### 开机关机

#### 1.开机

方式一:打开充电盒上盖,取出耳机自动开机;

方式二:长按左右耳机的MFB按键约3秒,耳机开机。

#### 2.关机

方式一:将耳机放回充电盒中,耳机自动关机,

方式二:与蓝牙设备断开连接3分钟后,自动关机。

### 如何重置

在未连接状态下,双击+长按2秒,然后关机,重置完成。

### 如何配对

#### 1.从充电仓拿出开机

2.耳机自动对

3.打开手机/平板的设置---蓝牙---打开蓝牙---搜索---YYK-Q65---配对/连接---播放音乐。

### 电脑/手提电脑配对的方法

打开电脑设置-设备-蓝牙和其他设备-开启蓝牙-添加蓝牙  
或其他设备-搜索蓝牙设备YYK-Q65-配对/连接-播放音乐。

注意:如果电脑没有蓝牙,请插入蓝牙适配器,下载蓝牙驱动  
后再正常使用。

### 如何给耳机充电

1.把耳机放入充电仓内,耳机就会自动关机然后开始充电,  
充电仓显示屏中间数字和左右对应进度条亮起,说明充电  
仓正在给耳机充电。

2.耳机充电时红灯常亮,充满蓝灯亮10秒钟后熄灭。

### 给充电仓充电

请使用手机适配器给充电仓充电,可以使用电脑Type-c线  
或者其他Type-c接口的充电器进行充电。

### 安全预防

高质量的耳机,为了延长使用寿命,请参考以下说明:  
1.请本品远离高温、高湿、腐蚀环境。  
2.请防止本品被撞击,跌落,弯曲,浸泡等。  
3.请不要拆耳机或者充电座。  
4.请不要让本品一直过度充电,这样降低本品的使用寿命。  
5.如果它引起任何不适感或者疼痛,请停止使用本品。  
6.使用由受监管的制造商认证的DC 5V-1A适配器。

### multiple use key



#### Pause/Play: Double-click the MFB button.

Previous Track: Long press the MFB button on the left (L side) for 1 second.

Next Track: Long press the MFB button on the right (R side) for 1 second.

Volume Up: Triple-click the MFB button on the left (L side).

Volume Down: Triple-click the MFB button on the right (R side).

Answer a call: Double-click the MFB button.

Hang up the phone: Double-click the MFB button.

Reject an incoming call: Long press the MFB button for 1 second.

Cancel the call: Double-click the MFB button.

Call Siri: Triple-click the MFB button on the left or right side when no music is playing.

Cancel Siri: Double-click the MFB button on the left or right side when no music is playing.

### Power on/off

Please translate the following text into English:

#### 1. Power On

Method 1: Open the lid of the charging case, take out the earphones, and they will power on automatically.

Method 2: Press and hold the MFB button on the left/right earphone for about 3 seconds to power on the earphones.

#### 2. Power Off

Method 1: Place the earphones back into the charging case, and they will power off automatically.

Method 2: The earphones will power off automatically after being disconnected from the Bluetooth device for 3 minutes.

### How to reset

In the disconnected state, double-click + hold down for 2 seconds and then power off. Reset is complete.

### How to pair

#### 1. Take out the charging chamber to start the machine

2. Automatic headset pairing

3. Open the settings of mobile phone/tablet --- Bluetooth --- Open Bluetooth --- Search---

YYK-Q65 --- pairing/connecting --- playing music.

### Computer/laptop pairing method

Open Computer Settings - Devices - Bluetooth and Other devices - Enable Bluetooth - Add Bluetooth Or other devices - Search for Bluetooth device

YYK-Q65- Pair/Connect - Play music.

Note: If the computer does not have Bluetooth, please plug in the Bluetooth adapter and download the Bluetooth driver. Then normal use.

### How to charge the headset

1. Put the headset into the charging compartment, the headset will automatically shut down and start charging. The number in the middle of the display and the corresponding progress bar on the left and right side of the display light up, indicating charging. Cang is charging the earphones.

2. When the earphone is charging, the red light will be steady on, and the blue light will be off after 10 seconds.

### Charge the charging chamber

Please use the mobile phone adapter to charge the charging chamber. You can use the computer Type-c cable or other chargers with Type-c interface.

### Safety precautions

For high-quality earphones, please refer to the following instructions to prolong the service life:

1. Please keep away from high temperature, high humidity and corrosive environment.

2. Please prevent the product from being hit, dropped, bent, soaked, etc.

3. Please do not remove the headset or charging stand.

4. Please do not allow the product to be overcharged all the time, so as to reduce the service life of the product.

5. If it causes any discomfort or pain, please stop using this product.

6. Use a DC 5V-1A adapter certified by a regulated manufacturer.

Repeated charging and discharging of the headset will cause the battery performance to decrease over time, which will affect all rechargeable electronic products are normal.
