1. Limits

According to KDB 447498 D01 General RF Exposure Guidance v06 The 1 - g and 10 - g SAR test exclusion thresholds for 100 MHz to 6 GHz at test separation distances ≤ 50 mm are determined by:

$$[(\text{max power of channel, including tune - up tolerance, mW})/(\text{min. test separation distance, mm})] \cdot [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}] \leq 3.0$$
 for 1 - g SAR and ≤ 7.5 for 10 - g extremity SAR,

Where:

Result = $P \sqrt{F/D}$

F = the RF channel transmit frequency in GHz

P = Maximum turn - up power in mw

D = Min. test separation distance in mm
