### SMART LUGGAGE FUNTION

1

Smart lock

After binding the luggage, log in the APP home page. Click on the lock/unlock button to open/close the lock. When the lights turn red means locked, and blue means unlocked. The system would lock automatically after 30 seconds. You can use the backup keys to open the lock when the system fails.

2

Be Weighted

Click on the "weight" button, then steadily lift the connected luggage, keep it for seconds, then the APP shows stable weight data to complete weighting.

3

Distance Alarm

Open the APP, or run it in the background, the warning system will alarm when the luggage is beyond a certain distance.

### QUICK START GUIDE

#### 1. Power on

Unzip the interior lining of the rear compartment to access the power unit. Open the battery cover by turning the screw lock counterclockwise. Place (2x) AAA batteries (included) inside. The TSA lock will turn blue, indicating that the luggage has been turned on.

#### 2. Download app

Scan the QR code below or visit the Apple store or Google Play store to search ECHOLAC to Download the app.



#### 3. Register

Register the account by your email address, and please remember your password.

#### 4. Binding

Open the APP and log in. Then click the button to pair with the luggage. If fail, please check if the power units are correctly installed, and make sure there's only one smart luggage around you, then try to pair again. If the luggage has already paired with other account A, pls unbind the luggage firstly by following steps. Open the APP, log in by account A, then tap the device information icon at the upper right corner of the luggage page, click the delete device, thus you unbind the luggage.

### REMINDING

1. To Weigh more accurately, the luggage handle is special designed with hollow joint.
2. Please take out the batteries if the luggage is left unused for a long time.
3. To keep the luggage secure, the system would lock automatically after 30 seconds.
4. Please note the distance alarm would be affected by your surroundings.
5. Be sure to keep the keys carefully outside the luggage. They are the backup keys to open the lock, please make sure you have it with you always.
