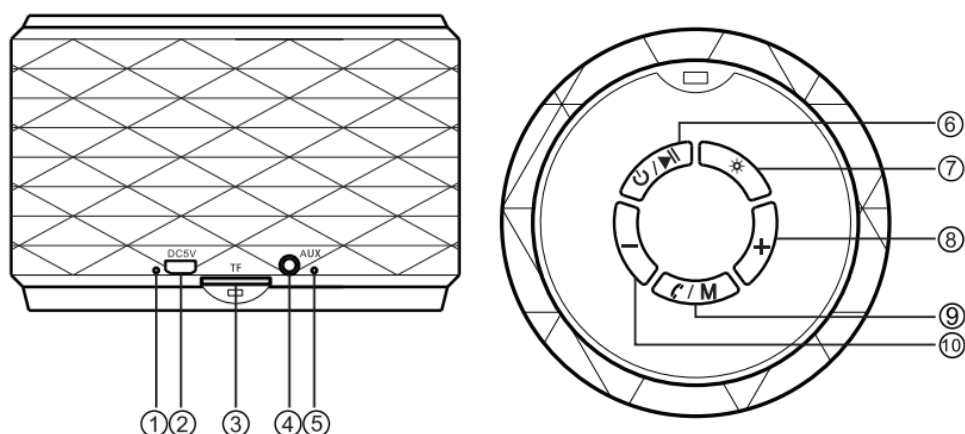

Functions

Instructions for use

1	Mode	Bluetooth/TF/AUX
2		Press the icon to return to the previous track; Hold the icon to decrease the volume
3		Press the icon to return to the next track; Hold the icon to increase the volume
4		Press the icon to answer phone and
5	Mic	Mic
6	TF card slot	Push the TF card into the slot to play the music
7		Press get into the LED status


Charging instruction

The speaker comes with a built rechargeable battery.

Before using it for first time it is recommended you charge the battery fully.

Use USB cable connection and charge the item. The LED indicator illuminates red color while the speaker is being charged. When the battery is fully charged, the LED indicator will be off.

Pairing the speaker with Bluetooth devices (Phone or music device)

- Long press the  to power on and get into the pairing status with info sound.
- Place the speaker and Bluetooth device (phone or music device) no further than 20 feet apart.
- Activate the Bluetooth function on your Bluetooth device (phone or music device). Please refer to the manufacture's instructions for information about enabling Bluetooth on your device.
- Once you have activated Bluetooth on your device, select the pairing name from the list of available Bluetooth device.
- Once pairing has occurred, you will hear a tone, indicating that pairing was successful.
- You can now start to use the speaker.
- Once you have paired the speaker with a device, the speaker will remember this device and will connect it automatically when the speaker is in Bluetooth mode and the Bluetooth activated and is in range. Do not need to re-pair any previously connected devices.
- The speaker will attempt to automatically connect to the last device it was paired when Bluetooth mode is turn on. If you want to pair it with a new device, please turn off the last Bluetooth device, then use your new device to search for and select the pairing name of the speaker.

Storage

Turn off the power when the product is not in use; Clean and store it safely.

This equipment has been tested and found to comply with the limits for a Class B digital device, pursuant to part 15 of the FCC Rules.
