
## **Safety Instructions**

## How to use the mirror lights?

- Short press the on/off button to light up or turn off the mirror.

## How to charge the mirror?

- Connect the micro USB port with a 5V/1A power supply or computer by the provided USB cable.
- When we start charging, the indicator is red color.
  When the mirror is fully charged, the indicator become blue color.
- 3. The mirror supports QI wireless charge.
- 4. Before charging the mirror, please make sure the lights are off.
- 5. Wireless charging only supports reception function.
