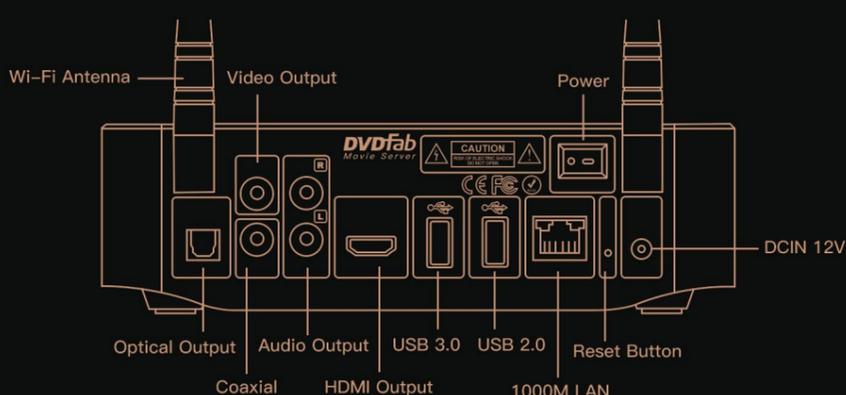

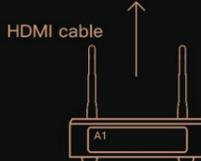

## Interface Introduction



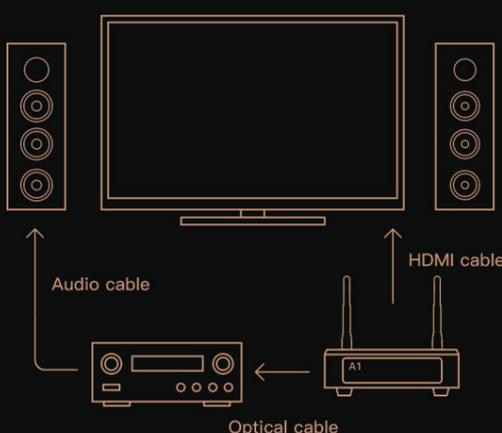
## Quick Setup

1. Power off all your devices;
2. Connect the Movie Server to the TV with an HDMI cable;
3. Plug in the power adaptor and the Ethernet cable;
4. Insert your HDD into the extraction cabinet;
5. Power on the Movie Server and then the TV to start enjoying.



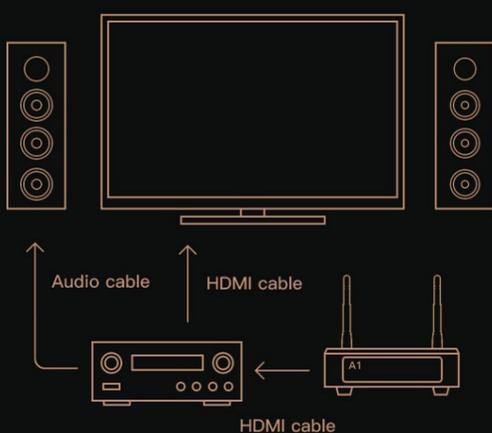
## Amplifier Setup

1. Power off all your devices;
2. Connect the Movie Server to the TV with an HDMI cable;
3. Connect the Movie Server to the amplifier with an S/PDIF optical cable;
4. Plug in the power adaptor and the Ethernet cable;
5. Insert your HDD to the extraction cabinet;
6. Power on the Movie Server, then the amplifier, and finally the TV to start enjoying.



## Home Theatre Setup

1. Power off all your devices;
2. Connect the amplifier to the TV with an HDMI cable;
3. Connect the Movie Server to the amplifier with an HDMI cable;
4. Plug in the power adaptor and the Ethernet cable;
5. Insert your HDD to the extraction cabinet;
6. Power on the Movie Server, then the amplifier, and finally the TV to start enjoying.



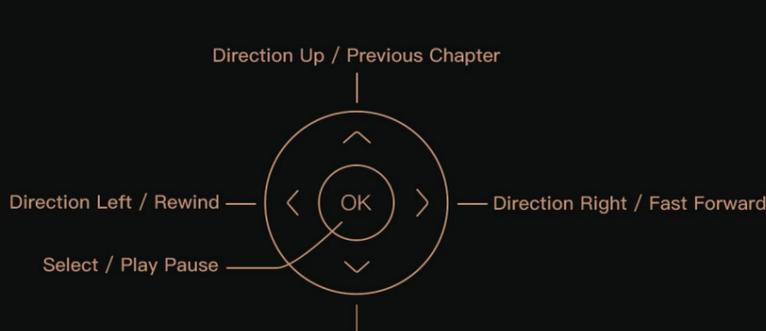
## Movie Server Activation

1. Power on the Movie Server;
2. At the welcome screen, enter your account information at DVDFab Member Center and click the Activate button.

## Build Your Digital Movie Library

1. Power on the Movie Server and make sure it is connected to the same network your computer is connected to;
2. Start DVDFab 10 on your computer and choose the Copy module;
3. Insert your DVD/Blu-ray into the computer optical drive;
4. Choose the Full Disc or Clone mode (more modules and modes will be supported in the future);
5. At the "Save to" section, choose DVDFab Movie Server from the dropdown menu;
6. Start the backup process;
7. Power on the amplifier or home theatre, depending on what you have, and the TV to start enjoying your favorite movies.

## Tips

- The standard SATA hard disk is not an included accessory, which means you have to prepare it on your own.
- Please refer to manufacturer's user manual of your TV and/or amplifier to determine the appropriate HDMI ports and firmware settings.
- In case there is no sound in any of the above-mentioned three circumstances, please reset the audio settings on the Movie Server at Settings > Playback > Audio Output Mode, there are three options available — Analog, HDMI, and S/PDIF.
