



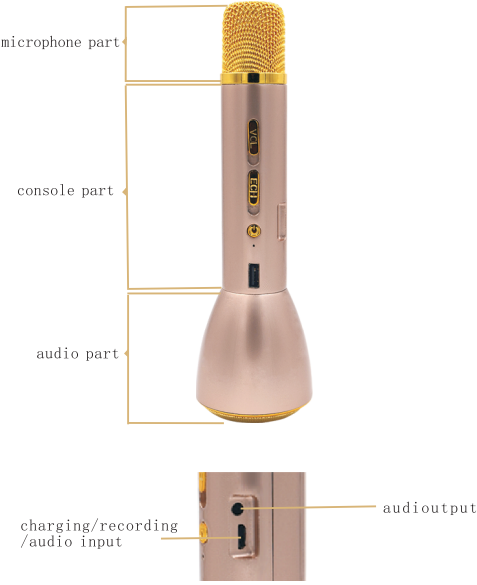

04. How to charge

1. When the battery voltage is too low, the product will automatically shutdown;
2. Using USB cable to connect with mobile phone standard jack. The red light will light;
3. Normal charging 2 hours, charging is completed, the red light is automatically extinguished;
4. Normal conditions continue 6-8 hours.

03. FAQs

Status	Reasons	Solutions
LCD does not light	Electricity is too low or charging cable is not plugged in	charging, checking plug and USB line
NO sound	Switch is not turned on or The voice volume not adjusted	Turn on the switch or turn VOL.
Microphone without reverberation	ECH key needs to adjust	Adjust ECH to the suitable location
Presence of noise	Environmental noise, mobile phone signal interference	Adjust the distance between microphone and phone
Some types of mobile phone recording effect is poor	Phone does not match, phone chip processing ability that is weak	Restart the phone to try or replace the existing mobile phone
When playing the music, the Staccato appears	Microphone is too far or there are obstructions between microphone and mobile phone	Close to mobile phone, keep away from obstructions
Accompanment sounds weak or without sound	The mobile phone sound is too low or music files quality is bad	Open media volume, download high quality files
Phone can't connect to the bluetooth	The bluetooth distance too far, already connected to another phone	Close to mobile phone, keep away from obstructions, Cancel the connection
Playing music is not real	Volume too high, electricity is too low	Turn down mobile phone volume, charge the battery
Bluetooth cannot connect Apple iPhone	iOS system don't support bluetooth output	Choose a music app to have a try

02. Instructions

How to sing

1. Power: turn on the power switch, the blue light will be light
2. Bluetooth connection: open your mobile phone bluetooth, after searching KTV-K088, Pairing connections connecting handheld KTV issued can be heard after 'tick' sound (Note: Pairing process to enter a password, enter '0000'):
3. Music: open cell phone music player such as 'cool music' to download that you like songs or to play the music to start playing. (Note: accompaniment volume can be adjusted via mobile phone);
4. Adjusting sound: adjust sound volume of microphone and intensity of reverb in place;
5. Start singing

Note:

Bluetooth with memory function. Once they had have one time connection with mobile phones, they will automatically connect next time.

If you need to disconnect, you can settings disconnect by mobile phone.

If you just listen to the music, you can adjust microphone volume to a minimum.

How to record

1. Connecting audio line: take out audio line, plug the USB plug into a pocket KTV audio jack, bluetooth will automatically disconnect at this time.
2. Connecting phone: audio cord 3.5mm Jack on the other end into the headphone Jack of phone.

If insert the tape line, bluetooth will automatically turn off
