

Product operating tips:

- Your mouse can operate from up to 30 ft. (10m) max. away from your computer.
- Store the USB receiver in the storage slot in the bottom of the mouse.
- Switch off your mouse when traveling or to conserve battery life.

Trouble shooting

Situation	Try this
Mouse does not work at setup	■ Ensure the USB receiver is connected. ■ Connect the USB receiver to a different USB port. ■ Check that the battery is inserted correctly into the battery compartment. ■ Install a new battery. ■ Moving the mouse closer to the USB receiver. ■ Connect the USB receiver to a different USB port. Try a USB port on the computer, not a USB Hub.
Mouse has stopped working	■ Check that the battery is good. If necessary, replace the battery. ■ Ensure the optical sensor on the mouse is clean.
