Attach part 8 frame sides to part 10 lower frame pieces with four part B screws

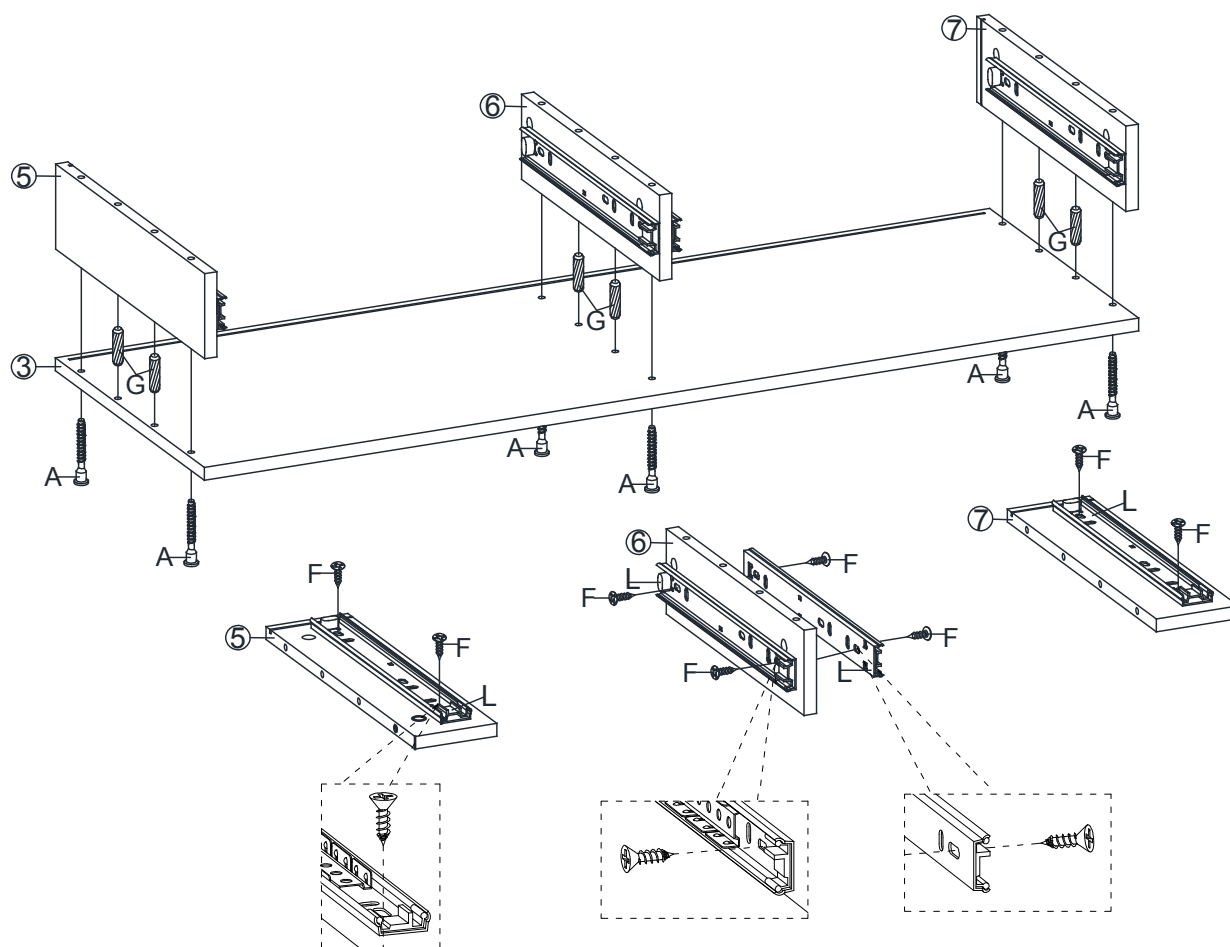

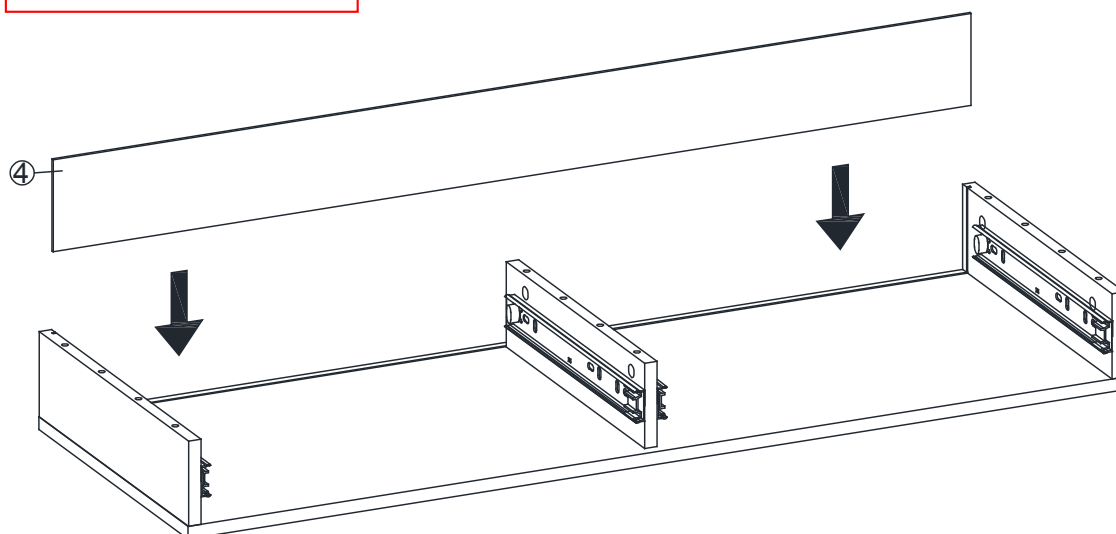

Attach part L slider rails to part 5,6,and 7 frame pieces. Attach frame pieces to part 3 lower shelf with six part G dowels and six part A screws.



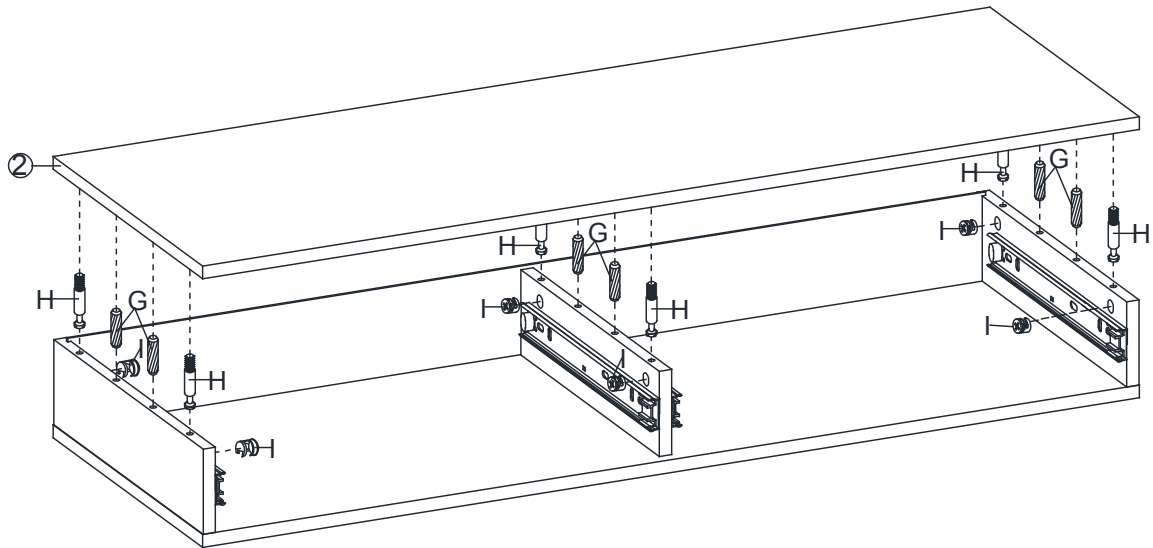

Slide in part 4 back.



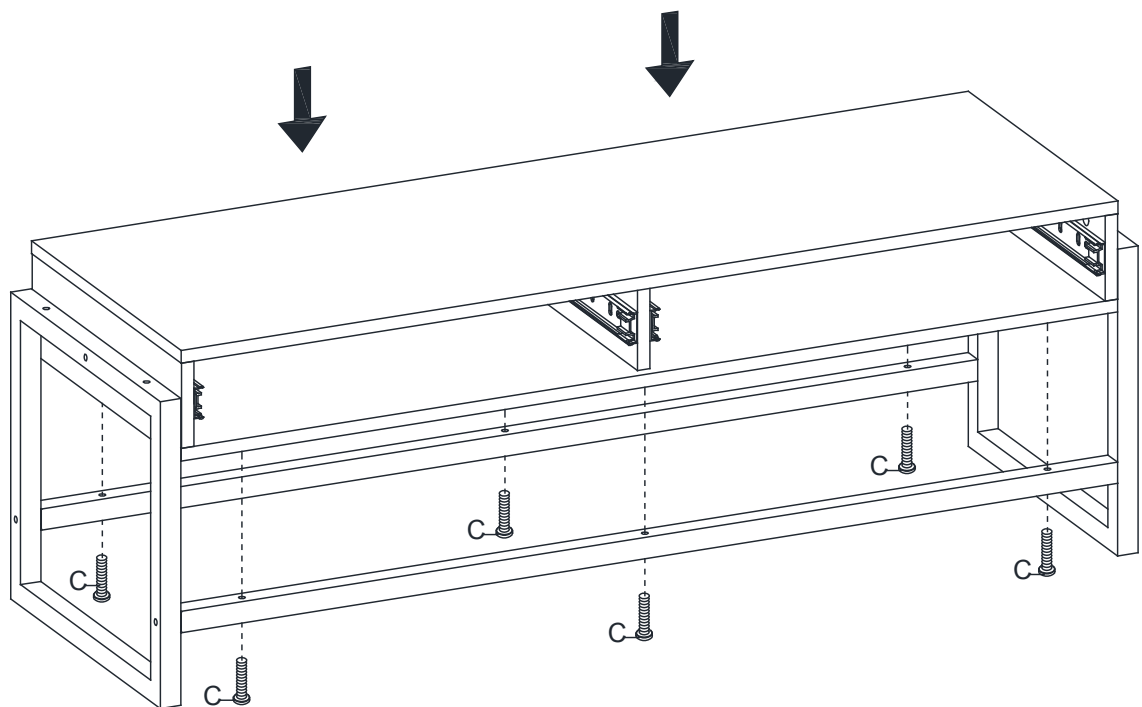

Attach part 2 middle shelf with six part G dowels, six part H cam bolts, and six part I cam locks.



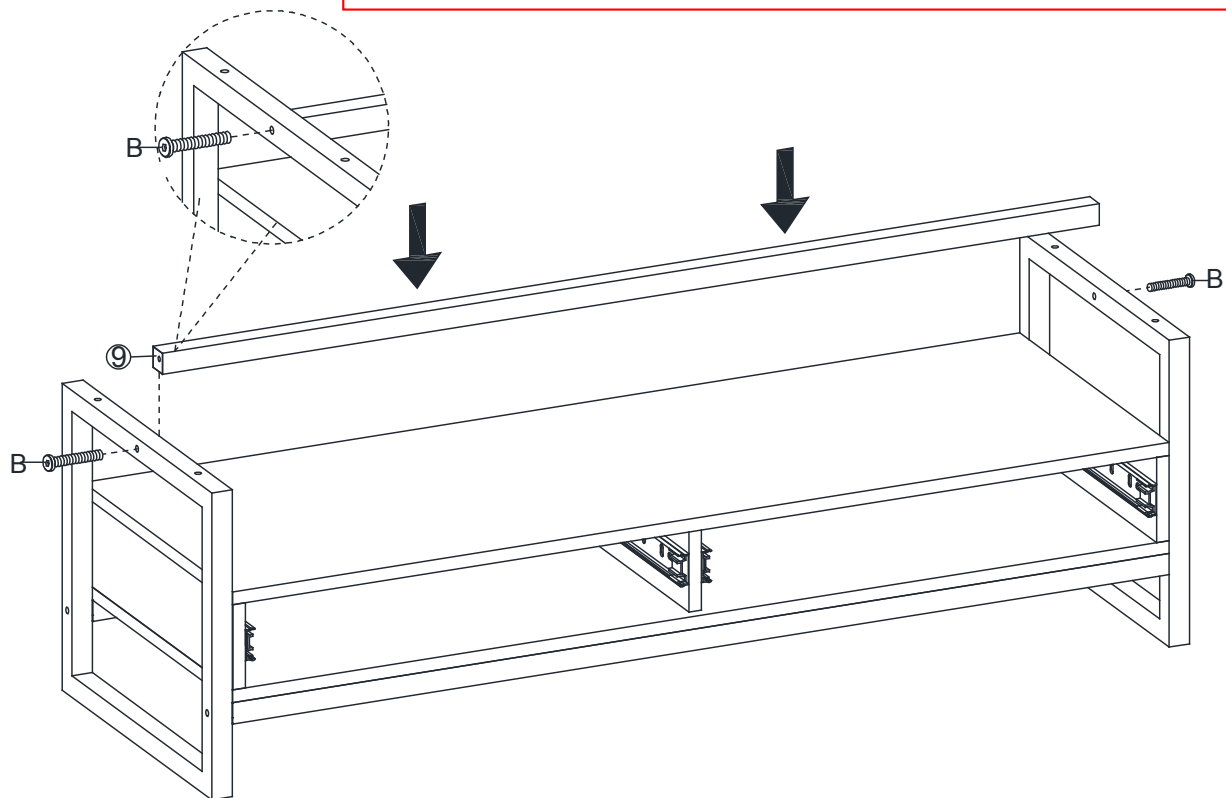
Step 6

Attach drawer/shelf assembly to lower frame with six part C screws.



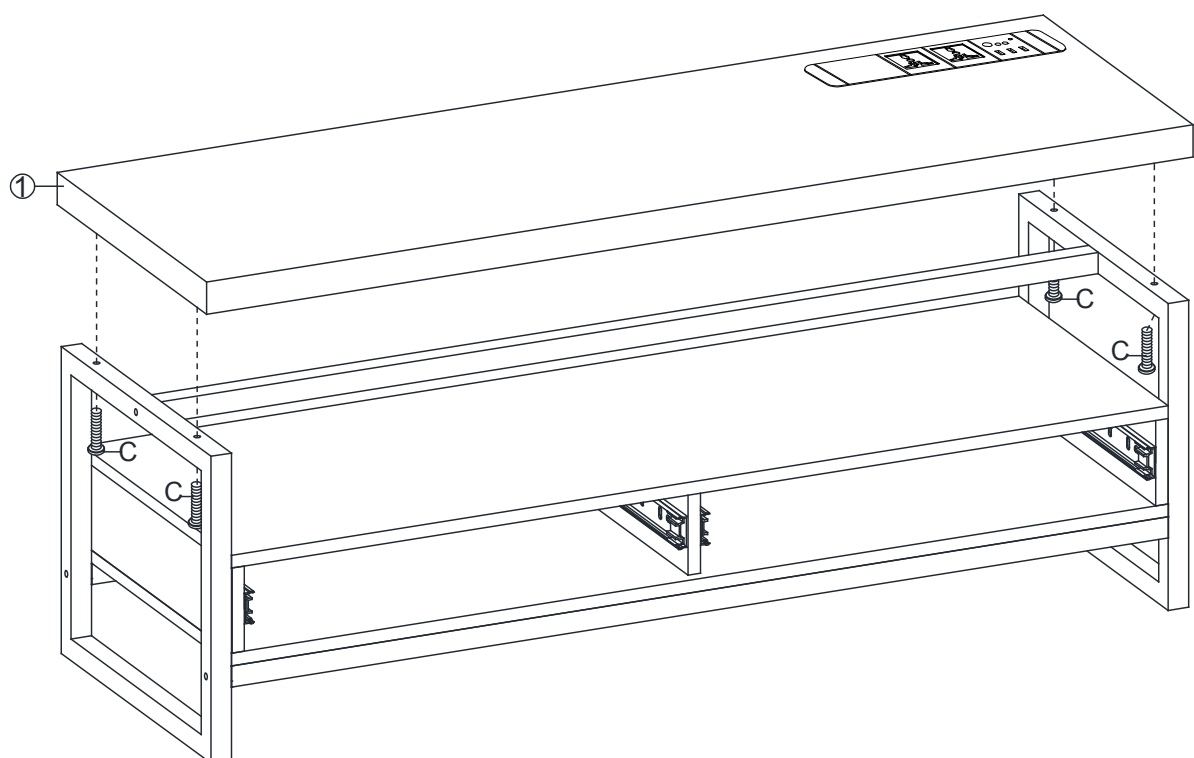

Attach part 9 middle support with two part B screws.



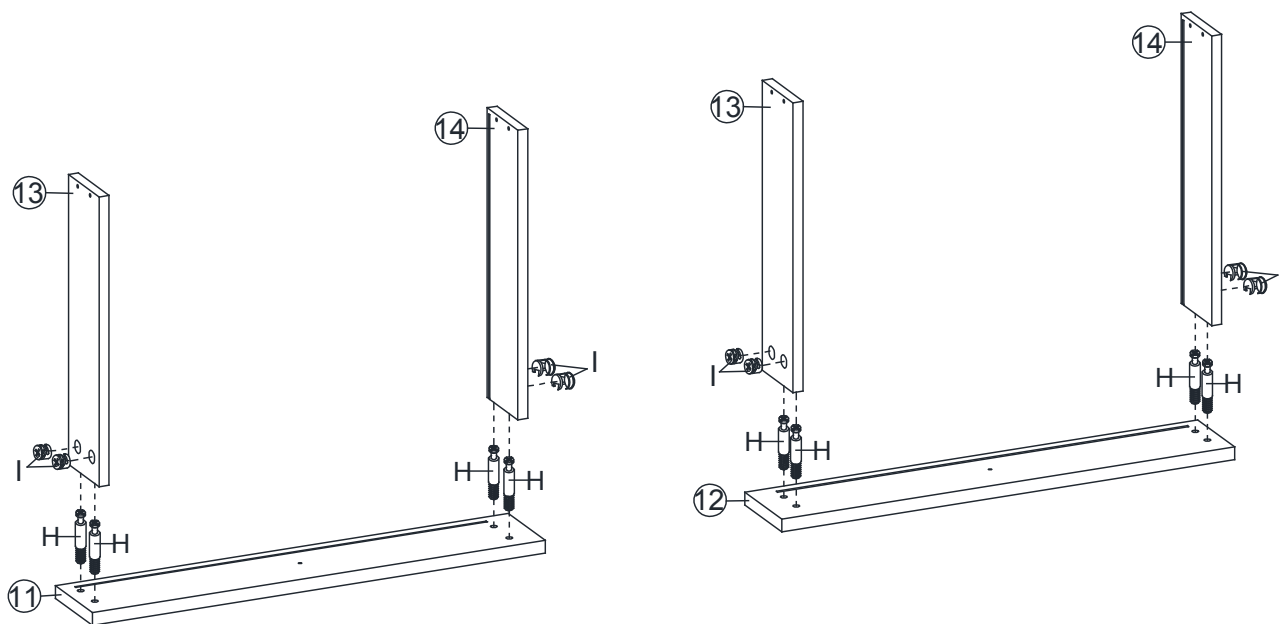
Step 8

Attach part 1 tabletop with four part C screws.



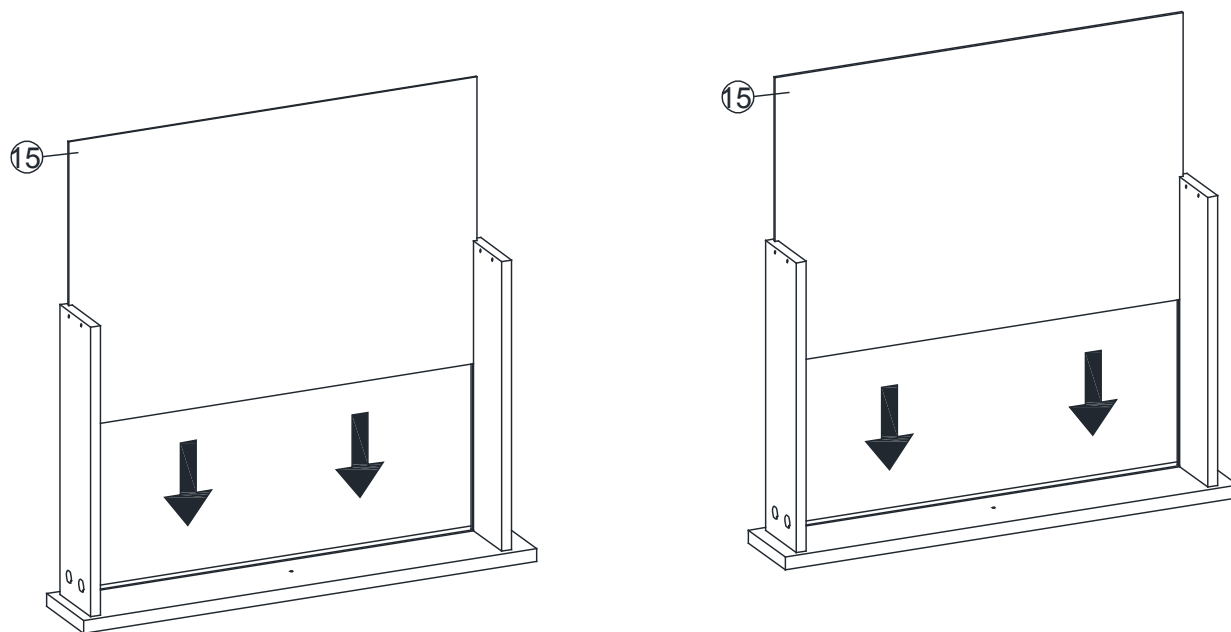
Step 9

Attach parts 13 and 14 drawer sides to drawer front panel with four part H cam bolts and four part cam locks. Repeat on other drawer front panel.



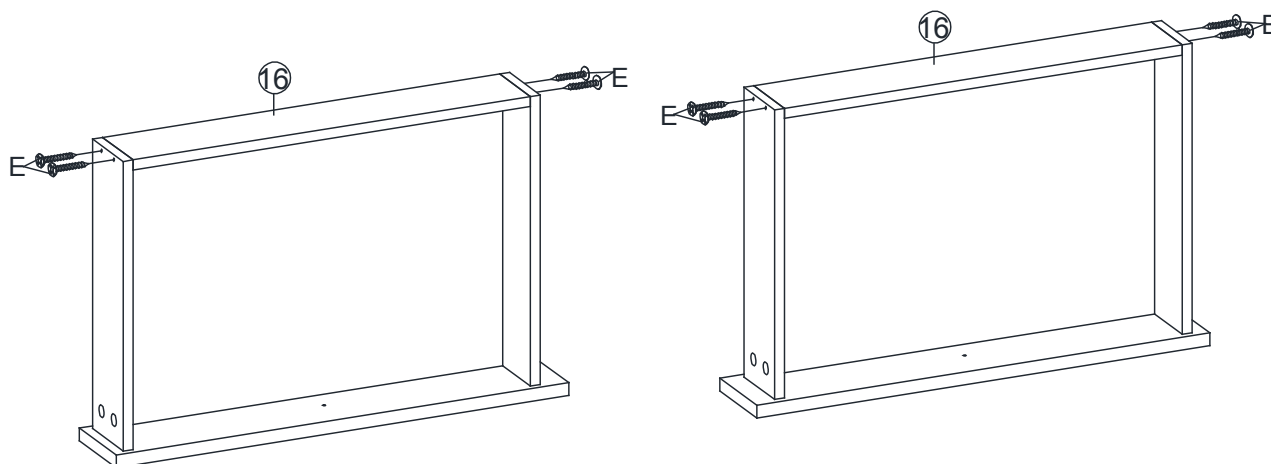
Step 10

Slide in part 15 drawer backs.



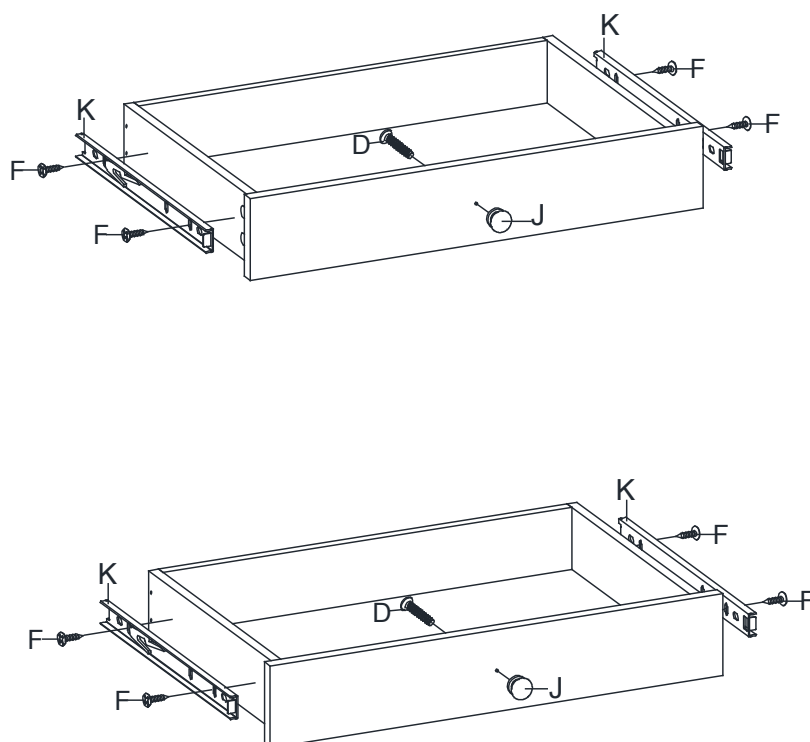
Step 11

Attach part 16 drawer back panel with four part E screws. Repeat on other drawer.



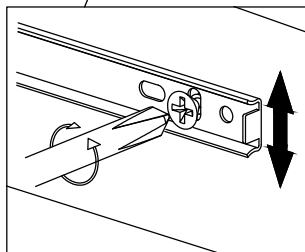
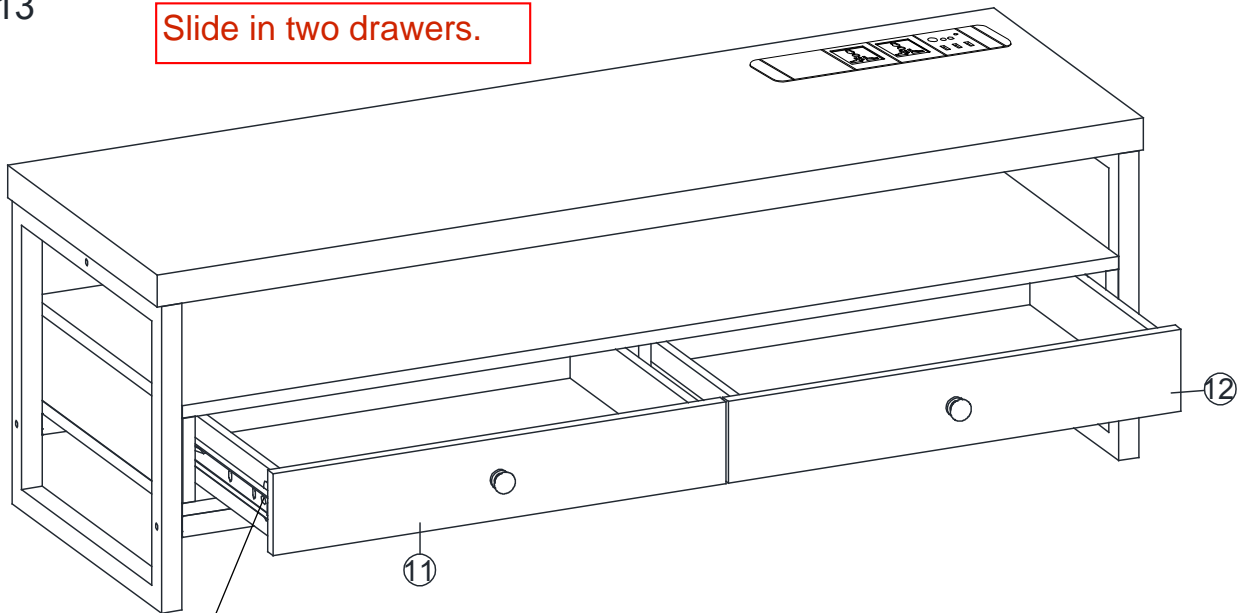
Step 12

Attach two part K slider rails with two part F screws on each. Attach part J knob with part D screw. Repeat on other drawer.



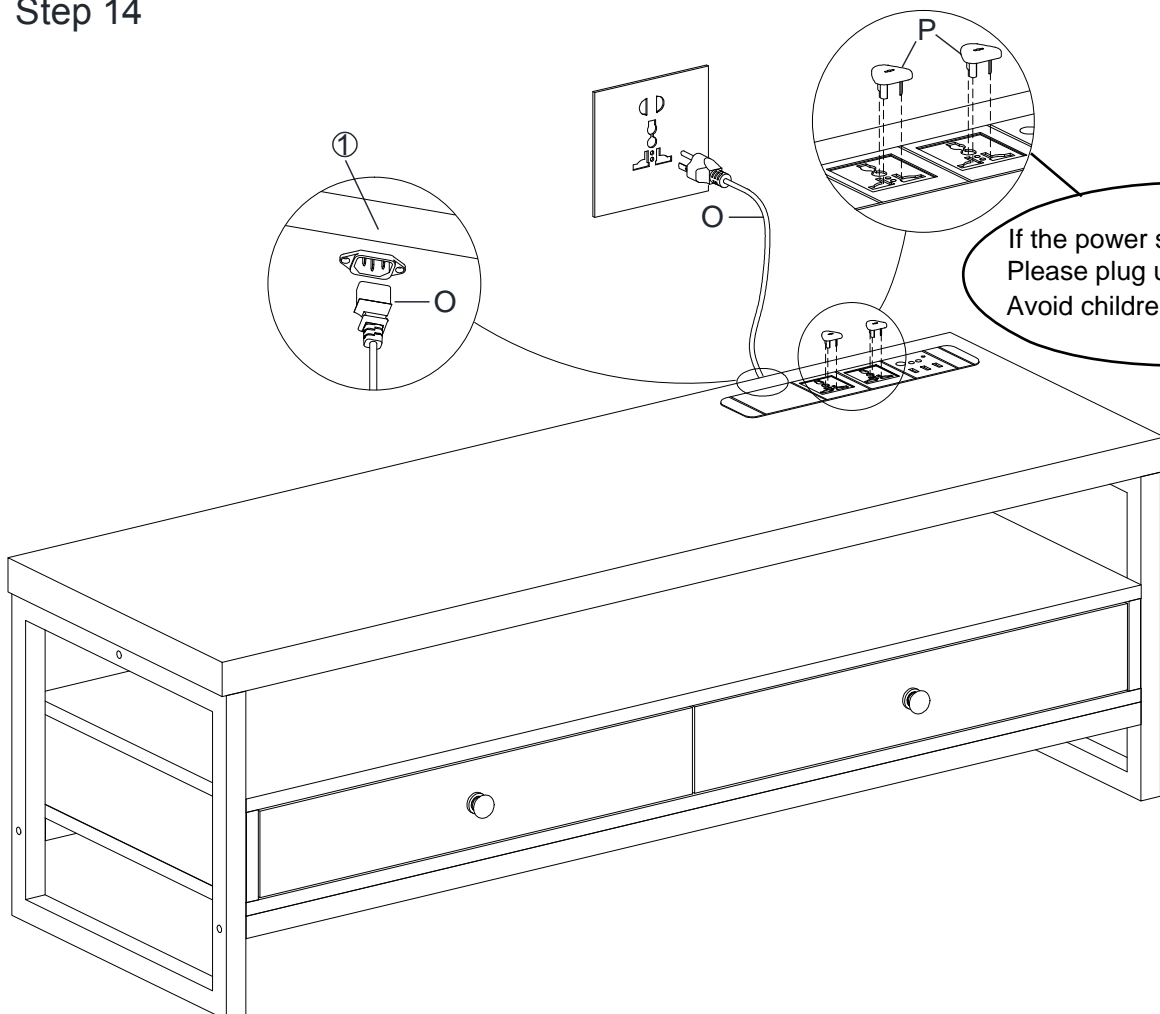
Step 13

Slide in two drawers.



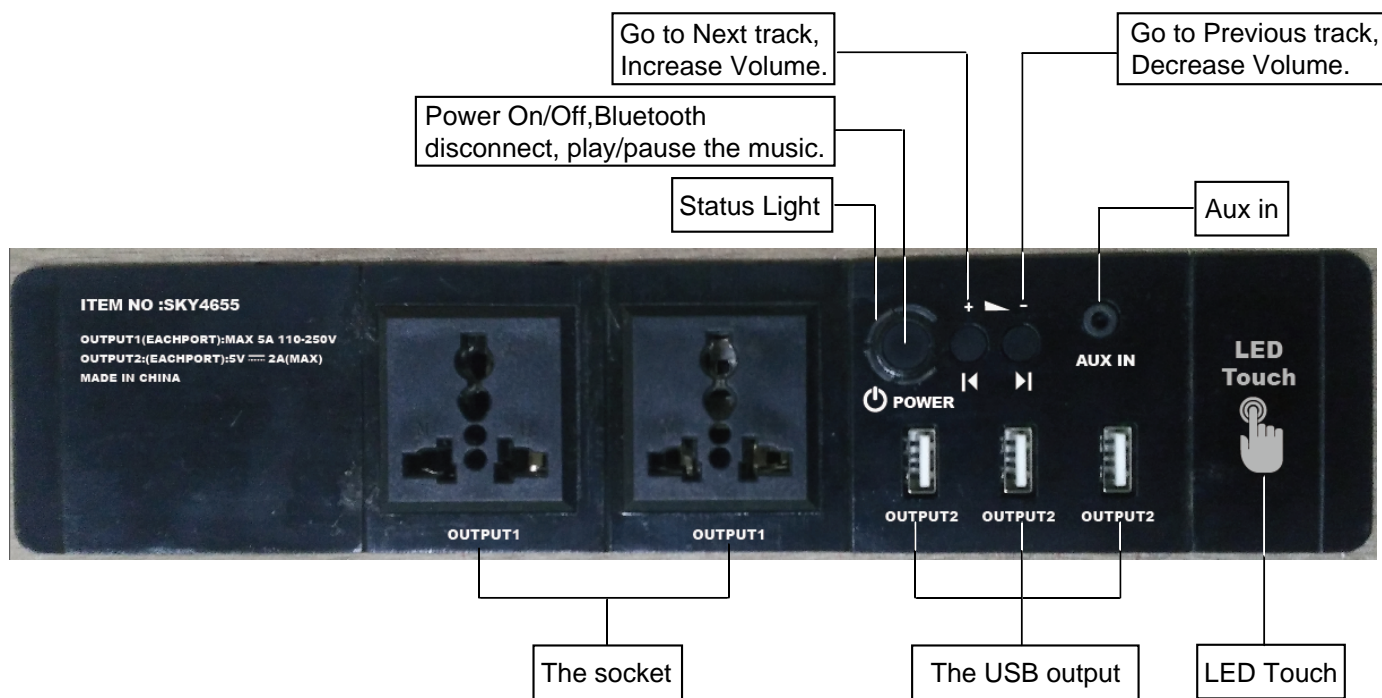
If the drawers are not aligned or overlap each other, then unscrew runner's screws slightly, re-adjust the drawers so they are fully aligned and levelled, then fully screw in the runner's screws.

If the power socket is not use. Please plug up it with the parts P. Avoid children touching it

1. Power On/Off:

ON: Push and hold "POWER" button for 3 seconds. The status light will turn blue and you will hear the Welcome tone. Reconnection: If paired before, the shelf will reconnect automatically to an earlier paired Bluetooth device.

OFF: When playing music,push and hold "POWER" button for 3 seconds to disconnect with a paired Bluetooth device.Push and hold "POWER" button for 6 seconds to shut down the speakers.

Noted: After disconnecting the Bluetooth device, the speakers automatically turn off after 5 minutes non use.

2. Bluetooth pairing:

For first pairing: Press and hold "POWER" button for 3 seconds. The blue status light will flash fast. Check the Bluetooth function on your mobile device and search for **BT 2Drw desk**.

When making the connection the status light will stop flashing and you will hear a ping tone. **Noted:** If not paired with a device the shelf will stay in the Bluetooth pairing mode for 5 minutes. If pairing is not successful, turn off the shelf speaker and reboot to pair again. Make sure that there is no wired line inserted inside "Aux in"jack before using bluetooth.

3. Play & Pause of music:

Press the "POWER" button once to pause your music. Press once again to continue listening.
-Changing Songs

Press "**⏮**"button once to go to previous track. Press "**⏭**" button once to go to next track.

-Volume control

Press and hold button "**⏮**" to decrease volume or press and hold button "**⏭**" to increase volume. An indication tone will alert you when the volume is adjusted to the maximum level.

Note: You may also adjust the volume from your Bluetooth enabled device's volume control. Not all devices have the same operation. Please refer to your device user's manual for further information.

4. Aux in jack; Wire mode connection guide:

Plug in cable to Aux in jack to another portable device to play the music.
