

# **399A Manual**

## **1. PAIR**

**Open the back battery cover and press the pair button near the battery to pair with the bed.**

## **2. Press the following buttons to control the bed:**

**==the Head-up button to lift the head part of the bed;**

**==the Head-down button to lower the head part of the bed;**

**==the Foot-up button to lift the foot part of the bed;**

**==the Foot-down button to lower the foot part of the bed;**

**==the Flat button to lower the whole bed to be flat;**

**==the Zero-G button to adjust the bed to the zero gravity state.**
