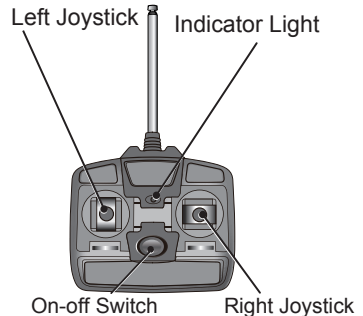
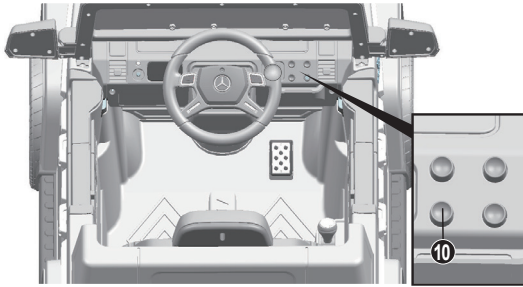




WARNING!

ADULT OPERATING ONLY!

1. Make sure the vehicle is set on remote control operation. For remote control operation **press the button (10 on the diagram below)** on the dashboard of the vehicle.



2. Press the “ON” button on the remote control to make connection with the vehicle. The Indicator light should turn **red**.

3. Always use caution when operating. Make sure child is fastened in the vehicle with the seat belt when in remote control operation.

4. Move the **Left Joystick** up and down slowly to control the vehicle’s speed. Releasing the joystick too quickly may cause sudden jerks to the vehicle.

5. Move the **Right Joystick** left and right to turn the vehicle.

(NOTE: Make sure steering wheel is set to **unlocked** when in remote control operation - *when the steering wheel is set to unlocked it will no longer control the front wheels, turning will only be possible with the remote control.*)
