POWER ON & POWER OFF

- 1. The earbuds will automatically turn on, on opening the charging case.
- 2. The earbuds will automatically turn off once placed inside the charging case with the lid closed.

PAIRING

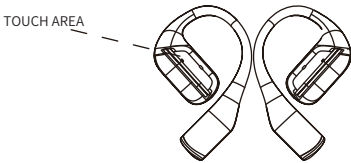
- 1. First-time Pairing with Device
  - Step 1: Open the charging case, and the earbuds will automatically power on and enter into pairing mode.
  - Step 2: Activate Bluetooth on your Bluetooth-enabled device and search for other Bluetooth devices.
  - Step 3: Select “FQ1100” from the list of Bluetooth devices shown.
- Notes:
  - The earbuds will automatically connect with the device paired last time when the case is open.

- 2. Pairing with a New Device or Connecting Two Bluetooth Devices Simultaneously
  - Step 1: Prepare for Pairing: Place both earbuds in the charging case, ensure they are charging, and keep the case open.
  - Step 2: Enter Pairing Mode: Press and hold the case button for 3 seconds until the earbuds' LED indicators flash white rapidly.
  - Step 3: Connect to a Device:

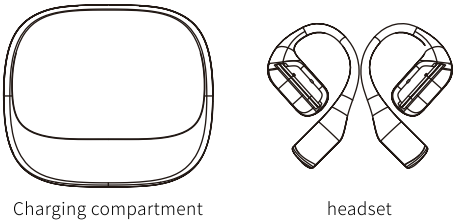
- For a new device: Search for the earbuds on the device and connect.

- For two devices:
  - First, connect the earbuds to the first device.
  - Then, repeat steps 1 & 2 to enter pairing mode again (earbuds will disconnect from the first device).
  - Search and connect on the second device.
  - Finally, manually reconnect the earbuds on the first device.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

• Single tap left side	⏮ Volume Down
• Single tap right side	⏭ Volume Up
• • Double tap either side	▶⏮ Play/Pause/Answer/Hang up
• • • Triple tap left	◀◀ Previous song
• • • Triple tap right	▶▶ Next song
— Touch and hold 2s right	🎮 Game Mode
— Touch and hold 2s left	🗣 Voice assistant
— Touch and hold 2s either side	📞 Reject incoming calls

CHARGING INDICATOR LIGHT

- 1. Place the left and right earbuds in the charging case;
- 2. When charging the case with a cable: the red light of the charging case remains on, and when the charging case is fully charged, the red light turns off.

(Please be sure to use 5V/1A charging cable or attached charging cable when you purchasing products)

RESET

- 1. Long press the charging case button for 8 seconds.
- 2. The charging case indicator will flash white once at 3 seconds and once at 8 seconds.

MATTERS NEEDING ATTENTION

- 1. Please put the headset in the correct position for charging.
- 2. The battery (battery pack or combination battery) shall not be exposed to conditions such as sunlight, fire, or similar overheating.
- 3. Listening to music at a high volume for a long time may cause hearing damage. Please adjust the volume appropriately when using this device.
