REMOTE BATTERIES

Use 2 x “AAA 1.5V” Batteries
(not included)



HOVERBOARD CHARGING

The charging port for the hoverboard is located on the back. To charge, connect the provided USB charging cable either to a USB port on a computer or to a 5V 1A Class 2 USB power adapter.

BATTERY SAFETY

- The placement or replacement of batteries is to be performed by an adult.
- Batteries must be inserted with the correct polarity +/-.
- Non chargeable batteries shall not be recharged.
- Do not short-circuit the batteries.
- Do not mix batteries from different producers or new and old batteries.
- You should only use batteries of the same or equivalent types as recommended.
- Check the batteries on a regular basis to avoid leakage.
- If the product will be stored and unused for an extended period, please remove the replaceable/non-rechargeable batteries.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-sinc), or rechargeable batteries.
- Never throw the batteries into fire to avoid explosion or leakage.
- Hoverboard has an internal rechargeable battery, use USB changing lead provided to recharge.

Operating The Product



REMOTE CONTROL

The hoverboard is operated via a remote control, allowing users to navigate it forwards, backwards, left, and right with ease.



CHARACTER ATTACHMENT

The plastic characters effortlessly slide onto and off of the hoverboard, allowing for easy customization and interchangeability.

Music Playback: Each character is equipped with a built-in speaker that plays a unique tune while on. Each character has it's own melody.

MULTIPLAYER FUN

To connect multiple boards for multiplayer fun, simply turn on a hoverboard, and the corresponding RC to connect. Then follow that sequence for all other hoverboards after each hoverboard has connected to an RC.

- When the toy is in motion, do not touch the wheels by hand to avoid damages or injury.
- Do not play in a place with puddles, mud or sand.
- Do not play on the roads or in any other dangerous places to avoid accidents.
