4. LONG PRESS 3 SECONDS TO POWER ON THE HEADPHONE;
SHORT PRESS: PLAY/PAUSE
INCOMING CALLS: SHORT PRESS TO ANSWER, LONG PRESS TO REJECT
DOUBLE CLICK TO REDIAL LAST NUMBERS IN YOUR CALLING HISTORY.

LED INDICATOR

THE RED/BLUE FLASH QUICK MEANS THAT THE HEADPHONE READY TO PAIR.
WHEN THE HEADPHONE IS PAIRED TO THE DEVICE, THE BLUE LIGHT WILL FLASH
EVERY 5 SECONDS.
WHEN THE ANC FUNCTION TURNS ON, THE GREEN LIGHT IS ON STEADILY.
WHEN USING CHARGING CABLE TO CHARGE THE HEADPHONE, THE LED LIGHT
UP AND HOLD RED.
THE LED TURN OFF WHEN THE HEADPHONE IS FULL CHARGED.
WHEN LOW BATTERY, THE RED LIGHT FLASH EVERY 5 SECONDS AND THERE
IS SOUND 'LOW BATTERY'.

HOW TO PAIR

LONG PRESS THE BUTTON FOR 3 SECONDS TO POWER ON THE
HEADPHONE, THE LED LIGHT WILL FLASH RED/BLUE.
ACTIVATE YOUR BLUETOOTH IN YOUR DEVICE, SELECT"NC 1"TO PAIR,
IF NEED A PASSWORD, PLEASE ENTER 0000.

AUX MOLD

POWER ON THE HEADPHONE, CONNECT THE HEADPHONE WITH THE
DEVICE VIA AUX CABLE, SUPPORT SMARTPHONE/MP4/MP3/CD/TABLETS ETC.
