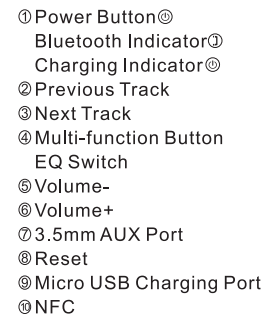




■ 3.5mm Audio Cable (2.3 ft) ■ Micro USB Cable (2.3 ft)



FUNCTION	OPERATION
Power on/off	Hold the Power Button for 2 seconds.
Answer a call/ Hang up	Tap the Power Button.
Reject a call/ Redial	Double click the Power Button.
Play/Pause	Tap the Multi-function Button.
Previous track	Tap the Previous Track Button
Next track	Tap the Next Track Button
Volume up/ down	Tap the Volume+ / Volume- button.
Disconnect Bluetooth	Hold the Next Track for 2 seconds.
Voice dial (Siri on iPhone)	Double click Multi-Function Button
EQ (Switch two EQ settings)	EQ1 : normal bass (will hear short "du-du" prompt sound) EQ2 : heavy bass (will hear long "du" prompt sound) Hold the Multi-Function Button for over 2 seconds to switch to another EQ.

How to Use Charging

1. Please make sure the speaker is within 3 feet of your device, like a cell phone.
2. Press and hold the Power Button for 5 seconds until the white light flashes. You will also hear a prompt sound.

1. Press and hold the Power Button for 5 seconds until the white light flashes. You will also hear a prompt sound.
2. Enable your device's NFC function.
3. Put your device near the NFC chip location.
4. Click "Yes" on your device's screen to confirm Bluetooth connection.
5. When the Bluetooth speaker and your device are successfully paired, the white indicator will be solid.

to reset the speaker, please use a 1.0mm
pin or probe to press the reset button for 5
conds.

When not in use, please power off the speaker and store in a cool, dry place. The operational range of the speaker will be influenced by obstructions, such as walls, pillars, etc. To ensure a stable connection, we recommend avoiding such obstructions whenever possible and/or shortening the distance during use. To protect the long-term performance of the battery, please do not place the speaker in high temperatures above 50°F/60°C, such as in a hot vehicle or under direct sunlight.

1. My speaker will not switch on.
 - a. Please recharge it and make sure it has enough power.
 - b. Plug the unit into a charger and see if the LED indicator becomes solid red.
2. Why can't the speaker connect to my device?
 - a. Check to ensure the Bluetooth function of your device is enabled.
 - b. Make sure your device is within 3ft/1m of the speaker.
 - c. Try tapping on the previous paired device to see if they can be connected again.
 - d. Delete the pairing record(s) on the speaker or your device. And, re-pair them.
3. Can I use the speaker to play music while charging?

To protect the long-term performance of the battery, it is better to charge when the speaker is turned off, especially when the battery is low.

4. Can I make or answer phone calls through the speaker?

Yes. The speaker has a built-in microphone.

5. Why can't I connect by NFC?

- a. Make sure that your device supports NFC functionality.
- b. Keep your mobile device close to the NFC chip location of the speaker when attempting to connect.
- c. Disable the Bluetooth connection of the speaker to other devices.
