

### 5) Speed Cruise

The integrated intelligent cruise function, the cruise control will automatically activate when a driver maintain a constant speed for 10 seconds, you can cancel cruise by simply holding slightly the brake handle.

### 6) Remote Control

Remote start: in the power-off state, user first press the "unlock button" and then double-click "flashing lightning" to complete the boot steps until the meter lights up.

Remote shutdown: in the power-on state, you can shut down by clicking the "unlock button".

Anti-theft function: in the parking off state, you can click on the "lock" to open the anti-theft alert function, the vehicle will emit alarm sound when it is moved or vibrated, you can close the alarm by clicking "unlock button".

Vehicle search function: in the shutdown or when anti-theft function is turned on, if user presses the "loudspeaker button", it will send a reminding sound so that user can find it easily, and press any button to stop it.

**Note: Do not use the remote control function in the course of driving so as to avoid accidents.**

### 7) External Device Charging



its built-in smart chip can provide 1-2A current output according to the need of charging equipment.

In the power-on state, it can be charged by just connecting the data line.

### 8) Battery Disassembly



User can put your fingers into the handle and slide down it to unlock the fastener of battery pack, and then gently pull up, you can complete the removal.

### 9)Vehicle Charging



When the input & output of the charger is connected, the charger's red light will be on, indicating that it is "in charging" state.

Standard charging time: user should use an original charger whose charging time is 3-4 hours in the case of ambient temperature of 25 °.

**Warm tip: please use the original vehicle charger, the company will not be responsible for the damage to the vehicle by the use of the other chargers.**

### Attention & Avoid

- ⚠ In case of poor road conditions, please slow down or get off.  
Note that in case of rain or freezing weather, it is not recommended to use this vehicle. If it is necessary to use, user needs to maintain the speed less 15km/h and can not salm brake to avoid slipping down.
- ⚠ Hasty acceleration and deceleration is prohibited.
- ⚠ Do not use this vehicle in an environment below -5 ° C.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to load more than one people.
- ⚠ Minors are prohibited from using this vehicle.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to ride this vehicle in unsafe or illegal places such as motorway, etc.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to turn off the power when the vehicle is running.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to ride in more than 15cm of water.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to do dangerous actions or ride on one hand while the vehicle is traveling.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to ride it up and down stairs and escalators.
- ⚠ It is forbidden to ride on the surface of slippery road with oil or ice.

## VI. Safe Usage

It is a stylish, environmentally friendly, convenient and safe intelligent means of transport, in order to better ensure the safety of riding, please carefully read the product's attention items and pay attention to safety during the ride.

### Matters needing attention:

- Before riding, user must wear helmets, gloves, elbow & knee pad and other safety equipments to prevent accidents;
- Check vehicle: before driving user needs to check the adequacy of the power, whether the vehicle is abnormal and loose;
- It is forbidden to ride on wet slippery roads, especially on snow and water;
- It is recommended not to climb on the slopes of more than 15 °;
- Please try to avoid rapid acceleration and deceleration, do not put your body excessive forward and backward, overspeeding is strictly prohibited; when the remaining power is insufficient user should keep a low speed ride;
- If there is a risk of falling, please protect firstly your personal safety, adhering to the principle "protect your body instead of vehicle".
- Do not put your hand in your pocket while riding in case of emergency;
- Do not put it in the car trunk for a long time in hot weather;
- When riding user should firstly learn and obey the local traffic laws and regulations, and ride in a civilized way and pay attention to the surrounding people and objects in order to avoid collision;
- Riding at a safe speed for yourself and other surrounding people, rading in a controllable condition;

- Respect pedestrian's traffic right to avoid frightening pedestrians, especially children; user should remind pedestrians and reduce your speed when passing through pedestrians;
- When going with other riders user should keep the proper safety distance away from danger and obstructions, please do not ride side by side unless there is enough space for pedestrians to pass by;
- Do not ride in bad light, if necessary, please reduce the speed and keep vigilant;
- Backwards riding is very dangerous, please try to avoid backwards riding, user could step back a few steps away unless avoiding obstacles.

### Active Safety Protection Measures

- Please read the manual carefully, and try to learn and accept the contents.
- Do not let others use it unless the person has read the manual carefully;
- Please do safety protection in the course of driving, whenever you ride, user should wear an approved, head-matched, belt-equipped safety helmet which can protect your hindbrain, as well as protective equipments like gloves, eye protection devices, elbow-pad, knee-pad and other.
- Do not ride while you are sick or unable to comply with the instructions or warnings of this manual, or in the presence of alcohol or drugs;
- In the low power, when the vehicle continuously alarms and limits speed, please get off in time to ensure safety;
- Do not move it by holding the tire to avoid damage caused by the finger caught between the tire and the shell;
- Please check before you ride it every time, if you find any loosening or damage, do not ride before troubleshooting.

**Please accelerate slowly, the sudden acceleration is likely to cause it loss of balance, causing riders fall and hurt! This riding habit is very dangerous and most of the accidental fall and loss of balance are caused by such riding habits.**

**During the ride, user may encounter sudden danger, so be careful to ride at any time, the company shall not be liable for any personal injury caused by the use not in accordance with the manual instructions.**

## VII. Routine Maintenance

If its body surface stains, you can use a soft cloth dipped in a small amount of water to wipe it; if stains are difficult to clean, you can daub toothpaste and repeatedly scrub them by a toothbrush, and then use a damp cloth to clean.

**Tip:** do not use alcohol, gasoline, kerosene or other corrosive, volatile chemical solvents to clean, otherwise it will seriously damage the appearance and internal structure of the body, else user does not use the pressure water gun spray washing. User should ensure that it is in the shutdown state, when cleaning, and the charging cable is unplugged and the charging port is buckled of the rubber plug, otherwise electric shock may occur or internal water may cause serious failure.

When not in use, user should store it indoors in dry and cool place, and try to avoid prolonged storage in the outdoors. Sun exposure / hot / cold outdoor environment will accelerate its appearance and tire aging and battery life.

### Maintenance of scooter battery pack

Do not place the battery pack in a temperature environment above 50 °C or below -20 °C (for example, do not place its body and its battery pack in the summer sun).

Do not put the battery pack into the fire, which may lead to battery failure, overheating, and even fire risk. please refer to the nameplate located below the battery pack for other maintenance precautions.

To avoid full exhaustion, the battery should be recharged after use at any time, which can greatly extend the battery life. In addition, the battery can play a higher mileage and performance at room temperature; and if the use in less than 0 °C environment, battery life and performance will decline. Typically, at -20 °C, the mileage may only be half or less at room temperature, and the battery mileage will be restored when the temperature rises.

**Tip:** If you do not use the vehicle, please full charge its battery every two months so as to avoid overdischarge damage which is irrecoverable, the battery's internal smart chip records the charging and discharging situation, the damaged battery due to prolonged charge will not be re-charged and can not enjoy the free warranty (Note: non-professionals are prohibited to disassemble the battery pack, otherwise it may encounter serious safety accident caused by electric shock or short circuit! )
