




HIGH DEFINITION WIRELESS HEADPHONES

2. Instructions:

First, make sure Bluetooth is turned on for the device you wish to pair.

■ Key Functions

	<p>Power on: Press for 5 seconds to power on, the blue indicator will flash. Pairing: When Bluetooth is turned on, the blue and red indicators take turns flashing. Search for the device name " X-Loud " and connect (It will turn off automatically if no device is connected for 5 minutes) Power off: Press for 5 seconds to power off.</p>
	<p>When receiving a phone call, press it to answer the call, press it again to end the phone call. Press it for 2 seconds to reject the phone call. Press it for 4 seconds to re-dial the last phone number you called. When not on a call, rapidly press twice for voice command prompt.</p>
	<p>In music mode, press it 1 time to pause, and press it again to play. When receiving a phone call the music will pause. When call is over, the music will continue.</p>
	<p>In Music Mode, press and hold to play next song. Briefly press the button to increase the volume.</p>
	<p>In Music Mode, press and hold to play previous song. Briefly press the button to decrease the volume.</p>

3. Bluetooth Indicator Status

Work Status	Indicator Light Status	Remark
Switch on	Blue indicator flash 3 times	Voice Prompts
Switch off	Red indicator flash 1 time	Voice Prompts
Pairing Mode	Red and blue indicators take turns to flash	Voice Prompts
Connection	Blue indicator will flash 1 time every 6 seconds	Voice Prompts
Phone call	Blue indicator will flash 1 time every 6 seconds	
Play Music	Blue indicator will flash 1 time every 6 seconds	
Battery low warning	Red indicator will flash every 60 second	Voice Prompts
Charging	Red indicator is on all the time when charging
