INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Billboard® True Wireless Earbuds. For best use of this device, we recommend carefully reading this user manual and keeping it for your records.

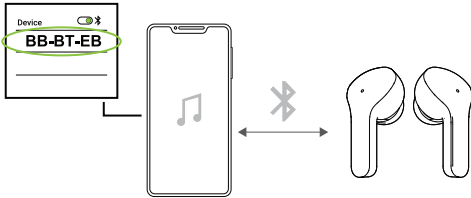
Package contains:

- a. Wireless Two Earbuds
- b. Charging case
- c. USB-C charging cable
- d. User manual



Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the earbuds ON. The LED indicators on both earbuds will FLASH BLUE. After a few seconds, a voice will be heard, indicating that the earbuds have connected to each other. **If the earbuds don't connect to each other, see the troubleshooting section at the bottom of this page.**
2. Open your device's Bluetooth menu and select **BB-BT-EB** when it appears.
3. Another voice will be heard, indicating that the earbuds are successfully connected to your device. The LED indicator on the earbuds will flash BLUE every 5s.



Trouble Pairing the Earbuds ? Try placing the earbuds back into their charging case, and then removing them again at the same time. They should automatically connect to each other.

Media Playback

Make sure the earbuds are charged and properly connected to your Bluetooth-enabled device.

Playback, volume and phone functions can be controlled with your paired device or with the earbuds, as indicated below:

Controlling Playback

- **Tap** the **[Multi]** button on either earbud to play, pause, and resume audio playback.
- **2xTap** the Left earbud's **[Multi]** button to skip to the **next** track.
- **2xTap** the Right earbud's **[Multi]** button to skip to the **previous** track.

Adjusting the Volume

- **3xTap** the Left earbud's **[Multi]** button to **increase** volume.
- **3xTap** the Right earbud's **[Multi]** button to **decrease** volume.



Phone Calls

- **Press** the **[Multi]** button on either earbud to **answer** an incoming phone call. **Press** again to **end** the phone call.
- **Long-Press** the **[Multi]** button on either earbud to **reject** an incoming phone call.

Activating Voice Assistant

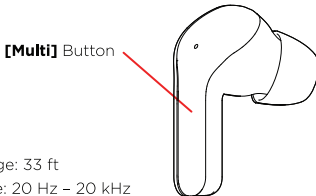
If you have a voice assistant on your paired device, you can activate it using the controls on the earbuds or the controls on your device.

- **Long-Press (1s)** either **[Multi]** button to **activate** the voice assistant.
- **Long-Press (1s)** either **[Multi]** button to **close** the voice assistant.

Storage & Maintenance

When not using the earbuds, it is recommended that they are stored in the charging case and placed in a safe, dry location, away from sources of water, light, heat, and dust. They are best stored in an airtight box or bag (not included).

If the earbuds or case are dirty, wipe gently with a clean microfiber cloth. Do not clean with water or any sort of soap or detergent.

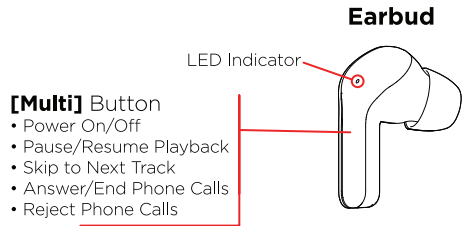

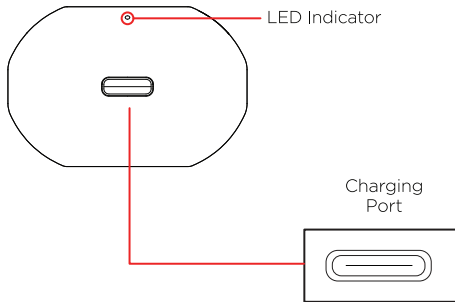

Charging the Case

Insert the small connector of the included USB Type-C charging cable into the charging port on the charging case. Insert the larger connector into the USB port on a computer, or a 5V/1A USB adapter (not included) and plug into an electrical outlet.

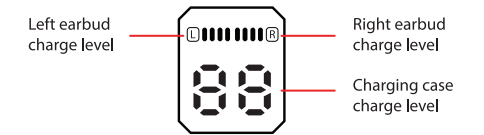
The LCD indicator on the charging case will FLASH while the earbuds are charging and read **"OK"** when fully charged.

A tone will be heard when the earbuds are low on battery, indicating that they need to be recharged.

Charging the Earbuds

Use the included charging case to protect and charge your earbuds.

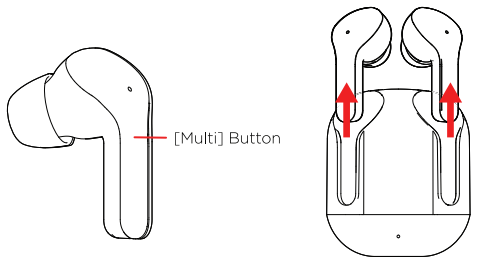
To charge the earbuds, place the earbuds into the correct earbud charging ports. The earbuds will automatically power OFF and begin charging. The earbuds' LED indicators will turn RED while charging and turn OFF when fully charged.



Powering On/Off

- **Charge the case and earbuds fully before using.**
- Remove the earbuds from the case to automatically power them ON.
- When both earbuds are powered ON at the same time they will automatically pair to each other after a few seconds, and a voice will be heard indicating that they are connected.
- **Long-Press** the **[Multi]** button to manually power the earbuds ON/OFF.

Note: The earbuds will automatically power OFF if they are not paired to a Bluetooth device after 5 minutes, or if the paired device is out of Bluetooth range (10 m / 33 ft) for 5 minutes.



Device Safety

- Your True Wireless Earbuds have internal rechargeable batteries. Improper usage may result in the Earbuds becoming hot, ignite or burst and cause injury if exposed to conditions of abuse.
- Do not disassemble, throw away or damage the True Wireless Earbuds.
- Store the True Wireless Earbuds in a dry place, keeping them away from damp corrosive materials and environments such as salt air.
- Keep the True Wireless Earbuds away from direct sunlight, fire and high voltage equipment. Do not store the True Wireless Earbuds inside a car during hot weather. Remember a closed car acts as a green house allowing the inside to reach high temperatures.
- The True Wireless Earbuds are not a toy. Please keep them out of the reach of young children.
- Please do not discard the True Wireless Earbuds. Consult your local waste collection agency for proper disposal or recycling methods. You may also contact "Call2Recycle" at 877-273-2925 or online at "call2recycle.org" for a battery recycling drop off location near you.

Additional information.
Make sure the earbuds are paired before use and the Bluetooth function is activated on your phone. Make sure the earbuds are charged before use. Safety use of the lithium battery The lithium batteries inside these products or not removable, do not attempt to remove these batteries.



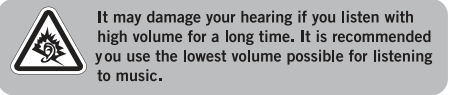
Battery Information

Your earbuds are powered by a rechargeable batteries. The full performance of new batteries is achieved only after two to three complete charge and discharge cycles. The batteries can be charged and discharged hundreds of times, but it will eventually wear out.

- Do not leave a fully charged earbuds connected to a charger, overcharging may shorten their lifetime. If left unused, fully charged earbud batteries will lose their charge over time.
- Never use any charger that is damaged.
- Leaving the device in hot or cold places will reduce the capacity and lifetime of the batteries. Optimal temperature for the batteries is between 59°F and 77°F. A device with a hot or cold batteries may not work temporarily, even when the batteries are fully charged.
- Do not dispose of batteries in a fire as they may explode. Batteries may also explode if damaged. Always dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Please recycle. Do not dispose as household waste.
