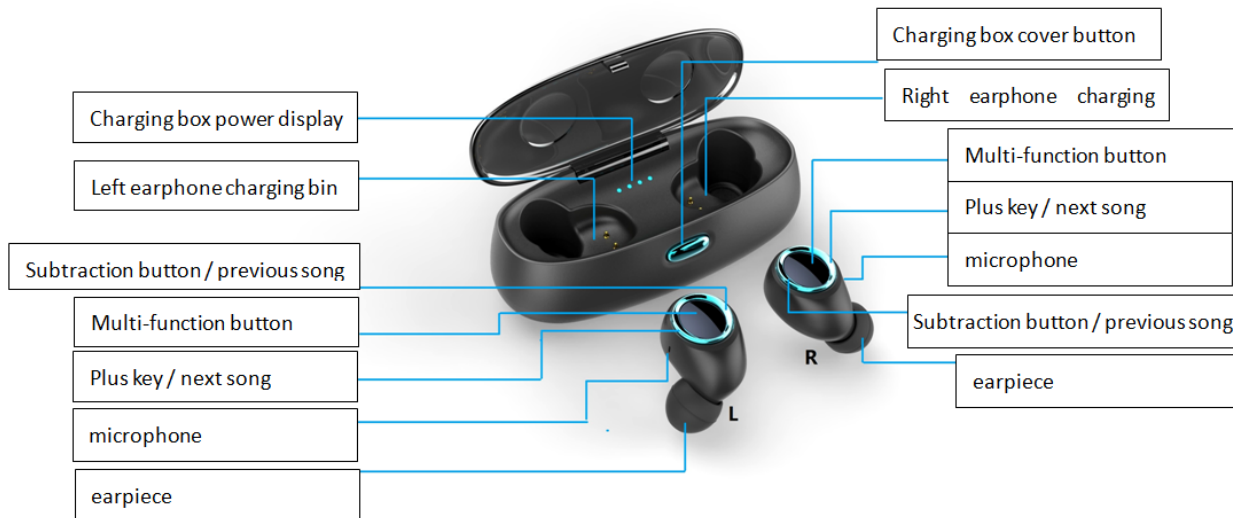


Wireless bluetooth headset user's manual

(Automatic team version)

Overview



Wireless bluetooth headset function operation

1. Power on: Automatic boot - the headset is taken out of the charging box, the headset will automatically turn on, the blue light flashes 3 times and is accompanied by a "boot" prompt. Manual start-up - press and hold the MFB button for about 3 seconds, the blue light flashes 3 times and is accompanied by a "boot" tone.

2. To the ear interconnection: the two headphones will be automatically connected after the headset L and the headset R are turned on separately, accompanied by the "left channel" and "right channel" prompts.

When the two headphones are connected, the two headphones will change from the original blue to a green and red light. At this point, the headset enters the connection mode with the mobile phone.

3. Pair with the phone: Open "Settings --- Bluetooth --- Click to connect "TS008" in the phone. After connecting the phone to the earphone, the ear

The alternately flashing red and green lights will change to a separate flash of blue light with a "connected" tone.

4. Music play/pause: Connect with the phone to open the player. Press the FMB button once to play the music. Repeat the operation to pause the song.

5. Play the next song: When the headset clicks the "Plus" button while playing the song, it will automatically play the next song in the phone.

6. Play the next song: When the headset clicks the "Zero Reduction" button while playing the song, it will automatically play the next song in the phone.

7. Increase the volume: Press and hold the "Plus" button while talking or playing audio, the volume will increase by 10% per second.

8. Decrease the volume: Press and hold the "Zero" button while talking or playing audio, the volume will be decremented by 10% per second.

9. Answer the call: Click the FMB button once in the incoming call state.

10. Hang up the phone: Click the FMB button once in the call state.

11. Last number redial: When the mobile phone is connected to the Bluetooth headset in standby mode, double-click the FMB button once.

12. Reject the call: Double click the FMB button in the incoming call state.

13. Cancel dialing: Short press the MFB button in the dialing state.

14.Siri/Voice group player: Press and hold for 1.5 seconds in standby mode or listening to songs. After hearing the “beep” sound, you will activate the phone's Siri (iphone).Voice Assistant (Android). After hearing the activation tone of the phone, you can speak the voice command.

15. Automatic connection: After the headset is connected with the mobile phone, and the Bluetooth of the mobile phone is turned on, the Bluetooth is turned on again after the headset is turned off, Bluetooth Automatically connect back to Bluetooth; when the headset and the phone leave beyond the signal distance range will be disconnected, within 3 minutes Bluetooth will automatically connect back to about 5 meters.

16. Low battery alarm: When the earphone is lower than 20%, it will flash red light for 5 seconds, and there will be a “low battery” tone for 5 minutes.

17. Low power shutdown: When the headset is lower than the normal working power, the headset will automatically shut down, the red light flashes with a “shutdown” tone.

18. Shutdown: Manual Shutdown - long press the MFB button for about 5 seconds, red flashes 3 times and there is a prompt "shutdown" tone.

(The headset will automatically shut down when it is not connected to the phone and other Bluetooth devices within 3 minutes)

Bluetooth headset stand-alone function operation:

1. Single machine boot into pairing: Bluetooth headset long press MFB button for about 5 seconds after power on until the red and blue lights alternately flash with "boot" and "pairing" prompts, the Bluetooth headset will enter the pairing state;

2. Pair with mobile phone: Open “Settings --- Bluetooth --- Mobile phone Bluetooth will display “TS008” in the phone --- Click to connect When the "TS008" phone is connected to the headset, the red and blue lights on the back of the earphone will flash to change to a blue light There is a "Connected" tone.

3. Play the next song: When the headset clicks the “Plus” button while playing the song, it will automatically play the next song in the phone.

4. Play the next song: When the headset clicks the “Zero Reduction” button while playing the song, it will automatically play the next song in the phone.

5. Increase the volume: Press and hold the “Plus” button while talking or playing audio, the volume will increase by 10% per second.

6. Decrease the volume: Press and hold the “Zero” button while talking or playing audio, the volume will be decremented by 10% per second.

7. Answer the call: Click the FMB button once in the incoming call state.

8. Hang up the phone: Click the FMB button once in the call state.

9. Last number redial: When the mobile phone is connected to the Bluetooth headset in standby mode, double-click the FMB button once.

10. Reject the call: Double click the FMB button in the incoming call state.

11. Cancel dialing: Short press the MFB button in the dialing state.

12.Siri/Voice group hands: Press and hold for 1.5 seconds in standby mode or listening to songs. After hearing the “beep” sound, you will activate the phone's Siri (iphone).Voice Assistant (Android). After hearing the activation tone of the phone, you can speak the voice command.

13. Shutdown: Press and hold the MFB button for about 3 seconds, the red light flashes and there is a prompt "shutdown"



How to charge the headset battery

1. Put the headphones L and R into the charging and “L”, “R” corresponding charging, and then close the cover of the charging box to enter the charging mode.
2. When the headset is charging The indicator light of the headset is red. The headset is fully charged and the headset indicator is off.
3. While charging the headset, the charging box indicator will show the power of the charging box, 100% power “●●●●” 75% Battery “●●●” 50% Battery “●●” 25% Battery “●”

. Safety Precautions

Use headphones when driving, please follow the regulations of your country and region.

Keep all equipment and accessories out of reach of children's pets. Ingestion of parts may result in suffocation and serious consequences.
