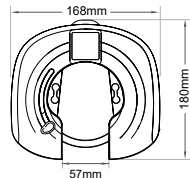

 - 3.6V 3500mA Lithium battery
 - 3.6V 8000mA Lithium battery



■ Power

- 3.6V 8000mA Lithium battery (Free of Charge)
- When the power is low, please contact manufacturer or dealer to change new battery of the same specifications.
- When the power is lower than 20%, APP will warn you low battery; please change the battery in time.(Power lasts about 30 months normally.)

■ Installation

- Fix the lock on the prob stand of bike, screw down the 4 bolts.



■ APP download

- Apply to iOS 8.0 , Android version 4.3 and higher, Bluetooth 4.0 version
- Scan the QR code on lock, download and install the APP.



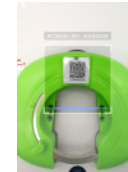
■ Lock

- Slide the handle to the bottom side, hear "bi bi", lock successfully. Connect Bluetooth successfully, click "return bike", then the bike sharing experience finished.



■ Manually Unlock

- Click the "scan" function on the APP, after connecting successfully, click "unlock", slider opens automatically.
