

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

### Test plot of Maximum Peak Conducted Output Power:




#### **Bluetooth Communication mode (GFSK, 2441MHz)**




### Bluetooth Communication mode (π/4 DQPSK, 2402MHz)


#### Bluetooth Communication mode ( $\pi/4$ DQPSK, 2441MHz)







#### 3.1.2 Radiated Spurious Emissions

Test Requirement: FCC 47CFR 15.209
Test Method: ANSI C63.10:2013

Mode of Operation: Tx mode / Bluetooth Communication mode (GFSK)

#### **Test Method:**

For emission measurements at or below 1 GHz, the sample was placed 0.8m above the ground plane of semi-anechoic Chamber\*. For emission measurements above 1 GHz, the sample was placed 1.5m above the ground plane of semi-anechoic Chamber\*. Measurements in both horizontal and vertical polarities were performed. During the test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, rotating turntable, varying antenna height from 1m to 4m in both horizontal and vertical polarizations. The emissions worst-case are shown in Test Results of the following pages.












Fig. B [Pulse duration of Middle Channel]

[Pulse duration of Highest Channel]








Fig. E [Pulse duration of Middle Channel]






