Thanks for your purchase of our NECKIE Bluetooth Headset. We hope that we will give you a satisfied user experience.


For better audio listening, it is advised to start a new headphone with some soft light music first under relatively low volume. It may takes days and even longer before the headset’s speaker is fully “warm up” and perform the best.

## 1. How to Connect?

1.1 Ensure the headset is off, then tap and hold the MFB (Multi–Functional button) till the LED blinks blue (means in the pairing mode).

1.2 Turn on Bluetooth of your mobile device, search and connect “NECKIE”.

1.3 If you fail to connect, please pay attention to the below:  
(1) Please turn off other Bluetooth devices that may connect NECKIE.  
(2)Pairing distance is advised to be within 3 feet (1 meter).  
(3) Restart NECKIE and your device, then reopen their Bluetooth again for a second try.



## 2. How to Wear?

2.1 The headset is light and elastic that it can be easily shaped to fit your neck –– super fit when you are wearing a shirt.


2.2 There are S/M/L sizes of soft eartips for a secure and comfortable fit. Try and find the best one.

2.3 You can move the clips to get a proper wire length.With these clips, you can manage the cords neat and clean. It is also good for their protection.

2.4 NECKIE is IPX5 water–resistant that can withstands sweat, splash, rains & humid weather (but cannot be put into the water).


### Note:

For better service life, the advice is not to use the headset if it gets wet until it is dry again. Also, it is not advised to use it on the beach as the corrosive sea water may damage the waterproof layer.

### 3.2 How to Charge

Gently open the charging cover and you can see the micro USB charging port inside. It takes about 2 hours for a full charge.

### 3.3 Support “Wire Audio”

When battery runs low, you can continue your music via the “USB to 3.5mm Jack Audio Cable” to connect NECKIE to your device.

### 3.4 Functions

	Power On/Off	Long press the MFB for 3 secs
	Play/Pause Audio	Tap the MFB when listening to music
	Answer/End Call	Tap the MFB when a call is coming / when on a call
	Reject call	Long Press the MFB for 2 secs
	Activate Siri	Double–tap the MFB
	Adjust Volume	Tap the “+”or “–” button
	Previous/Next Song	Double–tap “+”or “–” button
	Low Battery Warning	The headset sounds 4 times as a reminder.

### Note:

While you’re in phone calls, stay your mouth close to the microphone can deliver louder and clearer talking.

### 3.5 Restore the Factory Default Settings

Ensure the headset is off. Then tap and hold the MFB for about 10 seconds until the headset power on and finally power off (it means the setting is restored and all pairing history is clear).
