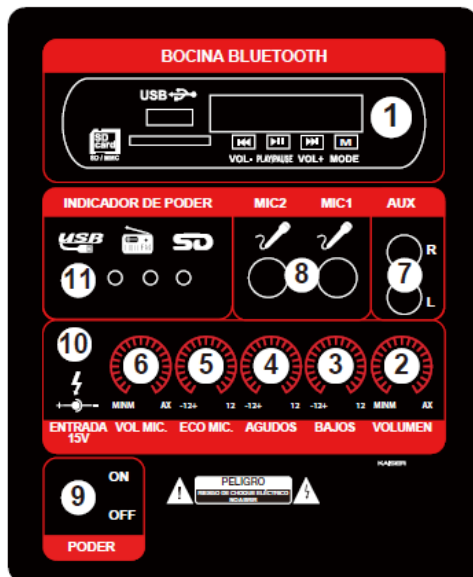




1.MP3 PLAY

Bluetooth pass word:0000.

2. VOLUME

Use it set the volume level.

3. BASS

This knob adjusts bass.

4. TREBLE

This knob adjusts treble.

5. MIC ECHO

6. MIC VOL

Allows you to increase or decrease the MIC level.

7. AUX INPUT

Allows cassette recorder or CD player to the Main output

8. MIC1/MIC2 INPUT

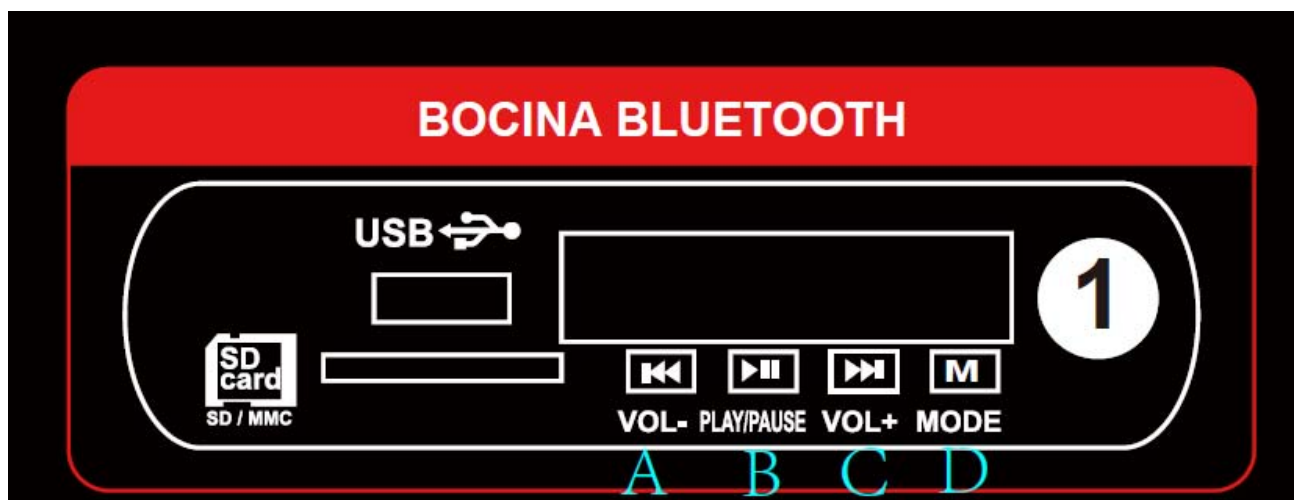
With a 6.3MM plug to connector a microphone.

9. ON/OFF SWITCH

Powers the device on/off.

10. DC 15V IN

11. LED CHARGE



A. Upward button:

short press to last song on USB/SD, long press to volume decrease.

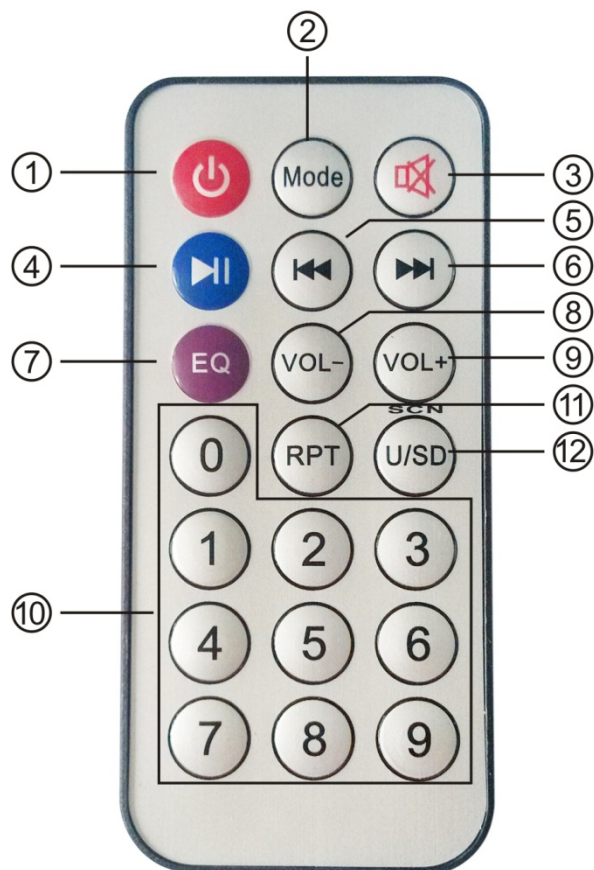
B. Play/Pause button:

On MP3 and Bluetooth: play/pause

On Aux: short press to stop the line out.

C. Downward button: short press to next song on USB/SD, next channel on FM. Long press to volume increase.

D. Mode button: to switch in the USB/SD/ Bluetooth /AUX mode



1. Press this button to turn on or turn off the power
2. **MODE**: USB / SD/BLUETOOTH/AUX function of conversion
3. Press this button to mute
4. Play / Pause button
5. Upward selection key: upward song on MP3/BLUETOOTH
6. Down selection key: Downward song on MP3/BLUETOOTH
7. Press this button to select the EQ mode: NORMAL/BAS/POP/ROC/JAZZ/CLA
8. Press this button to reduce the volume on USB/SD/FM/AUX/BLUETOOTH
9. Press this button to increase the volume on USB/SD/FM/AUX/BLUETOOTH
10. 0-9: KEY number for selecting the music on MP3
11. RPT: Press this button to enter REPEAT: ONE/ALL
12. U/SD: USB / SD function of conversion
