





SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The setup and installation for PET@HOME will take a few minutes. To get started, please make sure the following items are ready:

- 1) Smart Phone
- 2) Wi-Fi Router
- 3) PET@HOME



PET@HOME setup takes 4-7 minutes.

- ① Download the PET@HOME App
- ② Sign up your PET@HOME account
- ③ Add your PET@HOME device

Note: PET@HOME supports Wi-Fi 802.11 b/g/n (2.4GHz)

1. Download PET@HOME App

To configure your PET@HOME, you need to download the PET@HOME App from Apple App Store or Google Play via searching "PET@HOME iPATROL" or scanning the






2. Sign up your PET@HOME account and login

Tap "Sign Up" to create your PET@HOME account, then tap "Sign In" to login; or Tap "Sign In with Facebook" to login directly.




3. Add your PET@HOME

Tap "Add PET@HOME", the PET@HOME App will guide you through each step.




4. Setup is complete

You setup successfully, tap "Play with PET@HOME" to play it.



5. Add treats to hopper

Pour treats into the hopper and fill it, leaving 1 inch clearance at the top.



Notes: Treats should be no smaller than 0.2 inch and no larger than 1 inch in length.
The treat hopper can fit up to 200 treats.


- 1) Suggest using treats that are in the same size and shape.
- 2) Treats should be dry and hard.
- 3) Treats should not be crumbly, greasy, sticky or soft.
- 4) If the treats are small, multiple treats will be tossed at once.

RECOMMENDED PLACEMENT

You can place your PET@HOME in the following 2 options:

1) Place on the flat surface


Place your PET@HOME on a flat surface anywhere in your home. PET@HOME has a non-slip rubber bottom, which provides a secure grip on flat surface. For better viewing angle, suggest that PET@HOME is placed closer to the edge of the flat surface.



2) Mount on the wall

For more secure, you can mount PET@HOME on the wall:

1. Select your preferred viewing height
2. Use the included mounting guide to mark where to drill holes (0.24 inch (6mm) diameter for the included dowels) and 3 anchor screws to affix the PET@HOME.



LED INDICATOR NOTIFICATIONS

The LED indicator on the front right show you the current working status of PET@HOME.

1. Steady Red

PET@HOME is starting up.

2. Blinking Red

PET@HOME is restoring factory.

3. Blinking Red fastly

PET@HOME is upgrading.

4. Steady Green

PET@HOME connects Wi-Fi successfully.

5. Blinking Green

PET@HOME is in Wi-Fi setup mode.

6. Blinking Green fastly

PET@HOME is connecting to Wi-Fi.

7. Steady White


PET@HOME is ready to work.

8. Blinking White

PET@HOME is saving video to your timeline.

9. Steady Blue

Play mode. Take care of your privacy.



10. Blinking Purple

PET@HOME has connected to your Wi-Fi router, but can't reach our servers.

Please check your MAC address filtering, firewall, and other security settings on your Wi-Fi router.

11. Blinking Orange

Your PET@HOME is not registered, but has Wi-Fi settings. Please start the registration process by Tap the "Add PET@HOME" on the app.


CAUTIONS

To avoid injuries or causing harm, please read all safety information and operating instructions prior to using PET@HOME.

- 1) Children under 13 years old to be supervised when using PET@HOME.
- 2) The PET@HOME is designed and suitable for indoor use only.
- 3) The PET@HOME is not a substitute for home monitoring system.
- 4) Please try to make the PET@HOME close to your Wi-Fi Router as soon as possible.
- 5) Don't point the laser at people.
- 6) To avoid your pet breaking fragile objects, don't point the laser at them.
- 7) To avoid harm you or your pets, please stay away from the "Fling Treats Aperture".
- 8) Prevent the power cable from being pinched, walked on, or chewed by your pets.
- 9) To avoid overheating, please don't leave your PET@HOME in direct sunlight.
- 10) Keep your PET@HOME away from moisture, dust, liquid, or naked flames.
- 11) Don't drop, hit, shake, or tumble your PET@HOME.
- 12) Don't stain, scratch, or damage the front panel of PET@HOME.
- 13) Keep in mind your treats expiration date, to ensure your pets enjoy fresh treats always.
- 14) To avoid mechanical issues, please make sure your treats no larger than 1 inch.
- 15) The treats tossed by PET@HOME can't replace your pet's normal meals.
- 16) To prevent your pets from choking hazards, please make sure your pets are familiar with the treats that your are flinging through PET@HOME.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

It is important to note that only the treat hopper is dishwasher safe. All other parts can be cleaned with a warm damp towel.



1) Take out Treat Hopper

Detach the Hopper Lid via pulling the release buttons on both sides at the same time and pulling up and away from the base; then take out the treat hopper.

2) Cleaning Treat Hopper

The detachable treat hopper is dishwasher safe on low temperature (up to 130°F), or you can wash it by hand.

3) Cleaning Fling Treats Aperture

Open the door on the bottom of the PET@HOME via pulling door to the front, then clean up the crumbs and clean the aperture with a warm damp towel or sponge.

4) Close Hopper Lid

To keep treats fresh and prevent odor from getting out, please close the Hopper Lid and the door on the bottom after you finish cleaning.

Note: To prevent damaging the Treat Hopper, do not use abrasive cleaners on the treat hopper, only liquid detergents and soft sponges.
