


PRE-INSTALLATION

PLANNING INSTALLATION

- Turn off the electrical power at the fuse or circuit breaker box before installing or servicing any part of this fixture.
- If replacing a fixture, remove existing fixture and make a sketch of wiring configuration (by color) or mark wires with masking tape for identification.
- Remove the seiling light from the carton and check that all parts are included.

 Be careful not to misplace any of the screws or parts needed for installing the fixture.
- Diffuser is fragile. Carefully set aside in a safe location to avoid damage until ready to be installed.

INSTALLATION

IMPORTANT: Do not use with dimmers or timers.

CAUTION: Before beginning installation turn off the circuit breaker and light switch

STEP 1

Press one end of diffuser (B) and slide the diffuser (B) to the same side, ensure the diffuser is open from other side (A) and remove the diffuser. (Figure 1)



The lamp base (A) is manufactured with 3 knockout holes to provide flexibility during installation. If one of the Stand-By Knockout locations is used the wire may require additional trimming or extension. After selecting desired knockout location bend back the knockout tab (may require screwdriver to loosen), feed the connection wire through one of the knock out holes and slide connection wire beneath metal tabs. Bend tabs to hold wire in place. (Figure 2)




Mount the mounting bracket (BB) to the junction box and secure using the 2 small machine screws (AA). Connect the supply AC wires to the corresponding fixture wires (BLACK to BLACK, WHITE to WHITE and GROUND to GROUND) in the junction box and secure using wire nuts (CC). (Figure 2)

RECOMMENDED: Wrap each wire nut with electrical tape (not included) after wires have been attached


NOTE: The screws and nuts that are pre-installed on the mounting bracket (BB) should be test fitted to ensure only 3/16" of thread is exposed in order to firmly install lamp.



INSTALLATION

STEP 3

Mark 4 hole locations by holding fixture to wall or ceiling. For installation into drywall, drill a 1/4 in. pilot hole into the marked screw locations. Insert wall anchors (DD). Once the wall anchors have been inserted into pre-drilled holes, replace fixture over hole locations and slightly tighten screws (EE) into wall anchors. For installation into wood use the included screws. Slide the lamp base (A) over until the narrow legs of the keyhole slots are under the heads of the screws (EE). Finish tightening the screws (EE) until they are firmly seated and the lamp base (A) is tightly secured to the mounting surface. (Figure 4)



Insert and press one end of the diffuser (B) into the lamp base (A), making sure that the diffuser (B) is completely placed on the lamp base (A), slide the diffuser (B) to the other end. Restore power to the fuse box and turn light switch on to activate the fixture. (Figure 5)

NOTE: If you want to re-open the diffuser after installnation. Please hold the diffuser carefully for is easy to fall drop.






- 3. Once paired, you can use the (A/B/C) buttons to activate the light or group of lights. You can also select desired brightness, CCT and set timers.
