

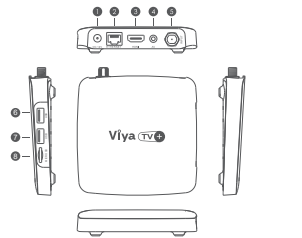

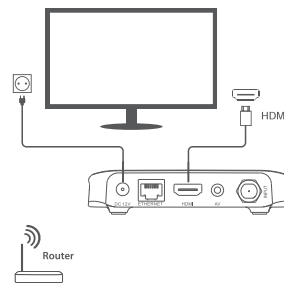

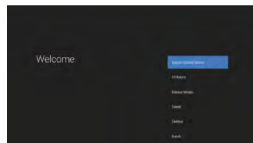
### Pairing guide

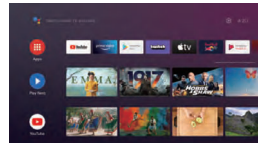
