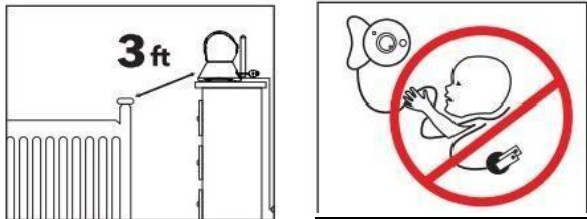
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# SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

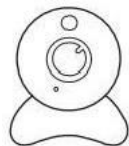
- NEVER place the camera or cord in or near the crib or playpen.

## Baby Monitor

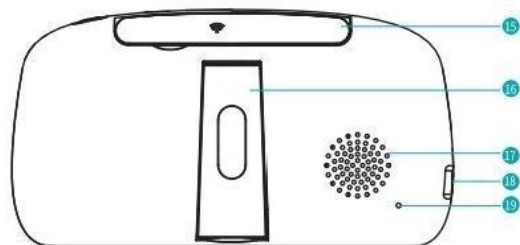


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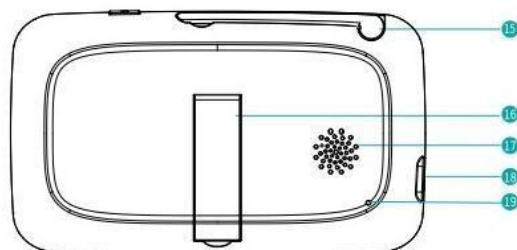


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- ① Power/Screen On&Off Button: Long press to turn on/off the monitor, short press to turn on/off the screen.
- ② Menu/Back: Press to enter menu page or press as a Back button
- ③ Camera Switch: Switch cameras if connected with 2 or more cameras.
- ④ Charging Indicator: Orange on charging, off at fully charged
- ⑤ Left Button: Press to pan the camera leftward or to change your selection leftward.
- ⑥ Up Button: Press to tilt the camera upward or to change your selection upward.
- ⑦ Right Button: Press to pan the camera rightward or to change your selection rightward.
- ⑧ Zoom/OK Button: Press to Zoom in/out or to confirm your selection.
- ⑨ Power connected Indicator: Yellow when connected to the power adapter.
- ⑩ Down Button: Press to tilt the camera downward or to change your selection downward.
- ⑪ Talk: Press and hold to talk to your baby in the monitoring page.
- ⑫ Volume/Brightness: Press to adjust the monitor's volume or brightness in the monitoring page.
- ⑬ Sound Level LED: Quantity of lighting LEDs shows sound volume detected by the camera.

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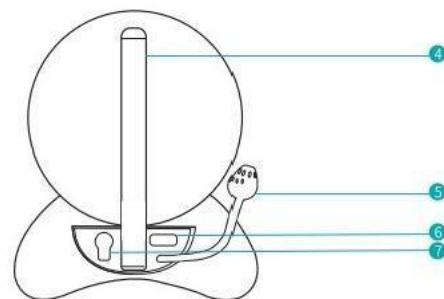
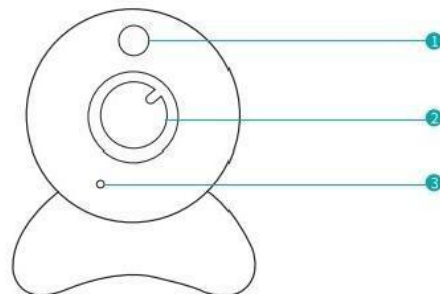

# GETTING STARTED

## 1. Charging&Powering Baby Monitor

- 1) Connect the monitor adapter to the monitor and a power socket.
- 2) Unplug the unit when its power indicator turns off, indicating a full charge.

## 2 Powering Camera

- 1) Connect the camera to power source via the USB type-C cable and camera adapter.

- Only use the power adapters included in the package.
- Do not place the camera and power cord within the reach of your baby.

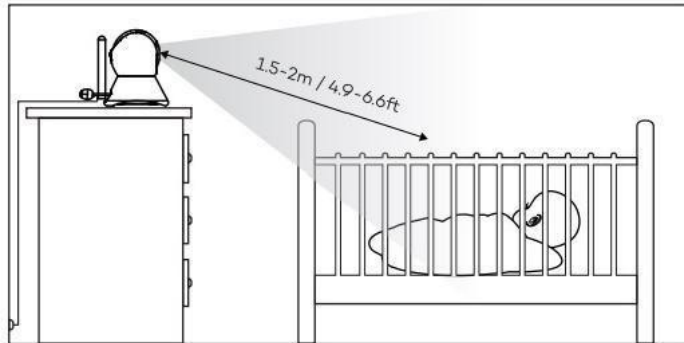
## 3. Pairing the Baby Monitor &the Camera

By default, one camera has been paired with the monitor when manufactured. When you power on the monitor and camera, the two will automatically pair. To add more cameras, press the Pair Button at the bottom of the camera, press Menu button, select through -> + -> +, and then the monitor will auto-pair with the new camera.

- Once they're paired successfully, the camera number with icon 1 will be shown at the top left.
- Microphone feedback noise might occur when the monitor is too close to the camera. Please keep them at least 1.5m/4.9ft apart.
  - It is recommended to pair in the baby's room, or wherever you intend to place the camera.

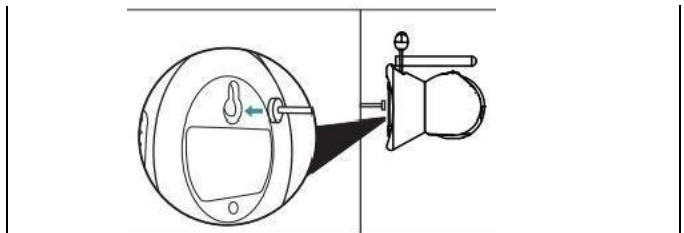
## 4.Placing the Camera

Place the camera 1.5-2m/4.9-6.6ft away from your baby for safety reason and for a better view in night vision mode.



## 5.Wall Mounting Camera

- 1) Select the spot to mount the camera, keeping it beyond your baby's reach.
- 2) Use the screw bag to fasten the bracket on the wall, and screw the camera into the bracket.



It's strongly recommended to use a screw and screw anchor. Don't release the camera until you're sure it is firmly mounted.

## 1. Digital Zoom

- 1) Press Zoom Button to zoom in to 2X/4X when viewing the camera.  
A third pressing of the button will restore to the original image.
- 2) Under split screen mode, press Left/Right Button->OK Button to select the camera(Camera 1 or 2) you want to view or zoom in.

,The current zoom level number will be shown with the Zoom icon Q2 on the monitor

## 2. Pan-n-Tilt

When viewing the camera, press Left/Right/Up/Down Button to view at different angles.

## 3. Night Vision

The night vision is automatically activated in a dim environment.  
The camera has high-intensity infrared LEDs for picking up clear images in the dark. Black and white images can be captured within 5m distance.

## 4. Talkback

Press and hold the Talk button to communicate with the baby, release to exit.

- When you enter the talking mode, the icon will be shown on the monitor.
- When it's mute or the speaker volume is too low, you may not be able to hear the baby.
- When you're pressing the Talk Button, the camera will not transfer the sound to the monitor. Please release the button to listen to your baby.

## 5. Volume/Display Brightness Adjustment

- 1) Use Shortcut Button: Press SHORTCUT Button->Left/Right Button to quickly adjust the volume with < > & > icons.
- 2) Use Shortcut Button: Press SHORTCUT Button->Up/Down Button to quickly adjust the Brightness with < > & > icons.

- When the sound is off, you may not hear your baby

## 6. Camera

### Add Camera

- 1) Press Menu button, select through ->田->+ to add a camera.






- 2) Short press the pairing button on the camera twice. The camera will emit a voice prompt of "Waiting for pairing"




·Four cameras at most can be connected to one monitor.




## Split Screen

- 1) Press Menu button,select through ->
- 2) Then select two cameras(Camera 1/2/3/4)for Split screen display.
- 3) Once set,you can view two cameras at one time without delay.The sound of the two rooms will be switched every 10 seconds.
- 4) Under Split screen mode,you can also press Left/Right Button->OK Button to select one camera(Camera 1or 2)you want to view or zoom in. Press the Menu Button to return to Split screen mode.




 The split screen mode can be activated only when two or more cameras are successfully connected.



## View Camera

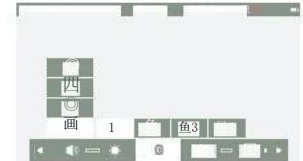
- 1) Press Menu button,select through ->  to view a camera.
- 2) If there are 2 or more cameras,tap  C to cycle through the added cameras every 10 seconds.
- 3) Select the camera number (1/2/3/4)to view the corresponding camera.




 You can switch viewing different cameras;the current camera number will be shown with the Camera icon on the monitor.

## Delete Camera

- 1) Press Menu button,select through ->  to delete a camera.



 Atleast one camera shall be added.Do not delete all the cameras. If necessary,please add a new camera before deletion.

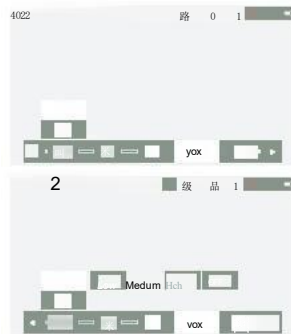
## 7. VOX

Explanation:

- There are two options, namely sound detection and crying detection.
- There are three levels for each option, LOW(75dB), MEDIUM(65dB) and HIGH(60dB). LOW means the sound/crying can be detected if it reaches 75dB, and so on for MEDIUM and HIGH.

- 1) Press Menu button, choose **vox**  
-> **OK** Button.

- 2) Select the option you want. Press **OK** Button.



- There is no sound detection alarm push and the screen will not wake up automatically if VOX is turned off.

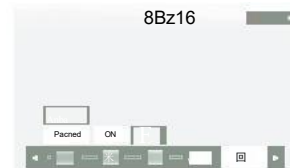
## 8. Playback/Record

Explanation:

- This function is to record important moments during the baby's growth process
- Recommend to use brand TF card such as Sandisk, Kingston, Samsung, etc.

### Record

- 1) Press Menu button, select through **D** -> **Record** -> **OK** Button.
- 2) Select the option you want. Press **OK** Button.



### Playback

- 1) Press Menu button, select through **D** -> **Playback** -> **OK** Button.
- 2) In the replay, press the left and right keys to select the video you want to replay.
- 3) In the playback video, press the left and right buttons to fast forward /fast rewind, press the **OK** button to pause, and press the menu button to ext.



## 9. Lullabies

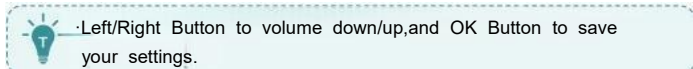

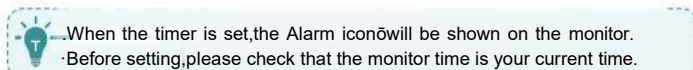
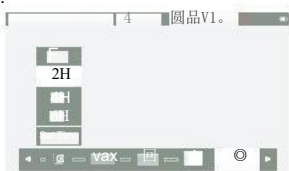
Explanation:

This function is to remind you of feeding your baby.

OFF means you shut down the function; 2 hour means it reminds you 2 hours later and so on for the other options.

## 11. Monitor Settings

Explanation:

This is the sub-menu of the function page where the Temperature setting, Screen auto off setting, Alarm Volume, date and time, system language, TF Card, System Version and Restore to factory setting.

2) Select the function to be adjusted.



## 12. Temperature Alert

Explanation:

Set temperature alert, so that the baby monitor beeps whenever the room temperature falls outside the desired temperature range. You can also choose to display the temperature in Fahrenheit (°F) or Celsius (°C) on your monitor.

1) Choose 🌡️ -> OK Button.


2) Press the up and down buttons to select off and on for temperature alarm or °C and F for temperature display.

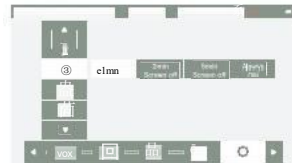
3) Press the up and down buttons to switch between the upper and lower temperature limits that trigger the temperature alarm.

When Mute is selected for sound,only the alarm sound is muted instead of system sound muted.


### 15. Date

- 1) Choose  ->OK Button.
- 2) Set the current date by setting the year,month and day.Press OK Button.



Press the up and down buttons to adjust the digital display.

### 16. Time

- 1) Choose(  )->OK Button.
- 2) Set the current time by setting hour, minute,and AM/PM.Press OK Button.

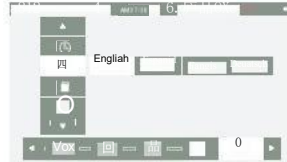

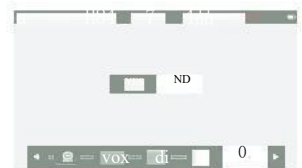


## 20.Restore to factory

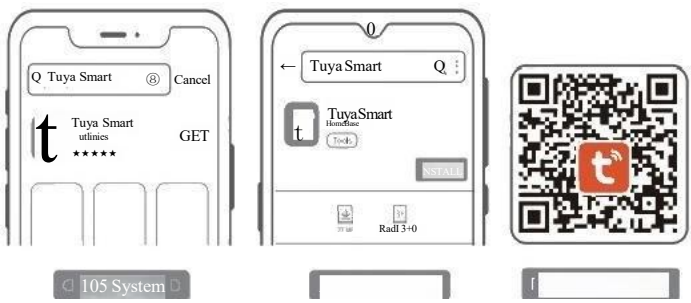
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## 1. APP DOWNLOAD AND INSTALLATION

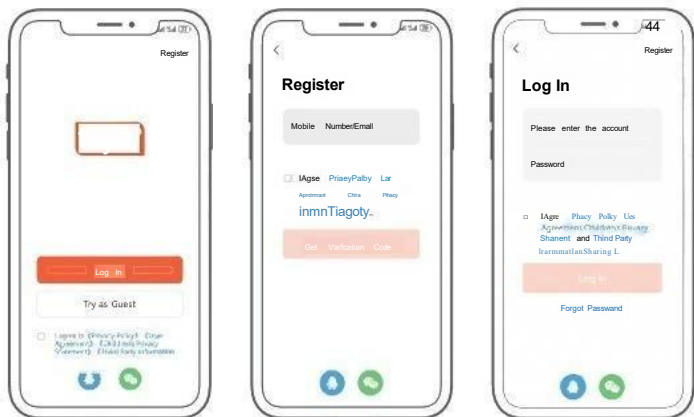

## 2. ACCOUNT REGISTRATION AND LOG IN

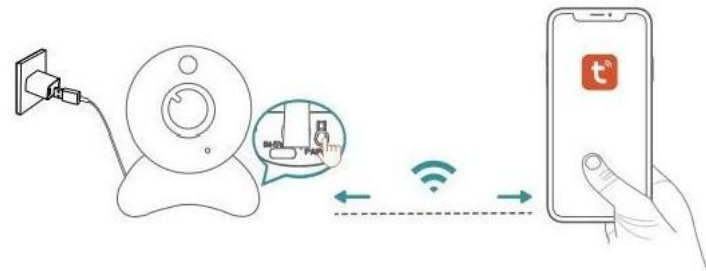
- ① If you already have a Tuya Smart account , please log in using your account and password directly.

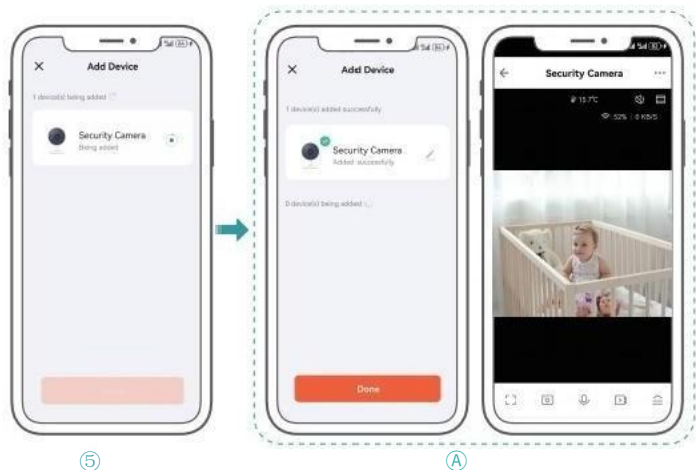
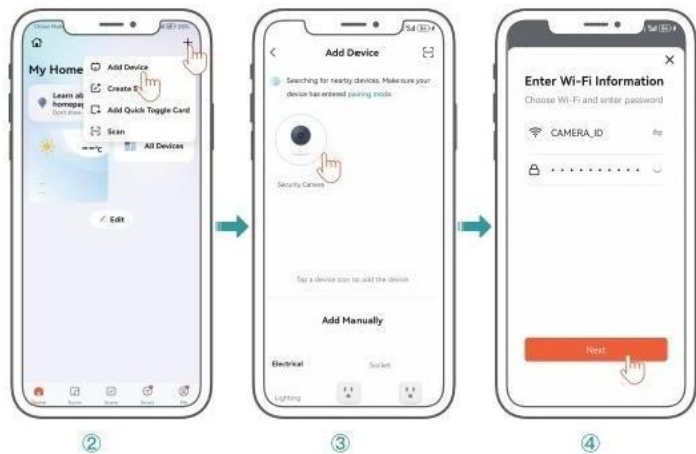


## 3. ADDING CAMERA TO APP

### Warm reminder:

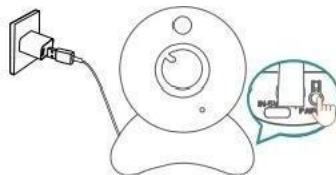
Make sure the Wi-Fi network is a 2.4 GHz network, as the camera doesn't support 5 GHz Wi-Fi. Before starting to connect the device to your phone App and Wi-Fi, please set the relevant parameters of the router and do not include special characters like ~!@#% ^&\* etc. into Wi-Fi password. When trying to connect the device to your App and Wi-Fi, try to keep your phone and device as close to the router as possible to speed up device setup.

- ② Click "Add Device" or " + " at the upper right corner of the APP homepage to enter the Add Device page.
- ③ After entering the Adding interface, Click the camera icon.
- ④ Put in the Wi-Fi password.
- ⑤ Wait for pairing.
- ⑥ After pairing finished, you can view via the camera.



## Method 2: Adding device by scanning QR code

- ① Connect your phone with WiFi. Using the power adapter and USB cable provided to connect the camera to the power socket. Long press the pairing button of the camera until you hear the prompt of **"waiting for wifi connection"**. It indicates the startup is successful.



- ② Click **"Add Device"** or **" + "** at the upper right corner of the APP homepage to enter the Add Device page.
- ③ Click **"Camera&Lock"** → Click **"Smart Camera(Wi-Fi)"**.
- ④ Following the step and click **"Next"**.
- ⑤ Choose the correct WiFi network connected with your phone and enter the correct password, then click **"Next"** and you will see a QR code on your phone. **(Note: Please choose 2.4Ghz WFi.)**
- ⑥ Put your QR code on your phone in front of the camera lens at a distance of 15-20cm. You will hear the prompt tone **"DI"** indicating the QR code is recognized successfully. Click **"I Heard a Prompt"**
- ⑦ Wait for the connection. It will be finished within 2 minutes.
- ⑧ A page prompts that the adding is successful, click **"Done"**. Then it will jump to the live streaming page automatically where you can check your baby via phone now.

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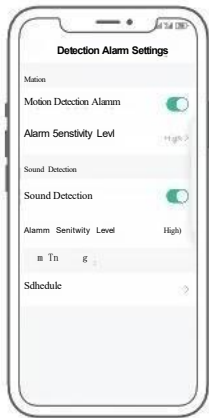
## 4.3 Detection Alarm

### 1) Motion Detection

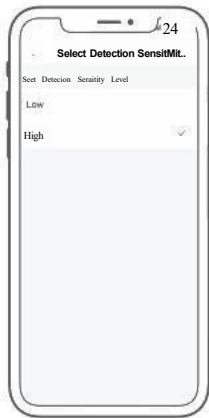
- ① When motion detection is on, once the camera detects a moving object, it will capture a picture. The user will be able to see the picture and receive the relevant notification push on the app.
- ② Motion Alarm Sensitivity Setting: Set high/medium/low sensitivity of motion detection according to your needs

### 2) Sound Detection (Cry Detection)

- ① When sound detection is on, once the sound/crying detected by the camera reaches a setting volume, it will push relevant notification on the app.
- ② Sound Alarm Sensitivity Setting: Set high/low sensitivity of sound/crying according to your needs.



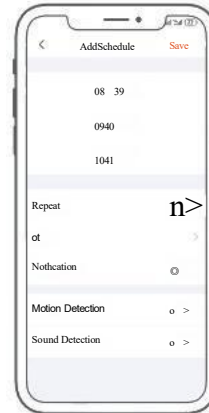
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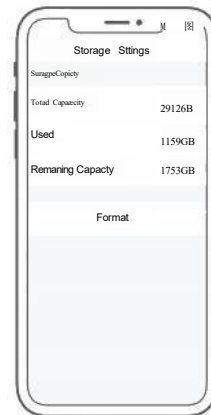

### 3) Schedule

- ② Edit the desired time, select the number of days to be repeated, turn on the "notification", select the detection mode, click "Finish" and save.

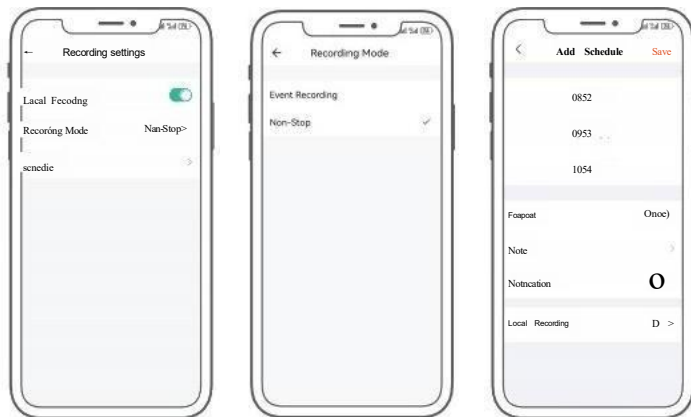

## 6. RECORDING SETTING

Non-stop recording can record continuously without stops and automatically cover the earliest event. Event recording only records the detected event.
- ③ **Schedule**: Select "schedule", click "Add" to enter the interface. Edit the desired time, select the number of days to be repeated, turn on the "notification", turn on local recording, click "Finish" and save.

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# TROUBLESHOOTING

Product not powering on?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check that the camera and monitor are turned on.</li> <li>• Check the camera is connected to power properly (it cannot be charged; it's power off once disconnected from power).</li> <li>• Check that the monitor is of enough battery (it'll shut off when battery level icon flashes red slowly on the monitor).</li> <li>• Check the integrity of the power cable.</li> </ul>
Baby monitor can't connect with the camera?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check whether the camera is near the monitor (recommended to keep within 1.5-2m/4.9-6.6ft).</li> <li>• Check whether the monitor is of low battery. Charge it in time to restore good connection.</li> <li>• Check whether the camera is well connected to power.</li> <li>• Check whether there are any large metallic objects including doors, refrigerators, mirrors, etc., are placed between the camera and monitor thus blocking the radio signals.</li> <li>• Check whether there's any other 2.4GHz product is used nearby like WiFi routers, microwave ovens, which may interfere the connection.</li> </ul> <p>If nothing above is involved, please retry to pair: press the Pair Button at the bottom of the camera, press Menu button, select through-&gt;+&gt;+, and then the monitor will auto-pair with the camera.</p>
Nothing shown when I view a camera?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check all connections to the camera (power cable plugging and pairing).</li> <li>• Check whether the screen is in sleep mode. Press any button to awake it.</li> <li>• Check whether the camera is within range of the monitor.</li> </ul>
No sound from the monitor?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check whether the system sound volume is set to "O". It'll be mute if set so.</li> </ul>
Black and white pictures?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Night vision LED may be ON. Please turn on room light to force it out of the night mode.</li> </ul>

Choppy videos?	<p>Check whether the camera is near the monitor and that there're no obstacles between them.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Adjust the monitor antenna to vertical position for better signal transfer.</li> </ul>
