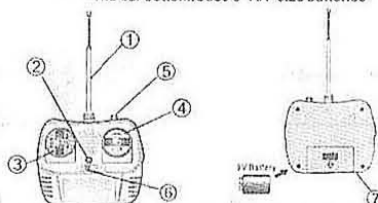

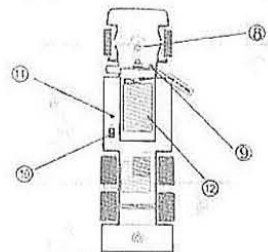

Attached with rechargeable battery and install of charger

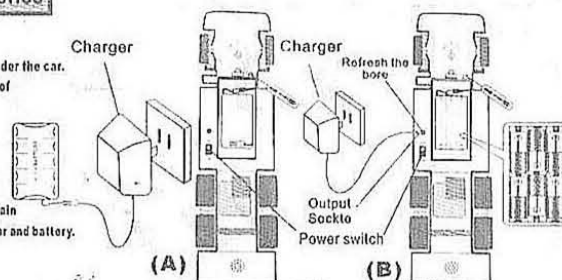


6936 Additional accessories

1. Connect the charger into the inner socket
2. Connect the charger's output plug into the socket under the car.
3. Turn on the button under the car as "A"; Or is a piece of battery takes out 6 grains the overcharging like "B".
4. The charging time should be about 4 hours.

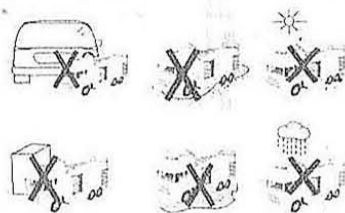
Notes:

1. Using special charger produced by our company is strongly recommended, charging with any other uncertain characteristic charger may destroy the circuit of the car and battery.
2. The charging time should not be too long, 6 hours charging is enough, over refresh time longly, and even destroy or invalidate the battery.



SAFETY CAUTIONS

1. Please turn off the power switch on the car bottom after playing, and take out the batteries in car and those in controller. If the batteries are not taken out, there may occur a leakage and therefore an injury to car and controller.
2. Pay attention to the "+" and "-" electrodes when loading the batteries in car and controller. Do not mix the new and old batteries or different brands of batteries together. Stop using the batteries once they get wet.
3. Please choose a safe outdoor place, immediately stop outdoor use when lightning comes.
4. Do not bend the antenna. If it breaks, the sharp ends may become very dangerous.
5. Don't touch the tires while they are rotating in case being injured.
6. Do not control the car to run toward people.
7. Do not moisten the car, descend the day in fish do not want to play in the open air.
8. Please keep the packing materials to avoid pollution to the environment.

3. Control the joystick to ride the car and.

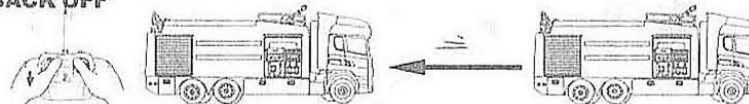
① WATERING, ABSORBING WATER



② GO FORWARD



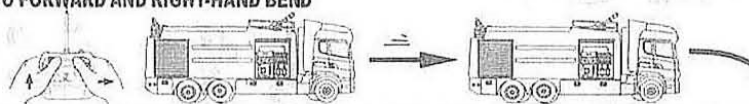
③ BACK OFF

⑤ GO FORWARD AND RIGHT-HAND BEND



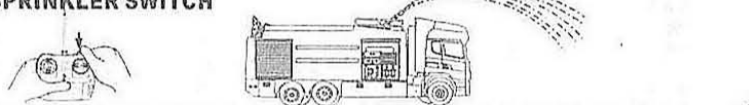
⑥ BACK OFF AND LAEOTROPIC

1. If slows down and the car cannot turn over, it means the battery is low and needed recharge or replace battery
