide the song types according to the artist's name.
4. Album:View songs by album name.
5. Genre:View different genres.
6. Playlist:View current playlist and saved playlist.

Click on a song to enter the media player interface, click "more" Pop-up menu :

- Music library: View local music library files.
- Add to playlist: Add this track to the playlist.
- Set as a ringtone: Set the track as a ringtone.
- Sharing :Share files via email, Bluetooth, or messages.
- Delete:Delete this track.

In the song playback interface, press the side button to adjust the volume.

Note:

File format that can support playback : mp3, amr, mid, etc.

## More tools

### Calendar

View calendar schedule

Create schedule

1. In the calendar interface, click "New", enter the My calendar editing interface, and start editing the schedule content.
2. Enter the theme of the event: you can enter the name of the event, the start and end time, describe the location of the event, etc.
3. Click "done" , Save the schedule file.

## Clock

### Alarm clock

#### Set an alarm

On the alarm clock interface, click "More—Settings" to personalize the alarm clock function :

Alarm style, automatic stop alarm, re-ringing interval, alarm volume, set the default ringtone.

Add alarm clock

On the alarm clock interface, click "Add alarm clock" , you can add more alarm clock entries.

#### Turn on the alarm clock

1. Click to select the alarm clock entry to enter.
2. Set the time, repetition, ringtone, vibration, snooze, and label of the alarm clock.
3. Click "save" Save the alarm settings.

#### Note:

1. In the state of shutdown, the system will automatically turn on before the alarm is reminded to perform the alarm service.
2. To ensure the effect of the alarm, please do not set the device to silent mode.

### Stopwatch

Click "Start" , the stopwatch timing starts ;

Click "Record" , record the current time ;

Click "Stop" , timing is paused ;

Click "Reset" , all records return to zero.

### Countdown

To set the time, click "Start" , the countdown starts.

### Clock

click "Add city" , click Add other city, and you can view the time of other cities in the "Clock" interface.

## File management

File management is like a personal assistant that can be carried with you, making it easy for you to manage files and folders.

View the documents stored on the phone.

You can also view different menu files by browsing by category.

## Resource sharing method

### Connect WLAN network

Click "Settings-WLAN" , enter the WLAN settings.

When turned on the WLAN, the list shows the available wireless networks. Click on any network. For encrypted networks, you need to enter a password and click Connect. The open network can be automatically connected . When the network status is displayed as connected, it can be used.

### Connect to Bluetooth function

click "Settings-Bluetooth" , enter the Bluetooth settings.

Click to turn on the Bluetooth function, click "Search for devices" , the device will search for and display a list of Bluetooth devices, click on the name of the device you want to pair, a dialog box will pop up and click

"Pair" . After the pairing is successful, the file transfer can be performed.

**Prompt :** Drop down the status bar to turn on the shortcut switch, you can quickly turn it on or off Functions such as WLAN and Bluetooth.

### USB Shared network

1. Use USB Wire to connect the device to the computer
  2. On the the main screen, click to enter the settings menu, and in wireless and network settings, click "More-network sharing-USB network sharing".
- Use USB network sharing, sharing the mobile network connection of the device with the computer via USB. After connecting to the computer, the device is used as a wireless network card connection.

#### Remarks :

1. This function requires a computer for Only systems above vista can be used.
2. When a computer accesses the Internet through a device, it uses the device's permission to access the network. If the device's Internet access channel needs to calculate the Internet access fee, these fees will be recorded in the device's account. Please consult your service provider for specific charges.

### Set up WLAN Hot spot

1. On the main screen, click to enter the settings menu, and in wireless and network settings, click "More-Network Sharing-portable WLAN hotspots", turn on portable hotspots.
2. Click "Set up a WLAN hotspot" , enter the user name in "Network name " , set the password for the WLAN hotspot, and click " Save".
3. After searching for this hotspot using another device, enter the password you set to use it.

#### Remarks :

1. Before turning on network sharing, please turn on the data connection first. The data shared with it is the mobile phone data of the machine. Use it with caution.
2. The signal strength of the hotspot is related to the compatibility of the device you are using, etc.

## How to install and uninstall software

#### Install :

1. Find the downloaded application installation package (extension) in file management apk).
2. Click the application installation package, if it pops up "Disable installation" , please select the settings according to the prompts, open "Security" , select "Unknown Source" , if you agree, select "OK" , then return to the application list, click on the application, and select "Install" .
3. After the installation is successful, start and run the installed application in the main menu.

#### Uninstall :

1. Enter "Settings>Application Manager" ;
2. Enter the application you want to uninstall and click "Uninstall"

#### Note :

Smart equipment It has an open application software. This function is limited to personal applications and is not for commercial use. When installing professional functional applications for commercial use, professional

## **Special note on dual SIM dual standby single pass**

This communication device adopts The " dual-sim, dual-standby, single-pass" design means that if two card numbers be inserted at the same time, voice services cannot be used at the same time, and data Internet services cannot be used at the same time. When one of the card numbers is in a voice call, the other card number cannot answer the call. If there is a call from the other card number at this time, you may hear "The call you dialed is not in the service area" , "The user you dialed is temporarily unavailable, please dial again later" and other prompts that cannot be connected.

The above situation is caused by the "dual SIM, dual standby, single pass" design, it has nothing to do with the operator's network status. Single pass is because this device is designed with a single chip, which can greatly improve standby time and reduce power consumption. It is recommended that users consult their local operators to activate relevant services to avoid the problem of missed calls without reminders in the scenarios mentioned above.
