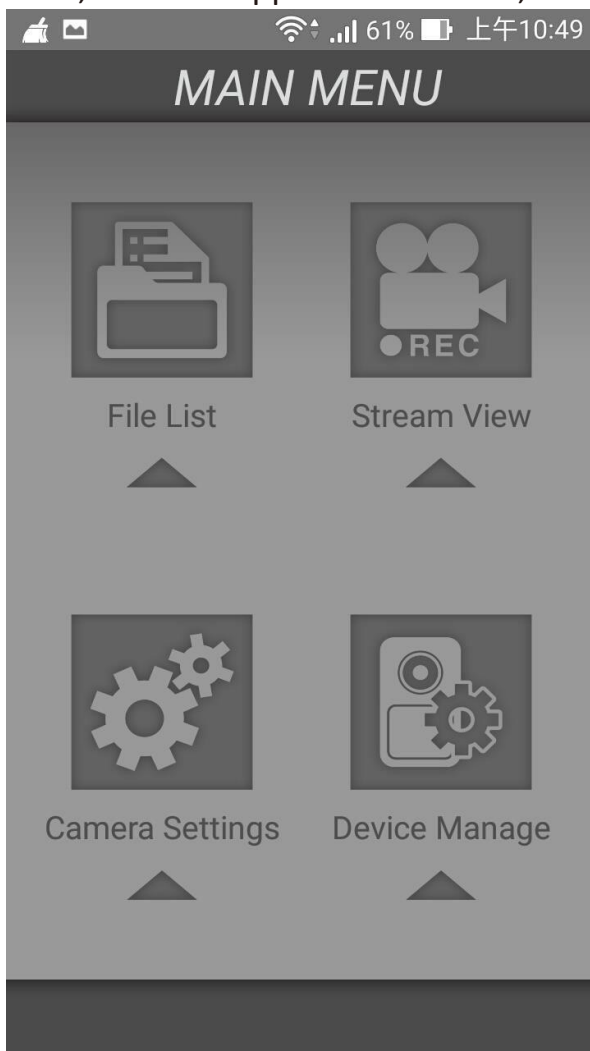
1. Install the App “P2P Camera”

Please manually install “**P2P Camera**” on your smart phone. Once “**P2P Camera**” icon shows on your phone, the app is successfully installed.



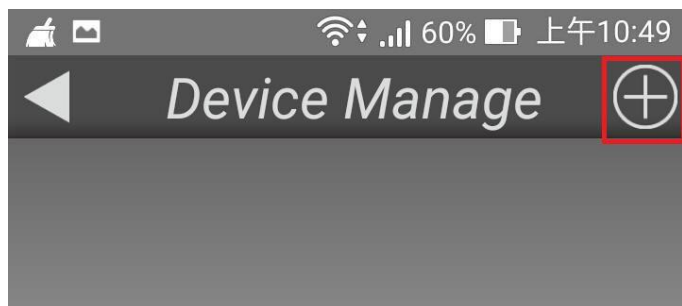
2. Configure the Wi-Fi Settings

To enable Wi-Fi, turn on the Wi-Fi function on your device and on your phone. With Wi-Fi turned on, go to **Settings>Wi-Fi** on your phone to search for the Wi-Fi network named “FARDxxxxx...” (same as the name of your device) and enter the password “88888888”. Next, start the app **P2P Camera**, and enter “**Device Manage**” on the main menu.

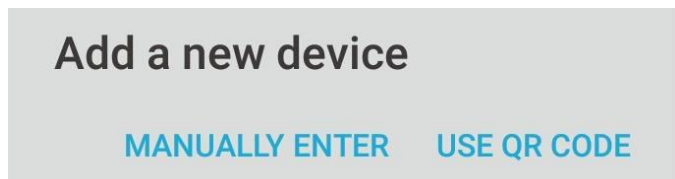


3. Add Device & SSID name

To add **Device**, press add device Icon



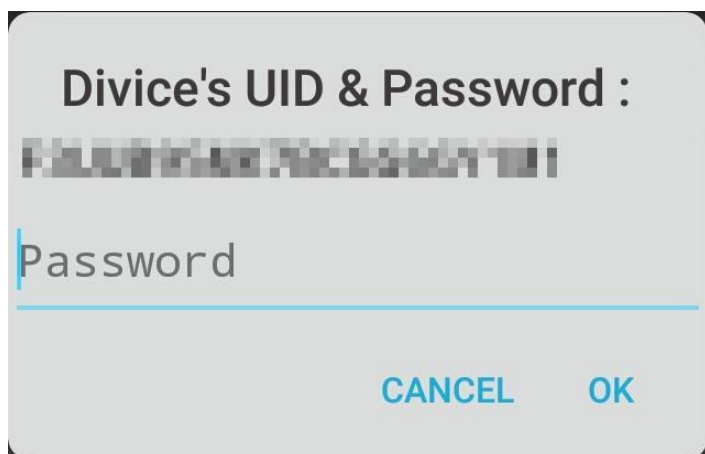

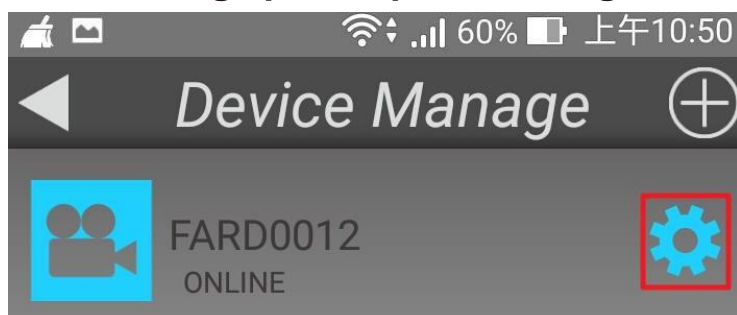
Use QR Code & Scan machine QR Code



After Scan QR Code, Please Input UUID password "88888888" & Press OK



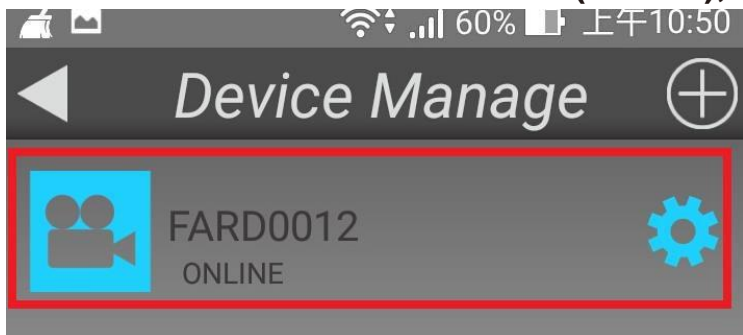
Then App will scan the device and show device Online. Then Configure the SSID Settings, please press Configure the SSID Settings Icon.



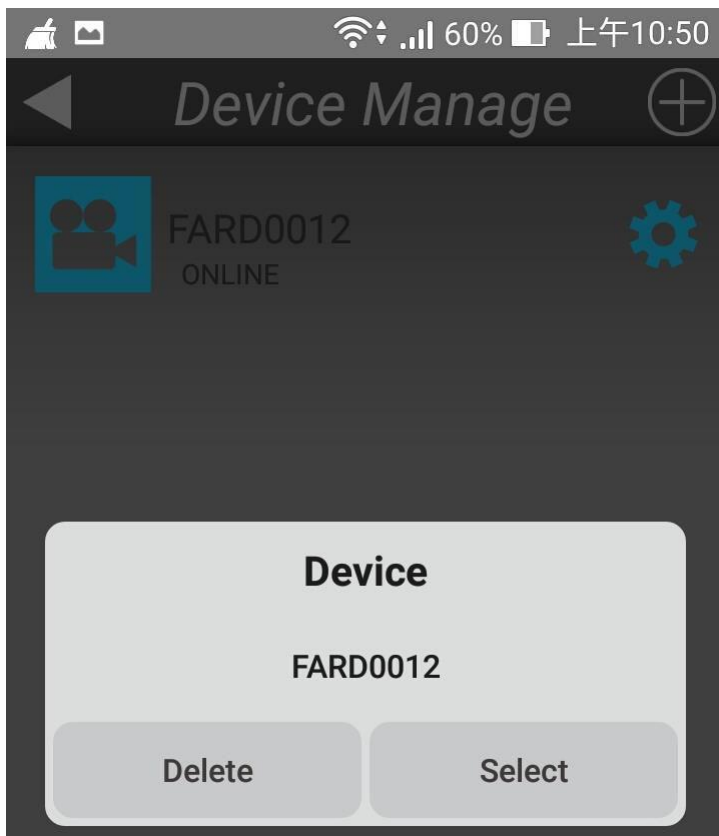
Please Input wifi server SSID name & Password,then press save Icon

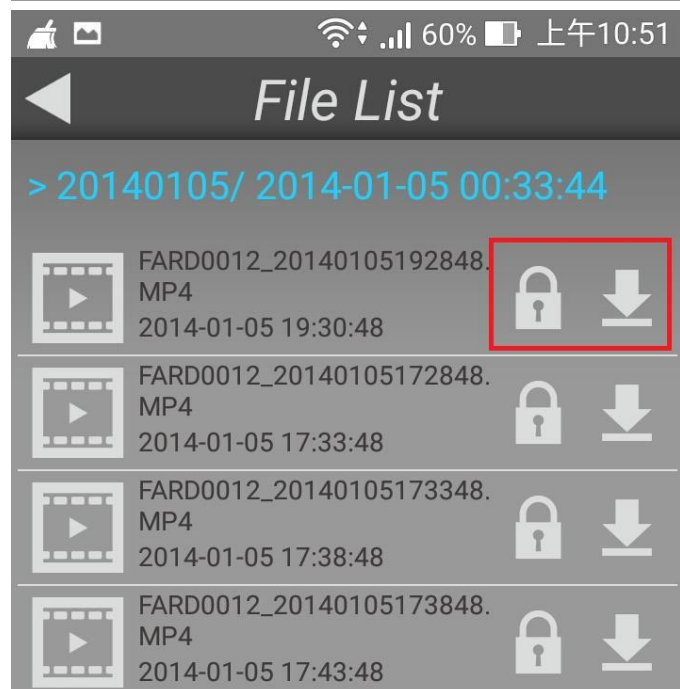
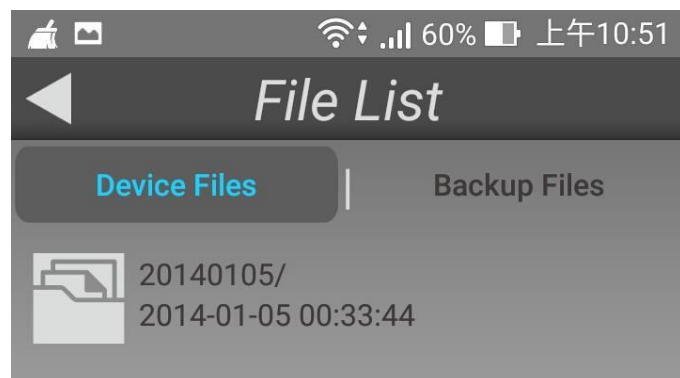
Stream View menu function

3. Audio On/Off (smart phone side)

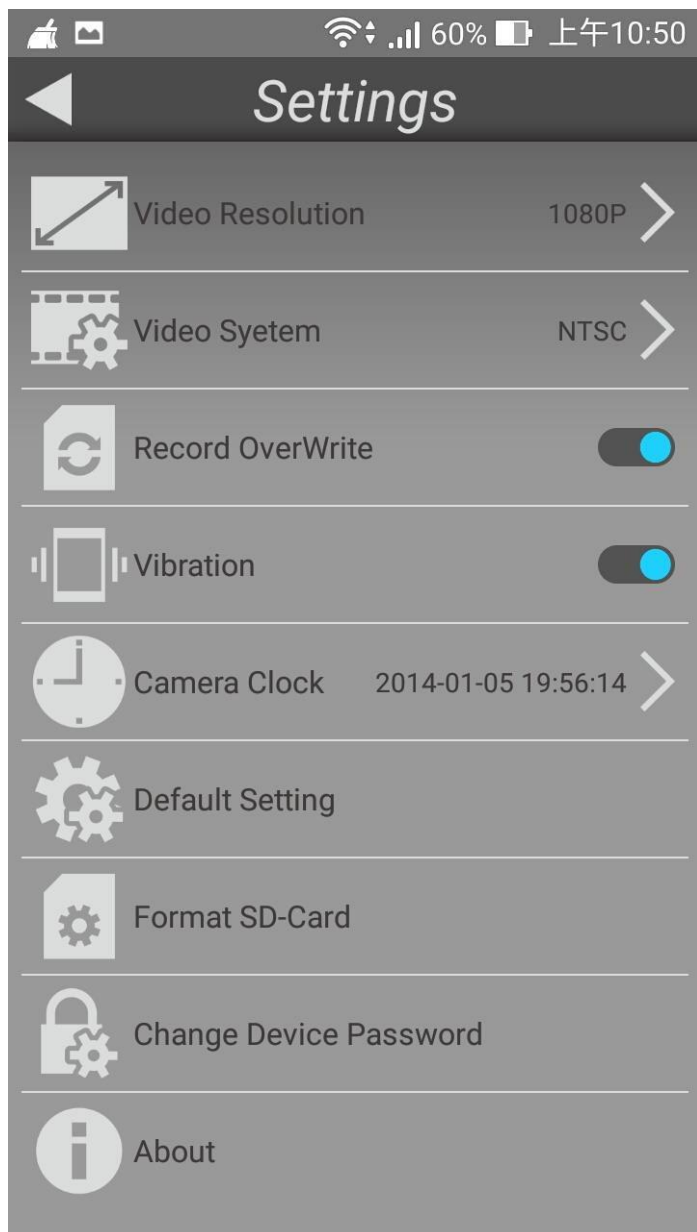


5.Download Video Files

In order to back up the recording files to your smart phone, please go to **Main Menu> File List** and find the video clips or photos you want to back up. Swipe left the video clip you want to back up, you will see two options, **“Backup files”** or **“Delete”**. Click on **“Backup files”**, the files will be backed up to your smart phone. Click **“Delete”**, the video file will be deleted from the device and phone. To check whether the file is successfully backed up on your phone, go to **“Backup files”** on **“Video Files”** to make sure it's in the list. If you want to delete the backed-up file, just slide it to the left and click Delete.

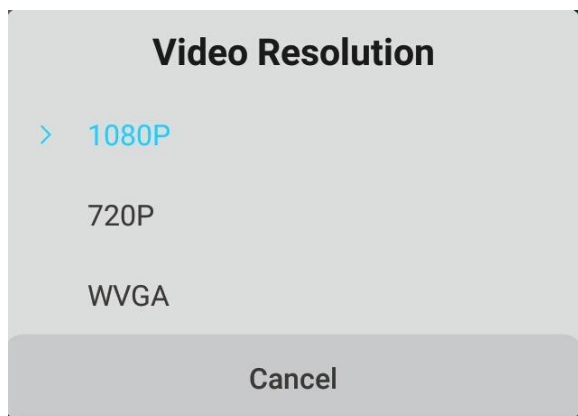

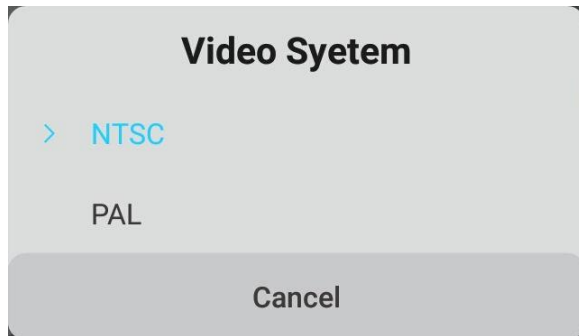

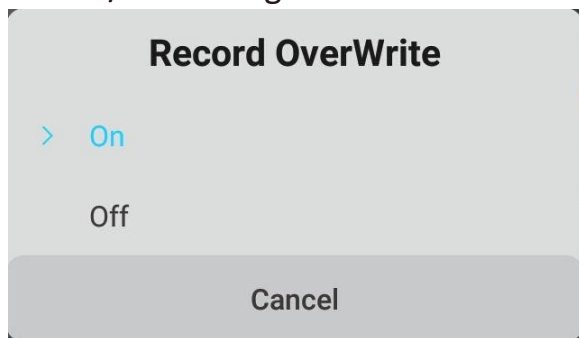

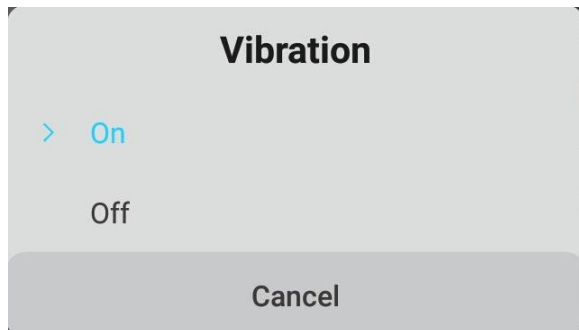

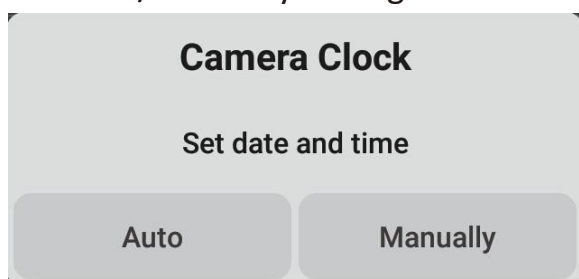

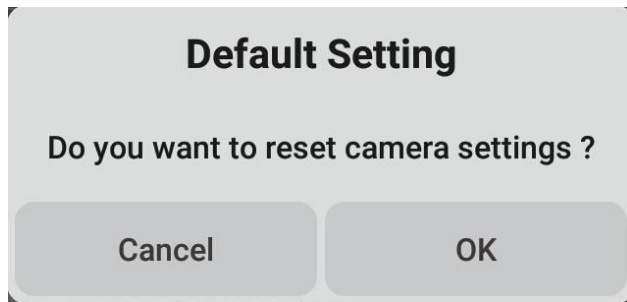

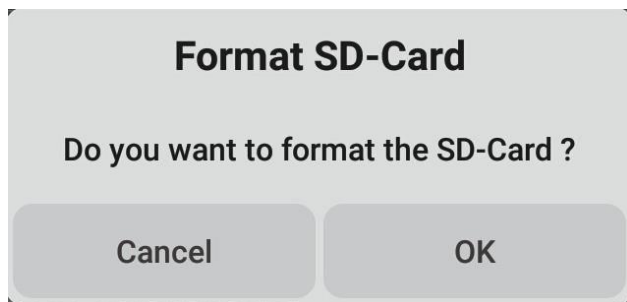

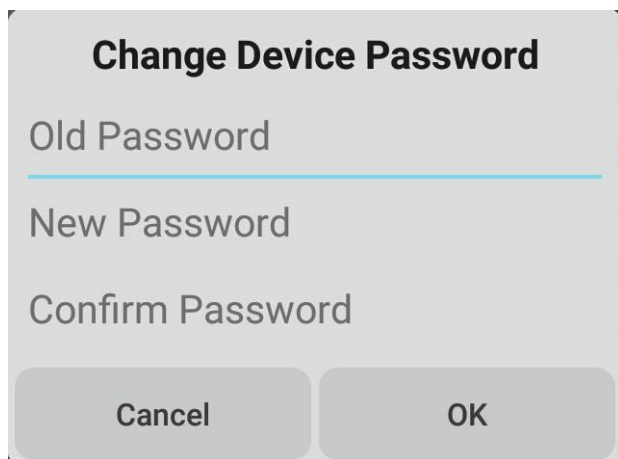

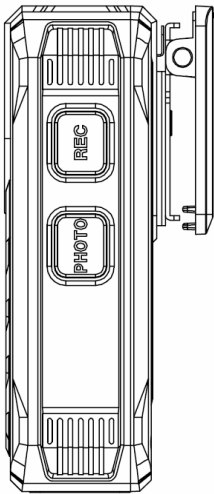
