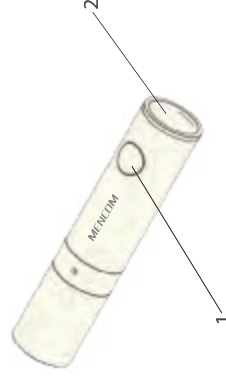

Functions

1. Multi Function Button
2. Micro USB Charging Port



Instructions for use

Getting started

- To turn the receiver on press and hold the MFB (1) for 3 seconds
- To turn the receiver off press and hold the MFB (1) for 3 seconds
- The receiver will shut down automatically if no action in ten minutes

Charging

It is recommended that you give the Lipstick a full charge before its first use.

1. Plug the micro USB end of the charge cable into the **device** micro USB charging port (2)
2. Plug the standard USB cable end into either a computer or a USB mains charger
3. The MFB (1) will be solid red whilst charging
4. When charging is complete, the MFB (1) will be solid blue

Note: It may take up to 1.5 hours before the Lipstick is fully charged.

Pairing the receiver to your device

Before you can use the receiver via Bluetooth, it will need to be paired to your device.

To do this:

1. Press and hold the MFB (1) for 6 seconds. This will turn the receiver on and will automatically enter pairing mode. The MFB (1) will flash red and blue when in pairing mode
2. Turn your device's Bluetooth ON and search for new devices
3. When the "MENCOM-BTR006" appears in the list, select it and if asked for a passcode, enter '0000'
4. The receiver should then be paired to your device

5. The receiver will automatically pair to the last device it connected to when turned on.

Attention:

If you can Not find the pairing name- MENCOM-BTR006 -on your cell phone, please read the no.1 carefully and pay attention to below:

[DO NOT release your hand on 3 seconds when the led red and blue flash only for 1 time]

Note: Pairing mode will be active for 3 minutes. After this, the light will slowly flash blue. To re-activate pairing mode, turn the receiver off and follow the instructions as above.

Please note you can have two devices paired to the UPSTICK at any time.

Playing music through your receiver

Aux-in / Bluetooth

If already connected to the receiver via Bluetooth, simply plug the **UPSTICK** into the aux port of the speaker/earphones. Whilst playing music please use your device to change volume/track. To play/pause songs through the receiver short press the **MFB** (1).

Call handling

The receiver can also take and receive calls when connected.

Answer phone call short press MFB (1)

Reject phone call press MFB (1) for 1 second

Hang up the call short press MFB (1)

Radial last number short press MFB (1) twice

Cancel dialling
short press MFB (1)

Note: If your aux-in port is located within the glove box and the glove box is closed, you may have problems talking over the phone as the MIC won't be able to pick up your voice.

3.5mm Aux Adapter cable

You can use the 3.5mm AUX adapter cable to connect your other devices which have Female Aux port,such as car,speaker etc.

Battery

- Low battery alarm will indicate there is 5 minutes left of battery
- After 5 minutes the device will turn off

Care for your LIPSTICK BT Receiver

Please DON'T:

- Get the device wet
- Drop the device as this will invalidate your warranty
- Open up the device There are no user serviceable parts inside
- Expose the device to extreme temperatures or rapid changes of hot to cold or vice versa
