### General Functions

Desired Result	Required Action
Turn on & Enter pairing mode	Long press the button for 3 seconds
Pairing	You should use a Bluetooth function cell phone or other Bluetooth device and to perform pairing action
Turn off	Long press the button for 3 seconds
Charging	Plug the Micro USB cable to charging port of the device
Handsfree Calling	Answer the phone call by click the button when there is a phone call

### Pairing to cell phone or other device

To use your Wireless Earphone, you must first pair your earphone with a phone or a computer. Once your earphone is paired to a specific cell phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.


### Pairing to a phone and entertainment:

- Turn on your phone and ensure its Bluetooth function is activated
- Turn on the earphone and go to the pairing mode
- Search your Wireless devices on your phone by following the phone's user manual for more information.
- After a few second the phone will list the "S530" as a discover device.
- Select it and follow your phone instruction to select this pairing.
- Your phone will confirm the pairing, and then press Yes/OK
- Finally, select to connect with the earphone from your phone.

### Charge your Earphone

Connect the earphone to USB Charger with the cable included. Red color LED indicator is ON when charge. The red color LED indicator turns blue when full charged. Make sure that your earphone is fully charged for at least 3 hours before initial use.
