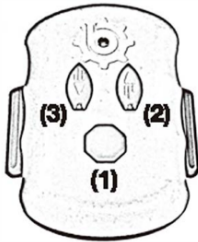


SYNCHING YOUR REMOTE TO YOUR POWER PACK



To check whether your Remote and Power Pack are already synced, activate your Power Pack using your Kill Switch. Then press the stop button only. If you hear a series of beeps, then your remote is already synced to your Power Pack.

To sync your remote to your Power Pack, activate your Power Pack using your kill switch. With the Power Pack activated, follow the key sequence below within a 10 second window:

- press the stop button (1) 3 times
- press the forward button (2) once
- press reverse button (3) once
- press the stop button (1) one last time

The Bixpy Remote control is equipped with a watch battery CR2032, a readily available battery on-line or at many retail stores. If the red LED light on your remote is flickering or not lighting up when you press buttons, you will need to replace the battery.
