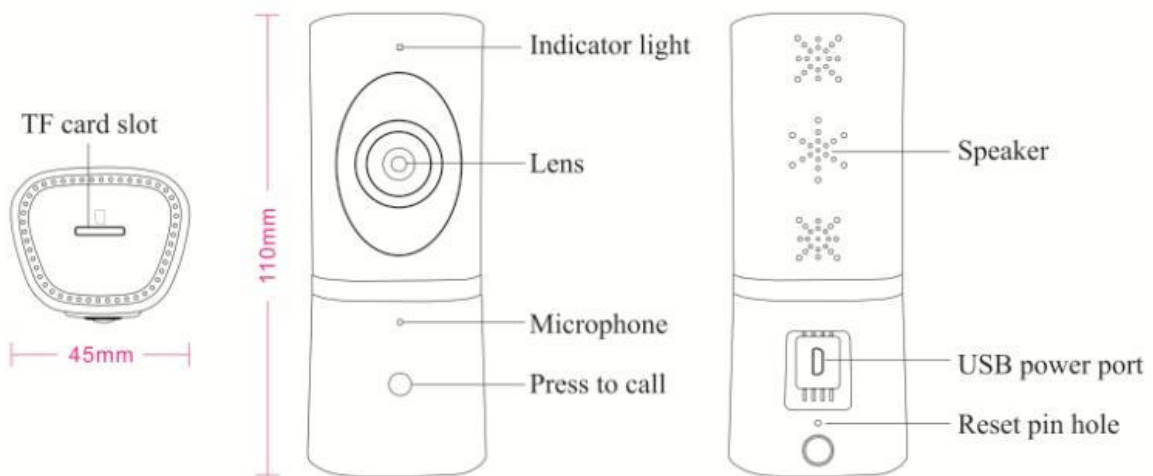

Quick Start

This user manual applies to all panoramic camera models

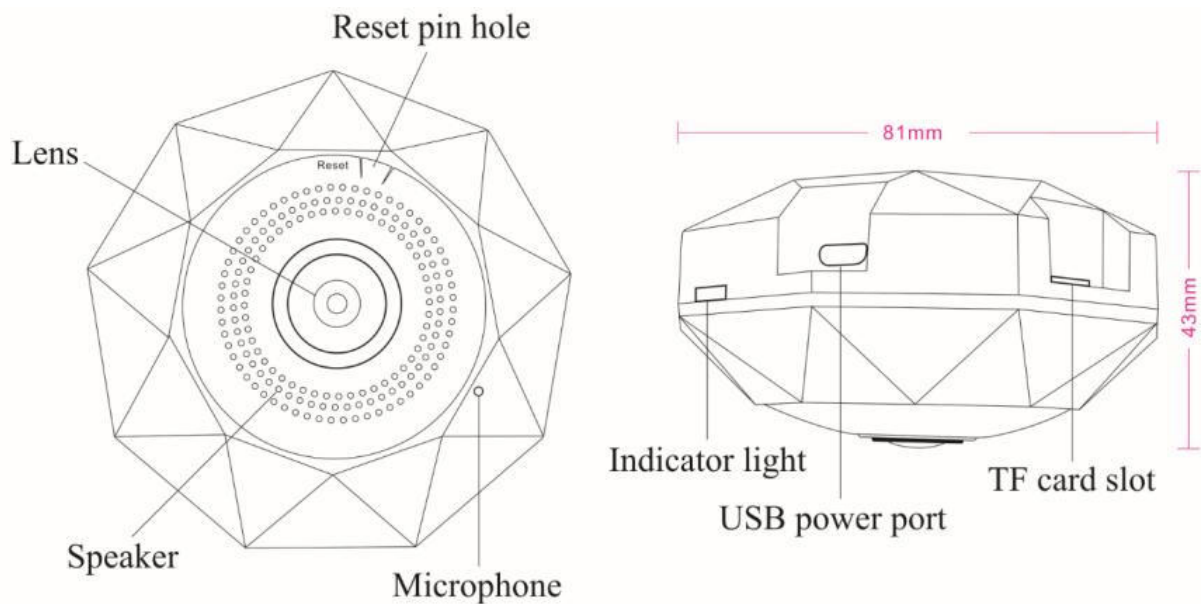
① Diagram



This is an interface example of 180 degree type, other 180 degree models similar.

USB interface: 5V external power supply

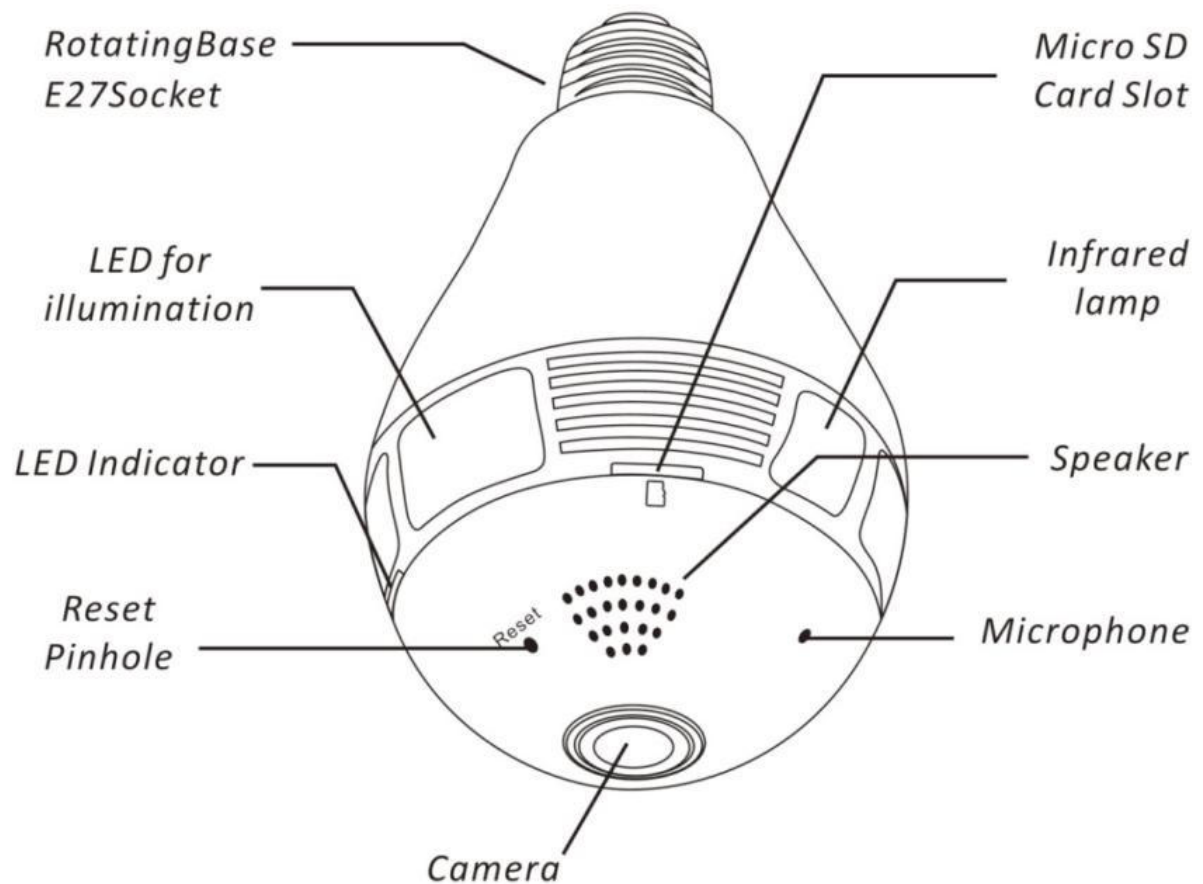
Micro SD card slot: For local storage, up to 128G



This is an interface example of 360 degree type, other 360 degree models similar.

USB interface: 5V external power supply

Micro SD card slot: For local storage, up to 128G



The power interface: **AC100~240V, 50~60Hz**

TF card slot: for storage, up to support 128G TF (SD card)

Note: the light bulb's voltage is 100V~240V, must be power-off when it is connected

② **Scan to download APP**

- Visit Apple APP Store or Google Play to download and install application “HDIPC360”. Launch the APP and create a new account. Alternatively you may scan the following QR Code with your smart phone which will bring you to the site:

③ **Camera connection**

- Get the camera connected with power and wait until red light blinks.
- Connected your Android or IOS device to your Wi-Fi and enter Wi-Fi password in APP as guided (5G Wi-Fi is not available for now), turn on the phone volume and get it close to the camera. When heard beeping sound from camera, please click “next” and wait until green light blink accompany with the voice “camera ready” which means connection is done.
- Name the camera and enjoy the video.

Q&A

① Why is the camera not connected online?

- Please check you have entered the right Wi-Fi password. Change password if there is any special symbol.
- Make sure DHCP of router is enabled.

② How can I playback recorded video on Micro SD card?

Tab “clock” icon on APP and move the cursor to the exact date and time, then tab again to play the recorded video. The camera need to insert TF card to support the storage and playback of video. Insert TF card into the memory card slot when camera is powered off, then connect to power, click on the playback button, select the point of time on the blue strip to playback video files.

③ I want to share the camera with other people. How to do that?

Go to the Camera settings, find the “sharing device” , click the top right icon “+” , and enter the user's account. Then click “OK”.

Note: the shared account must be a registered account in APP. The users re-log in their own account will be able to see the shared camera.

④ What if the camera be bound by other accounts?

Use the reset pin to press reset button, after hearing the beep sound, to add the camera again.

⑤ **How to make a call from camera to cellphone ?**

- One key call function is only available to corresponding model with the button on front of the cameras. (Other models do not support it.)
- Press the calling button on front of cameras, you will hear a “ding dong” sound, at the same time, cellphone will indicate the same sound(voice on) and push a notification. Click in the APP you will see “You have a call request, whether to view it” Click on “Yes” you will enter the real-time video. Now, enjoy your conversation.

⑥ **Why there is no response after pressing the call button?**

The camera will not respond if people are watching the real-time video, in this situation, you can just talk, cellphone user can hear you. When people are not watching the real-time video, press the call button, the camera and cellphone will sound “ding dong”.

Instruction

①Indicating light

- Stable red Power is on
- Blink red Waiting for Wi-Fi password
- Stable green Waiting for connection to Internet
- Blink green Camera is working

②Working Temperature

The camera is fit for the environment between $-5\sim 40^{\circ}\text{C}$.
It's normal if you feel the camera a bit hot when in working condition.

③Camera reset

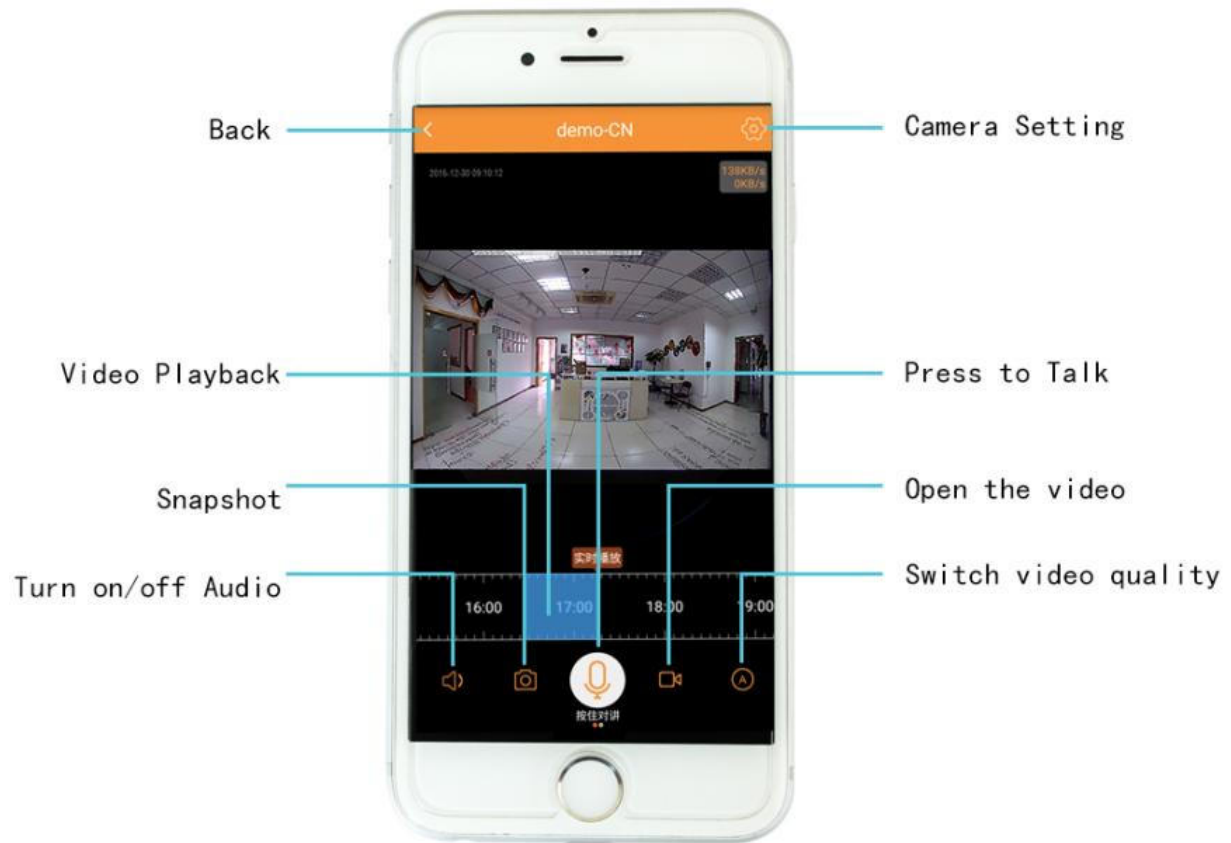
User will need to reset the camera when there is a requirement to:

- Change of Wi-Fi name or password.
- Change of Wi-Fi router
- Change of user to pair with the camera

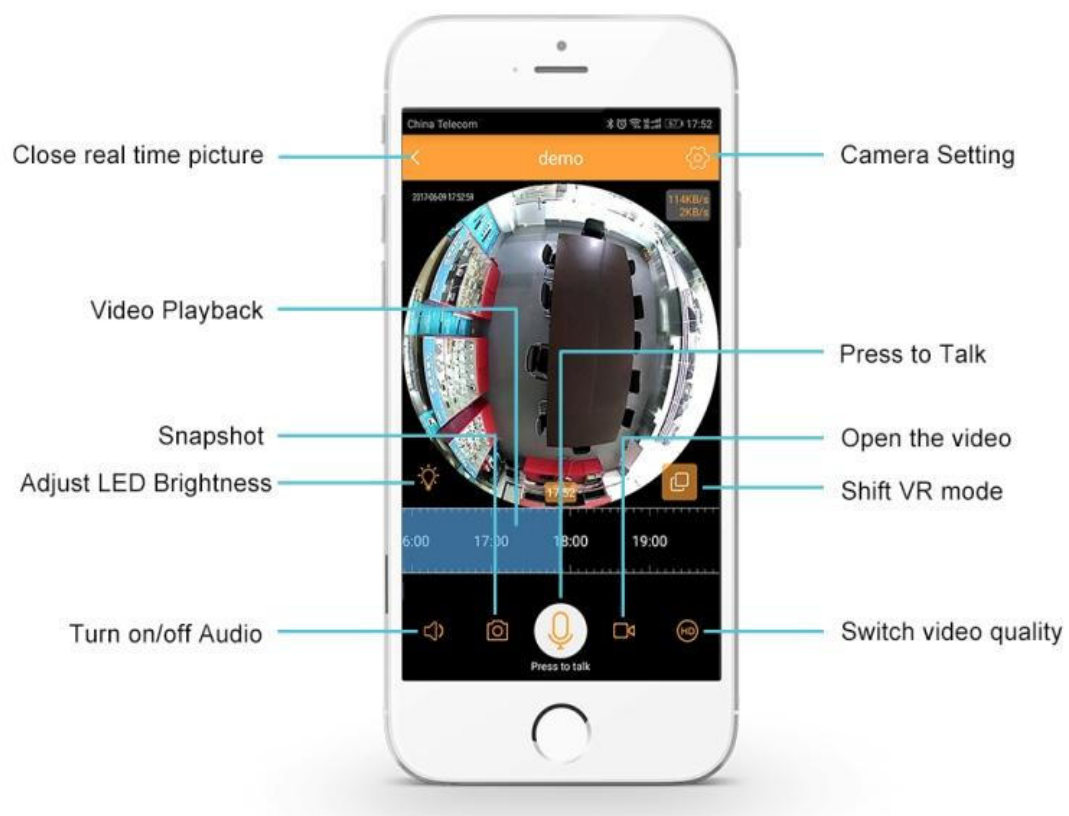
