Bluetooth device will not reconnect with the speaker	Navigate to your Bluetooth® settings menu on your Bluetooth® device, tap "Mercury S047B" and select "Forget". Now follow the steps to pair your device again.

- Plug the micro USB cable into the micro USB port on the back of the speaker, and connect the other end of the cable with any compatible charger or wall outlet.
- When charging, the small LED indicator will glow red. When fully charged, the LED indicator will turn off.
- Charging time is approximately 3-4 hours.
- Use the USB output for charging smartphones via USB cable.

- Press and hold the power button on the speaker to turn it **ON** or **OFF**
- Make sure the speaker is turned **ON**
- On your Bluetooth® enabled device, navigate to the Bluetooth® settings menu, turn on the Bluetooth® feature, and search for new devices.
- Wait a few seconds & select **"Mercury S047B"** The speaker will emit a tone when successfully paired.

- If your device's Bluetooth® version is below version 2.1, you may need to enter the password "0000".
- Insert a USB thumb drive or MicroSD card for direct music playback. Use the on-board controls to scroll through music files.

- You only need to pair your Bluetooth® device with the speaker once.
- With your previously paired device's Bluetooth® turned on & in range, power on the speaker.
- The speaker will automatically reconnect to the last Bluetooth® device it was connected to.
- If you have a previously paired device that does not auto-reconnect, navigate to the Bluetooth® settings menu on your device, turn on the Bluetooth® feature, and select "**Mercury S047B**" from your list of paired Bluetooth® devices.
