

- 1. Never place the utility light face down when the light is on or is still hot from recent use. Doing so could burn/ignite surfaces such as seats, carpeting, and so forth, and cause major property damage. Always turn the utility light off when not in use.
- 2. Always unplug the USB cable from the power source when not in use.
- 3. To prevent serious damage to evesight, never look into the light or shine into someone else's face.
- 4. DO NOT touch the lens of the utility light when light is on or if it was recently on. The lens will be hot and could cause serious burns.
- 5. DO NOT place the utility light in water. Keep all components dry and out of water at all times.
- 6. DO NOT allow children to handle or operate this utility light.
- 7. DO NOT use this product for anything other than its intended use.
- 8. DO NOT charge or operate in close proximity of combustible or flammable materials.
- 9. DO NOT charge battery in airight enclosures.
- 10. DO NOT attempt to charge or operate this utility light if USB, battery, bulb, or any part of the utility light is damaged or corroded.
- 11. Only use charging devices that are provided with the LED utility light or its replacements.

- 13. DO NOT dispose of the battery in fire as this may result in explosion.







IMPORTANT: The Battery is ready to use when purchased. A fully charged battery will provide approximately 3 hours of continuous light in high mode. Do not allow the battery to discharge completely. When battery indicator is red flashing, it indicates low battery.

Turn the utility light OFF and recharge the battery as soon as possible.

- Press the utility light power ON/OFF botton to switch among high light, medium light, low light, red, red flashing and off.
- Memory Mode will activate after a mode has been left on for 10 seconds.



Care and Maintenance

- Always keep the battery fully charged when not in use. This will prolong the overall life of the battery.
- Do not subject the unit to excessive force, shock, dust, or extreme temperature.

- Clean your unit with a dry cloth. Solvent or detergent should never be used.
- Avoid leaving your unit in direct sunlight or in hot, humid, or dusty places.
- Keep your unit away from heating appliances and sources of electrical noise such as fluorescent lamps or motors.
- Only use a type-C USB cable to charge this product.

Troubleshooting

	Buletooth is not activated.	Make sure bluetooth is activated for each speaker.
	The connection distance is more than 10m.	Make sure the distance is within 10m (33ft).
Cannot innerconnect with other speakers.	Every device was connected with Phone before.	Connect all lights first before connect to the phone bluetooth, or clean the phone bluetooth before to connect to one light, then other lights connect to the first light.
