




**Diagram**

\*The details of the functions of the headphones are as follows:



**Power ON / OFF**


\*The detailed rules for startup and use are as follows:



1. Power ON: Press the multi-function button to turn the device and enter the pairing state. The LED light flashes alternately between red and blue.  
2. Power OFF: Press and hold the multi-function button for 5 seconds to enter the power-off state. The LED red light is on and then goes off.

**How to pair**

1. Pairing status: It enters the pairing status as soon as it is powered on. The LED red light and blue light flash alternately.  
2. Activate Bluetooth and set it to search for new devices.  
\*iPhone® : Settings > Bluetooth > On\*  
\*Android™ : Bluetooth: On > Scan for devices\*  
\*PC/Notebook: Bluetooth Setting: On > add a Bluetooth device\*  
3. If your PC/Notebook does not support Bluetooth function or remind you need driver, you may need to use an external Bluetooth USB Adapter.  
4. Select "C1"




Connect two mobile phones

**Telephone usage**


1. When using music playback, the usage rules are as follows:



Press once—Volume up  
Press 2S—Previous song  
Press once—Volume down  
Press 2S—Next song

**Music usage**


1. When making or receiving calls, the usage rules are as follows:



Press once—Volume up  
Press once—Volume down  
Press once—Mute on  
Press once—Mute off  
Press once—Answer  
Press 2S—Repeat  
Incoming call  
Double twice—Call back

**Siri usage/Voice assistant usage**

1. When using Siri or Voice assistant, it is necessary that the connection between the headphones and the mobile phone is normal.




Connect status

**Charge battery**

\*Put the headphones into the charging box and cover it. When the battery symbol on the charging box flashes, the headphones are charging normally. When fully charged, the electronic digital tube extinguishes.
